ENCARNACION LEADS SHRIMP TO 5-1 WIN

Jerar Encarnacion blasted two home runs in Thursday's 5-1 Jacksonville win over Norfolk. After the Tides scored a run two batters into the bottom of the first on Heston Kjerstad's RBI single, Encarnacion mashed a two-run shot in the second to put the Jumbo Shrimp in front. The score remained that way until the fifth. Jordan Groshans collected an RBI single before Encarnacion crushed his second two-run homer of the game to make it 5-1. Daniel Castano worked 5.1 innings of one-run ball, and the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen combined for 3.2 scoreless frames.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 53 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 86-for-221 at the plate, slashing .389/.441/.511/.952 with seven doubles, one triple, six home runs, 38 RBIs and 48 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in the Minor League Baseball in batting average (.678) and fourth in the International League in OBP (.438). Among the 315 players in the IL with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023, Edwards has the third-best swinging-strike rate (4.3 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 51 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 52-for-178 (.292/.368/.674/1.042) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 18 home runs, 51 RBIs and 35 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season. Allen is fanning just 20.8 percent of the time in 2023.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City. In 14 games with Jacksonville, Johnston is 23-for-58 (.397/.453/.707/1.160) with seven doubles, one triple, three home runs and 12 RBIs. Johnston has had at least one hit in every game, including eight multi-hit contests. Perhaps not coincidentally, since Johnson's return on July 25, the Jumbo Shrimp have posted a 10-5 record. Including his time with Double-A Pensacola in 2023, Johnston has driven in 95 runs, the most of any MiLB player, in 97 games.

SIXPENCE NONE THE RICHER

By knocking off Norfolk 5-1 on Thursday, Jacksonville earned their sixth consecutive win - the club's longest winning streak since taking seven straight contests from April 15-22 of the 2022 campaign. Over this current six-game stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp offense leads Triple-A in both batting average (.342) and hits (75), ranks third in on-base percentage (.408), slugging percentage (.553) and OPS (.961), respectively, sixth in runs scored (46, 7.7 per game) and seventh in home runs (10). The club also ranks second in ERA (3.17), runs allowed (20, 3.3 per game) and walks (16), respectively. Only two of Jacksonville's six wins on this run have come by three runs or fewer.

IT ALL STARTS WITH THIS

Jacksonville's current six-game winning streak has seen the club's starting pitcher surrender three runs or fewer in all six contests. During this run. Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have worked 32.0 innings out of the club's 54.0 innings thrown (59.3 percent). Jacksonville starters had tossed 52.2 percent of the team's innings prior to this run. Additionally, during this six-game roll, Jumbo Shrimp starters are 4-0 with a 2.53 ERA (10 R, 9 ER in 32.0 innings). They have combined for 24 strikeouts (6.8 K/9) against only six walks (1.7 BB/9) and 31 hits allowed (8.7 H/9).

MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In his 39 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 57-for-160, hitting .356/.402/.488/.890 with 11 doubles. two triples, two home runs, 15 RBIs and 29 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 11 multi-hit games in his last 27 games, batting 45-for-120 (.375/.420/.508/.928) with eight doubles, one triple, two homers, 11 RBIs and 23 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 237 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the third-highest opposite field rate (45.3 percent). His 29.5 percent line drive rate is 12th.

SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has worked nine consecutive scoreless innings. In this series, Jacksonville relievers have vielded only one run on five hits in 10.0 innings.
