Back at Home

The Fightin Phils return home to open a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the first of 18 matchups between the teams this season, with nine at each location. Reading won the season-series over Sometset in 2023 10-8, which included a 2-4 record at home and 8-4 on the road Lachlan Wells is on the mound for Reading, opposite Zach Messinger for Somerset.

Finished on a High Note

Reading was victorious Sunday 5-4, in the series finale at Binghamton. Robert Moore led the way with two hits and three RBI. The bullpen combined for 6.1 IP, 3 H and 1 ER. The R-Phils won three-of-four to finish the series to earn their first series-split of the season.

Bullpen Success

After a slow start to the season, Reading's bullpen found much success at Binghamton last week. Over the six games, the group allowed seven-earned runs over 26.2 IP, which is good for a 2.36 ERA for the week.

Rincones Rolling

Gabriel Rincones Jr. stayed hot Sunday afternoon with his team-leading third double of the season. Last week, Rincones slashed .333/.391/.429, with a .820 OPS, adding two doubles and a stolen base. Rincones Jr. also currently has an 11-game on-base streak.

Amongst the League Leaders

A variety of Fightin Phils find themselves amongst the qualified league leaders in the Eastern League. Carson Taylor ranks tied for thrid in homers (4), and locked for second in RBI (14). Robert Moore is tied for seventh in OBP (.415), while Gabriel Rincones Jr. is eighth in SLG (.571) and 10th in OPS (.971). Marcus Lee Sang is tied for first in walks (10). Taylor is seventh in total bases (26), while Rincones is tied for sixth in runs (10). On the pitching side, Matt Osterberg is ninth in ERA (1.98) and Carlos Francisco is tied for first in appearances (6).

Who's On First, Nope Actually in Center Field

After making his first pro appearances in center field on Apr. 12 against Portland, Casey Martin made his first pro start at center on Sunday at Binghamton. He also knocked his first triple of the season to end the series on a high note. Martin went 3-8, with two runs scored, two XBH (3B and HR) and two RBI over the final two games he played in last week.

Magic Number

Five runs is appearing to be the magic number in runs scored for the Fightin Phils this season. So far, Reading is 6-1 when scoring north of five runs in a game this season, while the Fightin Phils are 0-8 when failing to hit the five-run plateau.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 23, 1967: At York, the R-Phils improve to 2-0 by winning their first road game, 6-5, behind a complete game by future Philadelphia manager Dallas Green. Green, who is also Reading's pitching coach, allows two unearned runs in the bottom of the 9th but gets Bill Vickery to pop out with the tying run on third to end it.

Somerset Synopsis

Somerset enters today with a 7-8 record, after going 3-3 vs Hartford last week. After this week, the Patriots host New Hampshire. Somerset finished 84-53 last season and ultimately lost to Binghamton in the Eastern League Semifinals. Nine of the Yankees' top-30 prospects are on Somerset's roster, featuring: Spencer Jones (2), Chase Hampton (4), Brock Selvidge (10), Ben Rice (12), Agustin Ramirez (21), Zach Messinger (22), Trystan Vierling (23), Jack Neely (25), Tyler Hardman (26) and Danny Watson (28). DJ Lemeiahu is also expected to make a rehab appearance this week.

Patriots Pitcher

Righty, and Yankees No. 22 Prospect, Zach Messinger gets the ball to open the series tonight. He's 0-1, with a 5.29 ERA over three starts this season. He allowed three-earned runs over five innings last Wednesday against Hartford. Messinger made 21 appearances with High-A Hudson Valley last season and one start with Somerset, going 1-10, with a 4.35 ERA. He made 31 appearances (16 starts) with Single-A Tampa in 2022, going 1-8 with a 4.30 ERA. The Yankees drafted Messinger in the 13th round of the 2021 draft out of Virginia.

Went 6-0 with a 0.94 ERA. Struck out 63 hitters across 47.2 innings pitched. Posted 11.9 strikeouts per nine innings and a 9.0 strikeout to walk ratio (63 SO, 7 BB). 
