Reading finishes a six-game series with game six tonight against Somerset. Reading has a 10-7 edge and cliched the season series over Somerset.

R-Phils.

Reading bounced back with an 8-7 win over Somerset last night. Oliver Dunn homered again and Baron Radcliff hit a go-ahead home run in the sixth inning. Nick Ward contributed a clutch two-run single in the seventh that proved to be the game-winning hit. Matt Osterberg started and went five innings and the bullpen combined to allow two-earned runs on two hits over four innings. Orion Kerkering worked around ninthinning trouble to pick up his second save of the week, and also his second Double-A save.

Dunn's Week

Oliver Dunn homered last night, marking his fourth long ball in five games this week. Dunn is 6-17 (.353) with eight RBI this week and an OPS of 1.535. His 21st home run of the season ties him with Carlos De La Cruz for the team lead and also tied for third in the Eastern League. His 75 RBI also lead the team and is the active lead in the league. In August, Dunn is hitting .364, with 10 homers and 27 RBI across 17 games. He also owns a 1.306 OPS. Against his former team Somerset, Dunn is hitting .300.

Nick Ward's strong start with Reading continued last night. He had two hits, including a two-run single in the seventh that was the eventual game-winning hit. Over seven games, Ward is hitting .346 with seven RBI and an OPS of 1.073. He is a local product, playing his high school baseball at Unionville High School and collegiately at West Chester University. Ward signed with the Phillies in December and played for Great Britain in the World Baseball Classic.

Wonderful Wilson

Ethan Wilson's also enjoyed a strong week against Somerset. He's hitting .353 this week with two doubles and has driven in two runs. Wilson's two doubles last night matched a season high. He's walked four times and has an on-base percentage of .476 for the week.

Around the Organization

The Phillies defeated the Nationals 12-3 last night, thanks to an eight-run eighth inning. They complete this weekend's series at Bowman Field in Williamsport for the Little League Classic. Lehigh Valley beat Jacksonville 4-1 last night as Tyler Phillips tossed a gem; seven innings, one run and four strikeouts. Jersey Shore fell 6-4 to Asheville as Justin Crawford added two-more stolen bases to get him to 43 on the season. Clearwater bear Dunedin 3-1 as Emaarion Boyd had two hits and also stole his 50th base of the season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 20, 1983: At Glens Falls, Reading beats the White Sox, 8-7, as Darren Daulton and Mike La Valliere each connect for home runs in a decisive 6-run 7th inning rally. Jeff Stone breaks Bob Dernier's franchise stolen base record by swiping his 72nd base. He would finish with 90 SBs.

Somerset enters tonight with the best-overall record in the Eastern League at 66-46, which saw them win the first half title. The Patriots are 24-20 in the second half, which currently sees them in first in the division. Somerset and Binghamton split a six-game series last week in New Jersey. Next up, Somerset returns home and welcomes Hartford. One of the Yankees' top prospects Jasson Dominguez headlines a Somerset team loaded with talent. Ben Rice has been a force since joining Somerset and both Rice and Dominguez have left strong marks on this series.

Patriot Pitcher

Righty Blane Abeyta starts tonight for Somerset. It'll be Abeyta's third start agasinst Reading this season. On May 21, he suffered a loss as he allowed two runs with seven strikeouts over 5.2 innings. On July 7, Reading tagged him for three runs and struck out eight time as Abeyta suffered a loss over 5.1 innings pitched. Overall in 2023, Abeyta is 7-6, with a 5.65 ERA over 20 games and 18 starts (100.1 IP, 102 H, 40 BB, 103 SO). He last threw last Sunday against Binghamton, earning a win going six-innings pitched, while allowing just one hit, no runs and had seven strikeouts. Abeyta spent all of 2022 with High-A Hudson Valley, where he went 5-8 with a 4.47 ERA over 23 games and 20 starts. He split 2021 between the FCL Yankees and Single-A Tampa. THe 24-year old signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent out of Nevada in 2020. He listed Roy Halladay as his sports hero growing up. He spent 2020 at Nevada and 2018-19 at Modesto Junior College before transfering to the Wolfpack.
