**ABOUT LAST NIGHT...** Eric Rivera's two-out RBI single in the eighth inning Tuesday night broke a 2-2 tie and spurred the Vancouver Canadians to a 3-2 win over the Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks) at Ron Tonkin Field.

Rivera's clutch knock was set up by consecutive one-out walks for Ronny Brito and DJ Neal, the second of which prompted a pitching change. After a strikeout, Rivera came up with two outs and runners on first and second. The West Park, FL native jumped on the first pitch from reliever Tyler Jones and plated Brito with a line drive into centerfield that brought home the eventual game-winning run.

After Rivera gave the Canadians their second lead of the night, Justin Maese (5, 4) came on for the bottom of the eighth and needed just seven pitchers to retire the side in order – the first time a C's pitcher did that all night – before he made quick work of the Hops in the ninth to secure the 3-2 win.

Hillsboro started the scoring with a run in the third off of starter Luis Quinones thanks to a walk and two singles to start the frame, but Quinones bounced back by retiring the next three hitters to strand two runners in scoring position and keep it 1-0 Hillsboro. The right-hander went four innings, allowed one run on four hits, walked five and K'd five but did not factor into the decision.

The Canadians plated two in the fifth to take the lead. Davis Schneider launched his third home run of the year – and second against the Hops – with one out in the inning to tie the game and rattle Hillsboro starter Blake Walston, who had given up three singles, struck out eight and not allowed a runner to pass second for the first four and a third innings. After the homer, Walston issued Rivera a free pass on seven pitches before Luis De Los Santos singled and Tanner Morris walked to load the bases. Sebastian Espino put Vancouver ahead with a sharp single up the middle that caromed off of Walston's lower back and made it 2-1 Canadians.

A run in the bottom of the sixth tied the game, but the Hops ran themselves out of the lead. Cam Coursey – who had singled after a walk to start the inning to set the table for Leodany Perez's game-tying base hit to right field – was on third base with two outs and attempted to steal home, but reliever Brandon Eisert (W, 5-1) calmly stepped off the rubber and fired a perfect toss to catcher Ryan Gold to nab Coursey by three steps and end the threat. Eisert would work three innings and allow one run on three hits with a walk, a hit batter and three strikeouts to earn his team-high fifth win

**BATTLE FOR THE 'BORO:** Vancouver and Hillsboro go head-to-head this week in their second of five week-long meetings this season. The C's took four of six May 18-23 when they outscored the Hops 32-22, including a 13-4 romp in the series opener on May 18 that featured a season-high 18 hits and the first of two instances where the Canadians plated 13 runs.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS HISTORY:** July 14, 2009 – The C's broke a 2-2 tie with a Rashun Dixon double followed by a pair of sacrifices (bunt, fly) to plate the go-ahead run in a 3-2 win over Boise at The Nat. Dixon led the way with two hits while Anthony Aliotti drove in a pair. Paul Smyth earned his first win of the year with 2.2 innings of relief and Jose Guzman earned his league-best fifth save.

**ROAD DOGS:** After Davis Schneider's homer last night, the Canadians have now hit 26 of their 43 home runs this season as the away team.

**GOOD AS GOLD:** Ryan Gold's defensive prowess was on full display last night. He nabbed a pair of would-be base stealers to improve his caught stealing percentage to a team-high .443 (19-for-43) and picked off a pair of runners as well.

**ON THE HILL:** Paxton Schultz gets the nod for Vancouver tonight. In his last turn on July 8 against Spokane, the right-hander took the loss after allowing five runs on five hits – including a crucial two-out, three-run home run in the sixth – with three walks and two K's through 5.2 innings of work. Despite the loss, he bounced back well after going a season-low 3.1 innings in his previous start on July 2 at Everett. This will be his second start against Hillsboro; he last faced the Hops on May 23 when he turned in his finest outing of the year. That day, the Orem, UT native worked six shutout stanzas in which he scattered two hits, struck out five and did not walk a batter to earn his second win of the season. Schultz, 23, was the PTBNL in the trade that sent big leaguer Derek Fisher to Milwaukee.

Right-hander Brandon Pfaat (rhymes with "pot") goes for Hillsboro. In his last outing on July 8 at Tri-City, Pfaat took the loss after surrendering three runs (four earned) on five hits with three walks and nine punch outs in five innings of work. He began the year with Low-A Visalia, where he went 2-2 with a 3.17 ERA in 40.1 innings that spanned seven starts. At one point Pfaat, 22, K'd 12 in back-to-back starts (June 4 at Fresno [COL], June 11 vs. Inland Empire [LAA]). He was a fifth round pick (149<sup>th</sup> overall) out of Bellarmine (KY) last year.
