FRES-NOTES

ROARING INTO THE POSTSEASON: On September 7th, the Fresno Grizzlies clinched a playoff berth with an 11-5 win over the Modesto Nuts at John Thurman Field. Fresno bunched the first of two tickets into the Low-A West playoffs and will take on the San Jose Glaints, after they clinched on September 10th. The playoffs will be a best of five series starting Tuesday, September 21st in Fresno. The last time the Grizzlies made the postseason was 2018 when they were apart of the Houston Astros organization. The Grizzlies eventually fell to the Memphis Redbirds in the PCL Championship. Prior to that, Fresno made the postseason in 2015, where they would go on to win the PCL and Triple-A National Championships, also with the Astros system.

GIANT AMOUNT OF HISTORY: Fresno and San Jose will meet 30 times in the regular season and up to another five possible times in the postseason (25% of the regular season schedule) in 2021. Of their 27 games against one another this year, Fresno holds a 15-12 season-lead with 19 of those contests being decided by one or two runs. The last time that these two teams were in the same league was in 1988. The Girzzlies were known as the Fresno Suns and did not have an affiliate tre. While San Jose were named and associated with the Giants organization. San Jose is still at the same ballpark as the last time these two teams faced off against each other. At the end of the 1987 season, the Fresno Giants were crowned league champions.

RUNNING WILD: The Fresno Grizzlies have been running wild on the basepaths this season. Fresno currently leads the Low-A West and are fourth in all of Minor League Baseball with 218 stolen bases. The 218 swipes are now the Grizzlies franchise record for the most team steals in a single season, which was initially held by the 2011 team (209). Julio Carreras was the recipient of the record-breaking steal in the fourth inning on September 4th at Stockher sthree players that are ranked in the Top Five of the Low-A West leaderboard and one player in the Top Two of Minor League Baseball in swipes. Rockies #30 prospect Eddy Diaz ranks first with 46 stolen bases in 60 attempts (Grizzlies, Low-A West) and ranks second in all of Minor League Baseball with 57 swipes in 75 tries (Spokane and Fresno). Rockies top prospect Zac Veen is second with 36 steals in 53 attempts and Bladimir Restituyo is tied for fourth with 31 swipes in 36 tries, all with the Grizzlies.

DIAZ SPRINTS INTO THE RECORD BOOKS: Eddy Diaz swiped one bag September 7th against the Modesto Nuts, giving him 46 stolen bases with the Grizzlies on the season. Diaz is in sole possession of second place on the Grizzlies' franchise single-season steals list. Up next on the list is Tyler Graham, who swiped 60 bases back in 2011. Diaz's 46 Fresno stolen bases are also more than three full season Minor League teams (Rochester, Las Vegas and Portland) and his 57 swipes between two levels are more than nine full season Minor League teams.

VEEN RACES INTO THE RECORD BOOKS TOO: The Grizzlies stole eight bases on September 3rd against the Stockton Ports, tying a season-high (June 9 at Modesto). Four of the eight stolen bases came from Zac Veen. The Rockies top prospect has 36 overall stolen bases on the season, which now puts him in a tie for fifth place on the Grizzlies' franchise single-season steals list. Veen's four stolen bases on the night also ties him with Ermmanuel Burns; (2011) for the most swipes in a single game in franchise history. Burriss is the current hitting coach for the Oklahoma City Dodgers, the Triple-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

ROMO RUNS INTO THE RECORD BOOKS AS WELL: Fresno stole seven bases on September 7th against the Modesto Nuts en route to clinching a playoff berth. Four of the seven stolen bases came from Drew Romo. His four stolen bases on the evening ties him with Zac Veen (four days apart) and Emmanuel Burriss (2011) for the most swipes in a single game in franchise history. The Rockies #8 do verall and top catching prospect has 22 stolen bases on the season, which now places him fourth on the club. Romo's 22 stolen bases are the most ever by a Grizzlies catcher and second all-time on the Fresno catcher leaderboard. The only player ahead of Romo is Roland LeBlanc, who stole 29 bases in 1955 for the Fresno Cardinals (California League). LeBlanc was converted from an outfielder to a catcher after gaining weight when he returned home from war. During the 1942 season, LeBlanc mass catcher Frank Zera joined the Marine Corps. LeBlanc became a pilot with the Frying Tigers and filew the infamous Himalayan route known as 'the hump.' Zera was killed in the battle of Okinawa as he stood alongside General Simon Bolivar Buckner, who was the highest ranking American officer ever killed in a war. When LeBlanc returned from the War, he had gained a lot of weight. So much that the Cardinals decided his days the outfell devere over and converted him to catcher for the 1947 season at Omaha. From 1950-1957, LeBlanc made a couple stirts with the Fresno Cardinals, spending time as both a player and manager.

ROARING ON THE ROAD: Fresno finished the regular season winning 22 of their last 28, 24 of their last 31 and 30 of their last 39 road games. In that span, the Grizzlies pitching staff tossed five shutbuts and allowed three runs or fewer 25 times (23-2 record). Over 10 away series this year, the Grizzlies did not lose one of them, picking up seven wins and three ties. Fresno has also won or led their last 12 series (home and away) with their most recent series loss coming versus Stockton from June 15th-20th (2-4).

WEAR THE BEAR: Scarlet (41-21), Cream (10-4), Black & Gold (8-3), Fresno Tacos (2-1), Gray (9-7), Specialty Promo (2-1), Lowriders de Fresno (Copa de la Diversion, 1-2), Red Pants (5-3), The Grizzlies need to win one game to clinch the North division and best record in Low-A West.
