LAST GAME

The Baysox opened their six-game set with the Erie SeaWolves with a 9-4 victory on Tuesday night. It was an impressive performance for right-hander Chayce McDermott, who picked up his fourth win of the season. After allowing a run on two hits in the first inning, McDermott only allowed one hit and one walk the rest of the way, striking out seven on the evening and tossing a career-high 94 pitches through his five innings of work. The Baysox took a 2-1 in the top of the second on a two-run, opposite-field home run from Maverick Handley on the first pitch he saw with Bowie this season. Cesar Prieto tallied three hits and four RBI on the night, including a two-run double in both the third and fourth inning - part of three and four run frames for the Baysox respectively to build a commanding 9-1 advantage. Bowie chased Erie starter Brant Hurter after just 4.1 innings, handing him his second loss of the season, with three of the five runs he allowed being earned. Joseph Rosa picked up a hit and an RBI in his Baysox debut, while Coby Mayo (21 games) and John Rhodes (23 games) each extended their on-base streaks.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Erie SeaWolves enter tonight with a record of 29-23 - tied with the Altoona Curve atop the Eastern League Southwest division. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, Erie has won seven of its last 10 games, including taking five of six against Richmond this past week. Despite Tuesday night's loss, the SeaWolves are 21-10 since entering their first series with the Baysox back in the beginning of May, where they took four of six in Bowie. Erie has not lost a series in that span, and outscored opponents 213-127, after entering the series with Bowie last month holding the worst run differential in the league at -51. No. 2 Tigers/No. 84 overall prospect (via MLB Pipeline) Colt Keith leads a SeaWolves offense that collectively paces the league in OPS (.769) and slugging (.416). Keith ranks second in the league in average (.325) and hits (63), while sitting third in OPS (.965) and extra-base hits (25) and was named the Eastern League's Player of the Month for May on Monday. Keith joins RHPs Wilmer Flores (No. 4 DET), Ty Madden (No. 5 DET), and Dylan Smith (No. 15 DET), alongside LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21 DET), as well as INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8 DET) and Gage Workman (No. 28 DET) as other notable prospects on the Erie roster.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Keider Montero is tonight's projected starter for the SeaWolves. Montero is coming off his best outing at the Double-A level last Thursday against Richmond, where he threw six shutout innings, allowing just two hits and two walks, while striking out a career-high nine batters. The six-year veteran of the Tigers' system made his long-awaited Double-A debut in Bowie against the Baysox back on 5/3, where he took a no decision after allowing four earned runs on five hits with three strikeouts and a season-high five walks. Still just 22 years old, Montero has allowed 31 hits in 25.2 innings through his first stint at the Double-A level, including four home runs, but has struck out 30 batters to accompany 15 walks. An international free agent signed by the Tigers in 2016 out of Venezuela, Montero features a fastball that tends to sit in the mid-90s, alongside a high-70s-low-80s curveball, and a mid-80s changeup.

DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo leads the Double-A level with 19 doubles and is second with 27 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles/No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has doubled in seven of his last nine games, and has at least one extra-base hit in 12 of his last 15 contests, following his two-bagger on Tuesday. Mayo also leads the Baysox with 25 RBI, 30 walks, and a .917 OPS. He is in the midst of a 21-game on-base streak - third-longest by a member of the Baysox this season (John Rhodes - 23 [Active], Heston Kjerstad - 29).

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 67 hits and a .354 average. Tuesday night's three-hit performance was the seventh of the season for Prieto, who has now hit safely in 41 of 48 games this season, with 19 multi-hit games. Last night was also the second game this season where Prieto drove in at least four runs, alongside a 5 RBI performance against Altoona on 5/18. Tuesday night served as a breakout of sorts for Prieto, who had hit just .225 (9-for-40) in the previous two series. The No. 16 Orioles' prospect leads the Baysox with a .402 on-base percentage this season.

LEADING THE WAY, AWAY FROM HOME

The Baysox sport a 3.08 staff ERA in road contests this season. That is the best mark at the Double-A level and the fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Despite an overall road record of 9-12 on the season, which has been due in part to poor run support, Bowie has bucked that trend as of late. The Baysox have won five of their last seven games away from home, with the offense averaging 5.14 runs per game in that stretch, after scoring just 3.09 runs per game in the 11 prior contests outside of Prince George's Stadium, where Bowie went 2-9.

CAREER NOTES

- 2022: Had a stellar month of May, where he pitched to a 0.49 ERA and held opponents to a .098 average - was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month.
- Struggled in the two months afterward, moving on-and-off the 7-day injured list while posting a 6.57 ERA through June and July, before being placed on the injured list for the remainder of the season on August 4. Control issues also resurfaced in June in July with twice as many walks in each month as he had in April or May.
- College: Transferred to UT-Arlington from Weatherford College in 2020, after pitching at Weatherford for two seasons.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/12 Pitched in relief of Chayce McDermott, allowed a solo home run in his third inning of work after striking out two batters to start the frame.
- 4/19 First start. Struck out the first four batters faced, and retired the first nine. Did not allow a hit until the fifth inning, where he allowed two runs.
- 4/26 Pitched in relief of Connor Gillispie. Retired the first two batters faced, but still allowed a run in the same inning. Third inning of work struggled, allowing a walk and two doubles with one out.
- 5/3 Second start, allowed a leadoff home run in the second inning, and five runs in the fourth on four-straight baserunners and another homer
- 5/9 Relieved Houston Roth. Single and two walks to open his second inning of work eventually led to two runs
- 5/14 Third start. Gave up two extra-base hits and had no strikeouts
- 5/21 Relieved Justin Armbruster. Walked two batters in first inning of work, and allowed an unearned run on a passed ball, but still struck out three in the frame,
