#### JACKSONVILLE WINS FOURTH-STRAIGHT

Jordan Groshans laced a pair of two-run doubles Sunday to lead the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to a 7-4 victory and series win over the Memphis Redbirds, Santiago Chavez and Jake Mangum knocked back-to-back singles in the fifth. With two outs, Groshans lashed his second two-run two-bagger to put Jacksonville (17-14) ahead 5-3. Cobie Fletcher-Vance doubled home two runs in the sixth inning to push the lead to 7-3.

#### STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in 17 of their last 22 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 51 runs, 44 earned, on 99 hits (8.4) H/9) in 106.0 innings for a 3.73 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registering just 75 punchouts (6.4 K/9). However, they have only issued 34 walks during this run, a rate of 2.9 per nine innings.

#### WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late: Jacksonville has registered 123 free passes over the last 23 games since April 11, a figure that ranks second in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 13.4 percent of their plate appearances. The Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games, Jacksonville's 11 walks on April 30 were their most in a game since tallying 12 against Birmingham on 6/15/19. The last time the club tallied 11 walks at home was 8/6/15 vs. Pensacola.

#### JERARASSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion has been on a tear since the season's second week. Over his last 23 games dating back to April 7, the native of Bayaguana in the Dominican Republic is 27for-89 at the plate, slashing .303/.441/.506/.947 with nine doubles, three homers, 16 RBIs and 22 walks. Encarnacion places amongst the league leaders in several categories this year, including doubles (T-7th, 9), walks (T-12th, 22) and RBIs (T-17th, 23).

#### WAVE RUNNERS

Last year Jacksonville struggled against their International League East foes, going 39-45. However, against Norfolk, Jacksonville went 11-10, winning the Navy Town Showdown. Although the Jumbo Shrimp slashed .250/.327/.403/.730 with 21 home runs and 93 RBIs, the pitching staff struggled. The Jumbo Shrimp hurlers compiled a 5.03 ERA was the third-worst ERA among 2022 opponents. Norfolk hit .233 against Jacksonville pitchers, plating 102 ER in 182.1 innings. The Tides' 21 home runs against Jumbo Shrimp pitchers was the third-most hit against the pitching staff out of the 10 teams Jacksonville faced in 2022. The 2021 Navy Town Showdown series also featured Jacksonville's record-setting game where the offense put up 20 runs on June 4, 2022, the most in a game since 2005.

#### KING CHARLES

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, Charles Leblanc went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot at the plate since. Over the last nine games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 11-for-30 (.367) with a double, home run, five RBIs and a remarkable 14 walks for a .568 on-base percentage. On the campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (26) more than he has struck out (25). Leblanc ranks second in the International League in walk percentage (23.6 percent) and tied for third in total walks (26). His swingingstrike rate of 8.1 percent is tied for th 21st-lowest out of the circuit's 132 qualified hitters.

#### 'PFN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. That stretch saw the club's bullpen fan 35 batters (10.7 K/9) but walk 23 hitters (7.1 BB/9). However, in the 10 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 15 runs, 10 earned, on 18 hits (3.5 H/9) in 46.2 innings for a 1.93 ERA. The Shrimp bullpen has combined for 46 strikeouts (8.9 K/9) against 29 walks (6.2 BB/9) during this recent run.



#### ABOUT JEFF

-A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2022, he has already totaled 19 minor league starts in 36 career games, collecting an 8-10 record and 3.28 ERA.

-Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

-An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

#### 2022 SEASON

-Lingren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoo's between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combine, Lingren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

#### 2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

#### 2019 SEASON

--With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

#### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
