TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a sixgame home series against the Biloxi Shuckers. This is the last series between the two clubs, capping off five series and 27 total meetings.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves dropped their fifth in a row, 12-3. Cal Conley went 3-for-5 with a double and an RBI, and Luke Waddell knocked in his fourth run of the series. Luis De Avila tossed four no-hit innings before Biloxi exploded in the fifth. The Shuckers scored four in the fifth, three in the sixth and five in the eighth. Felix Valerio hit two of the Shuckers three homers.

LAST TIME VS BILOXI: The M-Braves took a sixgame series at MGM Park with four straight wins to close out the week and 14 home runs from June 29-July 3. Jesse Franklin V hit three homers on July 1, the same game Luke Waddell hit a grand slam.

JESSE'S STREAK: Jesse Franklin V is riding a 27game on-base streak*. Over the streak (July 16), he is batting .277 with four home runs, two doubles, 14 RBI, 10 walks and a .376 OBP. The streak is the longest by an M-Brave this season, and the longest active streak in the league.

CAN'T CATCH A BREAK: The M-Braves have lost 10 of their last 11 one-run games, all coming since June 18. The M-Braves are 8-20 since the All-Star Break and have lost five straight

YEAH, WE GOT PROSPECTS: The M-Braves had several players jump into the most recent pros-pect rankings on MLB Pipeline and now have nine Top-30 prospects on the roster.

The prospects include No. 11 INF Cal Conley, No. 12 OF Jesse Franklin V, No. 23 RHP Alan Rangel, No. 25 C Tyler Tolve, No. 26 LHP Luis De Avila, No. 27 INF Luke Waddell, No. 28 RHP Tyler Owens, No. 29 INF/OF Cody Milligan, No. 30 C Javier Valdes.

TOP PITCHING STAFF: The M-Braves lead the Southern League, and rank 4th in Double-A, with a 4.06 ERA. The pitching staff has given up just 84 home runs, the fewest, by three, in Double-A. The M-Braves bullpen is 4th in Double-A with a 3.69 FRA.

RETURN OF THE PEARL CITY BOMBERS: The M-Braves have two of the top-five home run hitters in the league with Drew Lugbauer (22, 1st), and Landon Stephens (18, T-5th). Cade Bunnell (13), and Jesse Franklin V (13) have double digit long balls.

M-Braves opponents have just 26 home runs at Trustmark Park this season.

GRAND SALAMI TIME: The M-Braves have a club record six grand slams, including the first-ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell). Waddell hit grand slams on June 16 at Pensacola and July 1 at Biloxi.

SLUGBAUER TO TRIPLE-A: 1B Drew Lugbauer was promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett on Tuesday. He recorded his first career three-homer game and the first in Trustmark Park history on August 5 vs Montgomery. He went on a 14-game hitting streak from June 1-July 23, batting .465 with 5 2B, 4 HR, 11 RBI, 8 BB, .558 OBP, and 1.418 OPS over the streak. It's the club's longest hitting streak this season.

LEAGUE AFFILIATE OF THE

Despite not qualifying for the league leaders due to an IL stint, Lugbauer currently leads the Southern League with 22 home runs, and ranks among the Southern League leaders in RBI (58, 10th), and extra-base hits (37, T-8th).

Lugbauer has eight home runs, 15 RBI, 1.131 OPS, and 42 total bases in his last 15 games.

He's the first M-Braves player to ever have multiple 20-home run seasons. In 283 games for the M-Braves, Lugbauer slashed .231/.342/.491 with 68 home runs, 53 doubles, two triples, and 191 RBI. On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mileper-hour home run, ranking 5th among MLB players for hardest-hit balls.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record, and Double-A franchise record 68 home runs over parts of three seasons. Lugbauer also has a club-record 191 RBI. He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022.

WADDYYY: Luke Waddell ranks 8th in the League with a .283 batting average and ranks 8th in the league with a .389 OBP.

COUNTIN' ON CAL: Cal Conley leads the league with 108 games played, and ranks among the league leaders in hits (96, 6th), and stolen bases (25, T-9th).

HOT SOUP COMIN' THROUGH: Drew Campbell just lost an eight-game hitting streak that ran from July 30-August 12, batting .500 (13-for-26) with a double, home run, four RBI, four runs, two walks, and two stolen bases over the streak. He has 13 hits in 10 games in August.

DE AVILA DELIVERS: Luis De Avila delivered 11 hitless innings in two starts on July 17 and 23, earning SL Pitcher of the Week. The lefty delivered five solid starts in June, going 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 28.0 innings. He has three shutouts in his last six starts. After a team-most 20 starts, De Avila ranks among the league leaders in ERA (3.23, 3rd), opponent average (.224, 3rd) and WHIP (1.33, 7th).

THE HARTFORD BRAVES: On July 24, Atlanta announced a trade with the Colorado Rockies for RHP Pierce Johnson, RHP Victor Vodnik (No. 10) and RHP Tanner Gordon (No. 26) were sent to the Rockies organization. Both were assigned to Double-A Hartford after the trade.

On August 1. Atlanta announced another trade with Colorado, sending M-Braves RHP Alec Barger for LHP Brad Hand, a three-time all-star. Barger was also assigned to Double-A Hartford after the trade.

TODAY'S GAME

- Robles will appear in his 20th game of the season and 18th for the M-Braves. This will
 be his first start since July 30, and fourth career start against Biloxi.
- Robles ranks top 5 in the league in ERA (3.94, 5th), and WHIP (1.28, 4th).

LAST TIME OUT

Robles started on Sunday against Rocket City, but the game was suspended after
one inning. On July 30, Robles logged his second-straight quality start, and seventh
of the season in a win over Pensacola, 10-5, on July 30. He allowed two runs on five
hits with two walks, and three strikeouts.

2023 NOTES

- Appeared in Atlanta's spring training, picked up a save in one relief appearance, tossing a scoreless inning.
- Broke camp with Mississippi, but was transferred to Gwinnett before the M-Braves' season began, on April 4.
- Made two starts for Triple-A Gwinnett in April, going 0-2 with eight earned runs in 7.2 innings
- Tossed 7.0 innings of shutout relief, coming into the game after a long rain delay on May 5 at Pensacola. Robles posted the longest shutout relief appearance in club history. The left-hander gave up just three hits and a walk with seven strikeouts.
- Logged a career-high 11 strikeouts on May 13 vs. Chattanooga, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 ER, 2 BB. 11 SO
- In May, went 2-2 with a 2.20 ERA in 28.2 innings over five games, four starts. Robles
 posted two quality starts. His 28.2 innings in May ranked 2nd in the league.
