SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 5-4, in 10 innings. Richmond led, 4-1, entering the eighth. Liover Peguero closed the score to 4-2 with an RBI single in the top of the eighth and Abrahan Gutierrez tied the score, 4-4, with a two-run homer the ninth. Claudio Finol gave Altoona a 5-4 lead with a sac fly in the top of the 10th and Travis MacGregor held Richmond off the board in the bottom of the inning. The Flying Squirrels took a 2-0 lead in the third on a homer by **Marco Luciano**, his third in the last two games. The Curve closed the gap to 2-1 in the fourth with an RBI single by Mason Martin. In the seventh, Simon Whiteman brought in two runs with a double to open a 4-1 lead. Landen Roupp and Carson Seymour each allowed one run over four innings of work.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-day, seven-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today is the 6th of 24 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 4-1 at Prince George's Stadium from April 25-29. The Sunday finale of that series was rained out. The Baysox will come to The Diamond for six-game sets from July 4-9 and August 8-13.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won three-of-five since Wednesday, and split last week's series against the Curve. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 24-of-their-last-35. Their 11-24 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 197.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 287.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.23 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and the fifth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE BAYSOX are in last place in the Southwest Division but won five-of-six last week in Erie. Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Bowie players, including INF Coby Mayo (No. 9), LHP Cade Povich (No. 10), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 15), INF Cesar Prireto (No. 16), RHP Justin Armbruester (No. 22) and OF John Rhodes (No. 26). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Bowie players, including Mayo (No. 8), Povich (No. 11), Prieto (No. 16), McDermott (No. 17), Rhodes (No. 19) and Armbruester (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Carson Whisenhunt makes his second Double-A start. In his debut last Wednesday, he threw five scoreless innings with seven strikeouts against the Curve at The Diamond. He closed his time with High-A Eugene with five scoreless innings on May 31 at Vancouver and struck out seven straight batters from the third through fifth innings. He was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month for May. During his time in High-A, Whisenhunt led the Northwest League in ERA (1.42), strikeouts (36), BAA (.107) and WHIP (0.67). He allowed one-or-less hits in five-of-his-six starts for the Emeralds. Whisenhunt began the season with the Low-A San Jose Giants before being promoted to Eugene on April 26. A native of Winston-Salem, N.C., Whisenhunt pitched two seasons at East Carolina University in Greenville, N.C. He was selected by the Giants in the second round (66th overall) in the 2022 MLB Draft. Whisenhunt is rated by Baseball America as the No. 8 Giants prospect and No. 8 by MLB.com.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Carlos Tavera makes his sixth start and 11th appearance of the year. He last pitched on Wednesday in Erie and allowed three runs over four innings in a no-decision. In his previous start on June 1, his last one at Prince George's Stadium, he tied a career high with 10 strikeouts in four innings against the Senators. He has made one start against the Flying Squirrels, allowing a season-high five runs over 2.2 innings on April 26 in Bowie. Tavera was selected in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Orioles out of UT-Arliington. Last year, he made 16 starts for High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with 4.40 ERA.

LOVE LUC: On Saturday night, Marco Luciano hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the furth Lub- On Saturday night, Marco Luciano hit a grand siam and a two-run nomer in the Hying Squirreis 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep twice in the ACL on July 2, 2019. He also had a pair of two-homer games with Low-A San Jose on May 19 and June 29, 2021. His six RBIs was a new career high. The second-inning grand slam was the third of his professional career, with the others coming with High-A Eugene on August 19 and August 30, 2022. He went deep again with a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon. Since he began his season with his Double-A debut on May 3, his eight home runs are tied for the fifth-most in the Eastern League.

WELCOME BACK, WADE: Wade Meckler was reinstated from the injured list on Saturday after missing 12 games. In his first game back, he reached base three times with two walks and a two-run double. For the year, Meckler leads all minor league hitters (min. 120 PA) in batting average (.414) and ranks 11th in OBP (.468). He has picked up 10 hits and five walks in his eight Double-A games since being promoted from High-A Eugene on May 17.

MARTY PARTY: After missing 39 games with a hand injury, Brandon Martorano was reinstated from the injured list on Thursday and played his first game for the Flying Squirrels since April 20. In his third at-bat leading off the bottom of the seventh, he broke the shutout and the no-hit bid with a solo home run. He added a hit on Friday night and played center field for the first time in his career. Martorano is playing his third season with Richmond. He first joined the team mid-way through the 2021 season and spent all of 2022 in the Eastern League. In his 141 Double-A games, Martorano has homered 17 times and has 69 RBIs.

GLOW SHOW: Infielder **Jimmy Glowenke** was promoted to Double-A on May 30. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542) at the time of his promotion. He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league. He has hit safely in eight-of-his-last-nine games, including four hits in his last three since Friday.

WHERE THERE'S A WILLIAMS THERE'S A WAY: Carter Williams has hit safely in each of his last 11 games since May 27. During that stretch, he is batting .357 (15-for-42) with two homers, three doubles, three RBIs and 11 runs scored. His 11-game hit streak is the longest active streak in the Eastern League. It is also the longest by a Richmond player this year, ahead of a nine-game streak by **Carter Aldrete** from May 19-28. Last year in his first full professional season, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, which ranked second among Giants minor league hitters (min. 300 PA).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for second in triples (3). Hayden Cantrelle is tied for ninth in walks (34). Evan Gates is tied for ninth in saves (4). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for seventh in strikeouts (63). Carson Seymour is 10th in ERA (3.35).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Cesar Prieto is first in batting average (.362), fifth in OBP (.409), ninth in OPS (.892), first in hits (75) and tied for fifth in total bases (100). Coby Mayo is sixth in OBP (.404), 10th in SLG (.513), 10th in hits (54), first in doubles (19), tied for ninth in walks (34), third in extra-base hits (28) and tied for sixth in total bases (99)

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best curveball and **José Cruz** is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 18 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).
