FRISCO SPLITS TWO GAMES ON FRIDAY:

The Frisco RoughRiders completed yesterday's suspended game with a 13-5 win on Friday night before the Arkansas Travelers responded with a 7-1 win in seven innings at Riders Field. Frisco (7-6) is now 2-2 against Arkansas (9-4), which had the best record in the Texas League entering this week. Now, both teams are tied for first in their respective divisions. **Tekoah Roby** (0-2) started the second game and went four innings for Frisco, allowing four runs with five strikeouts. Kyle Tyler tossed four innings for Arkansas with one run allowed before giving way to Devin Sweet (3-0), who maneuvered two scoreless innings to earn the win. **Kellen Strahm** walked twice in the ballgame, stole a base and was the lone Frisco player to score. He came home on a **Scott Kapers** sacrifice fly. Getting his second career start in center field, **Chris Seise** belted a home run in the seventh inning of the first game on Friday and went 1-for-3 in the second game. The former first-round pick homered in the second and third games of this series, the two games Frisco has won. In Friday's first game, Frisco resumed play leading Arkansas 9-0. **Luisangel Acuña** had launched a grand slam on Thursday before play was halted due to rain. Acuña added an RBI double in Friday's portion of the game to total five runs batted in, a career high for the 21-year-old.

DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN:

RoughRiders infielder **Dio Arias** crunched two home runs on Wednesday for his second multi-home run game of his career. His first, also with Frisco, took place 363 days earlier on April 21st, 2022 against Northwest Arkansas. On Thursday, Arias hit another long ball. Over his last four games, he is hitting .375 (6-for-16)/.444/1.063 with two doubles, two home runs and five RBIs.

THIS PEN IS NO BULL...:

To start this season, the RoughRiders bullpen had been brilliant, but they have faltered against a strong Arkansas offense. Through nine games, the Riders allowed zero home runs and owned a 1.76 ERA, which was second-best in Minor League Baseball. In the first four games of this series, the Riders pen owns a 5.63 ERA. On the season, three different Frisco relievers have thrown at least three times without allowing a run (**Grant Wolfram**, **Triston Polley** and **Theo McDowell**). Overall, the RoughRiders have a team ERA of 3.42 which is the second-best in the Texas League (Tulsa is first with a 3.37 ERA).

LOAD UP UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 19 at-bats with the bases loaded this season. As a team, they are hitting .368 (7-for-19)/.348/.947/1.295 with three grand slams and 22 RBIs. They are one of just two teams in Minor League Baseball with at least three grand slams this season already (Triple-A Round Rock) as **Trevor Hauver** hit one on Opening Day, **Dustin Harris** added another on Sunday in San Antonio and **Luisangel Acuña** blasted one on Thursday.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed five errors through 13 games and committed their first position player error on Sunday. The team's .989 fielding percentage is tied for second in Minor League Baseball (Memphis, .991).

WALK THIS WAY:

The Riders hitters worked 40 walks in the six games against the San Antonio Missions, which was the sixth-most in the minors last week. On the season, Frisco's 68 walks lead the Texas League while their .358 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Evan Carter** is second in the Texas League with 13 walks and is second in OBP (.525).

I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders seven wins this season have come by eight, six, seven, seven, 10, four runs and eight runs, respectively, while their six losses have come by a combined 20 runs. That gives Frisco a +30 run differential through 13 games, which is the best in the Texas League despite being tied with Amarillo (7-6 record, -15 run differential) in first in the South Division. The only team with a +20 run differential in the league is Tulsa, which is 9-4 (+29).

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in 11 of his 12 games this season, batting .378 (17-for-45)/.525/.600/1.125 with a double, three home runs, 13 walks, 15 RBIs and three stolen bases. Carter is fourth in the Texas League in average (.378), fifth in hits (17), tied for third in home runs (3), tied for second in RBIs (15), second in walks (13) and fifth in OPS (1.125). On Wednesday in San Antonio, Carter crushed a three-run home run and a solo homer for his second two-home run game of his Minor League career before adding another home run on Sunday. The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter is also the second-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo.

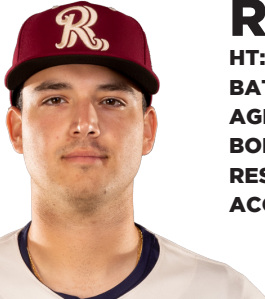

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
