#### TODAY'S HEADLINES

## Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 281-264 LAST TIME OUT: The Saints could not get after Indianapolis starter Thomas Harrington in a 3-0 loss on Saturday. Harrington retired the first 15 Saints he faced before Rylan Bannon broke up the perfect game with a leadoff infield single in the sixth. Randy Dobnak took the loss, allowing one run over 4.0 innings in his first start back with St. Paul. Indy got back-to-back home runs in the sixth inning to extend the lead to 3-0. Once again in the ninth, the Saints got the tying run to the plate, but

could not plate a run in the 3-0 defeat.

ON THE SKID: The Saints have dropped their last eight games, their longest losing streak of the season and the second-longest streak in franchise history. There has been only one other skid of eight-or-more games, the franchise-record 11 consecutive losses from May 8-20, 2022 During this eight-game skid, the Saints have been out-scored 45-31 and been out-hit 83-58.

S All eight losses have been decided by three-or-fewer runs. The tying run has been at the plate or on base in seven of the eight losses, with the only other being the 6-5 walk-off loss on Wednesday

NO NO-NO: Saturday's game marked the sixth time this season, and the third time in August, that the Saints did not have a hit through the first five innings of the game. It also was the second instance in 10 days that the first 15 batters were retired, replicating what Matt Boyd accomplished with Columbus on August 7. The Saints are 1-5 this season when not getting a hit in the first five innings, with the lone win coming on August 7, after Boyd had a perfect game through 5.2 innings.

**SUNDAY SCARIES:** The Saints have struggled in the series finale in their last nine series, going 3-7. They have been out-scored 79-53 in their last nine finales, an average of 7.9 runs for the opposition, compared to 5.3 for the Saints, despite being out-hit only 107-100 in that

FINDING THE GAPS: The long ball has not been much of a factor for the Saints in the month of August, hitting a Triple-A-low eight homers this month. However, they have still gotten extra-base hits, hitting 35 doubles in August, most in Triple-A. The Saints' four triples in August are also tied for the sixth-most in Triple-A. The club's .367 slugging percentage this month is 16<sup>th</sup> in the International League.

Doubleheaders 0-1-2 percentage is the lowest against any team in a single season since joining the International League in 2021. Over the course of a season series (minimum six games), the Saints have been held to two-or-fewer six games and the saints ha Run Differential ......-7 (603-610) (minimum six games).

> **ELECTRIC EELES:** Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .419 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 28 of the 33 games he's played in, drawing 17 walks and been hit by a pitch five times. He is fifth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .441 across three levels. Of the four players ahead of him, only two have played in Triple-A.

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 60 games since May 21, he has hit .329 (74-for-226), with 12 home runs, drawing 40 walks, owning a .961 OPS. In that time, Severino leads the league in batting average, ranks second in OPS, third on-base percentage (.423) and in RBI (48), sixth in seventh percentage at .538 and 74hits. His 40 walks Days In Fourth Place ...... 5 since May 21 are the ninth-most in the league.

> TWINS UPDATE: The Twins took game three of their series against Texas, winning 5-2. David Festa allowed two runs over 5.0 innings of work, but it was Ronny Henriquez who got his first MLB win of the season, throwing 2.0 shutout innings of relief. Willi Castro drove in three in the eighth inning to give Minnesota the lead.

**ON THE FAST TRACK:** Morris will be pitching at his third different level of minor league baseball with the Saints in 2024, but it won't be the first time he's accelerated at a faster pace that his peers. He graduated high school at only 16 years old, starting his freshman season of college at just 17. He was born on the cutoff date of September 1 for starting school and his mother chose to start him in kindergarten a year ahead. Not only that, he also skipped second grade as he was being homeschooled in Alaska.

**BUILDING UP TRAVEL POINTS:** Although he was born in Manhattan, Morris claims Boulder, Colorado as his hometown. He moved from New York as a child to Oregon, then to Alaska and then to Colorado, where he attended Monarch High School in Boulder. He tells people Boulder is where he's from as that is where he lived the longest.
