JUMBO SHRIMP FALL 14-3 TO BULLS

The Durham Bulls blasted four home runs on Saturday to overpower the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp 14-3 from Durham Bulls Athletic Park. **Nathan Lukes'** RBI single opened up the scoring in the second. Later in the frame, **Wander Franco** crushed a grand slam to make it 5-0. **Esteban Quiroz** added a solo shot in the third and the Bulls scored twice more in the fifth to go up 8-0. The Jumbo Shrimp finally got on the board in the sixth on **Monte Harrison's** RBI ground out. However, **Taylor Walls** answered with a solo shot in the bottom of the sixth. Durham scored once more in the seventh, but after Jacksonville plated a pair in the top of the eighth, the Bulls added four runs in the bottom of the frame, highlighted by **Vidal Bruján's** three-run bomb to make it 14-3.

NEED FOR SPEED

Entering play on Thursday, the Jumbo Shrimp had stolen just two bases as a team, ranking in a tie for 17th in the 20-team Triple-A East. Moreover, Jacksonville had swiped just those lone two bags while getting caught stealing three times. In game one of Thursday's doubleheader **Brian Miller** reached base four times and scored three runs thanks to a career-high four stolen bases. **Jazz Chisholm** also added a theft in the contest to give the club five in the seven-inning game. Meanwhile, on Friday at Durham, the Jumbo Shrimp added three more steals, with two coming from **Monte Harrison**. Jacksonville has rocketed into a tie for fourth in Triple-A East with 10 stolen bases.

JESÚS WALKS

Jacksonville outfielder **Jesús Sánchez** has gotten off to a scorching start at the plate this season. The native of Higuey, in the Dominican Republic has hit in eight of the nine games he has appeared in, going 17-for-35 at the plate. Entering play on Sunday, Sánchez ranks first in Triple-A East in RBIs (15), second in both slugging percentage (1.057) and OPS (1.583), tied for second in home runs (5), third in batting average (.486), tied for third in hits (17) and fifth in on-base percentage (.526). Nearly one-quarter of Jacksonville's runs this year have been plated by Sánchez, and he has combined with Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Lewin Díaz** to drive in 27 of Jacksonville's 64 runs on the season, a total of 42.2 percent.

THE TWO TOWERS

Though Jacksonville lost 14-3 on Saturday at Durham - the club's worst margin of defeat since a 17-1 thumping at Mississippi on June 24, 2018 - the Jumbo Shrimp are still in position to take their series with the Bulls by winning Sunday's finale. Thus, after winning four of six with Norfolk to start the year, the Jumbo Shrimp are in rare position of winning their first two sets of the season. Jacksonville has not started a campaign with two consecutive series wins since three of five from Jackson and four of five from Huntsville in 2013.

NEARLY EVEN STEVEN

Jacksonville pitchers have worked 94.0 innings on the season, and they have been nearly perfectly divided between the club's starters and relievers. In 47.1 innings, Jumbo Shrimp starters are 3-2 with a 5.13 ERA, yielding 46 hits (8.7 H/9) and 22 walks (4.2 BB/9) to go along with 53 strikeouts (10.1 K/9). Meanwhile, the bullpen has worked 46.2 frames, posting a 4-2 record and a 4.24 ERA. Jumbo Shrimp relievers have collected 59 strikeouts (11.4 K/9) against only 11 walks (2.1 BB/9) and 47 hits allowed (9.1 H/9). Perhaps the biggest difference between the two parts of the club's staff is that Jumbo Shrimp starters are recording more ground ball outs; Jacksonville starters have recorded 1.66 ground-outs-per-air-out, a figure that places third among all starting units in Triple-A East. The club's relievers have registered a 0.58 mark, the lowest among all Triple-A East bullpens. In 2019, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers worked 730.2 of the club's 1,192.2 innings, or 61.3 percent.

SHRIMP SKEWERS

Durham is trying to force a set split after winning Saturday's game. The Bulls are currently tied with the Jumbo Shrimp at 7-4, one game back of Gwinnett... Right-hander **Luis Madero** was assigned to Jacksonville from Miami. He enjoyed his major league debut on May 10 at Arizona, notching two scoreless innings of relief... **Lewin Díaz** has opted to go to the opposite field quite frequently in 2021. The first baseman's 48.7 percent opposite-field rate is an even 14th in Triple-A out of 228 qualified hitters. Somewhat surprisingly, his BABIP is just .229, which is 49th-lowest... Please note that **Jazz Chisholm's** rehab stint is complete.

ABOUT SHAWN

-A 19th-round pick by Cleveland in the 2011 draft out of Ocean Lakes High School (Virginia Beach, Va.), Morimando was ranked as the organization's 12th-ranked prospect in 2016 and 16th-best prospect in 2017.

-Morimando made his major league debut for Cleveland on July 2, 2016. However, that debut almost did not happen. Cleveland was playing in Toronto when it decided to call-up Morimando, who was playing with Triple-A Columbus on a road trip to Pawtucket, R.I. Morimando's passport was actually in Akron, Ohio, where Cleveland's Double-A affiliate is located (the left-hander had recently been promoted from the RubberDucks). An intern in Cleveland's front office drove from Cleveland to Akron, where he met the RubberDucks' clubhouse manager, who found Morimando's apartment keys in his locker and hunted down the missing passport. The intern then drove back to Cleveland, where he met Morimando at an airport hotel following the pitcher's flight from Rhode Island. Morimando caught a 6:30 a.m. ET flight to Toronto on the morning of July 2 to make it in time for the game to make his MLB debut.

-Cleveland released Morimando in 2018, and after clearing waivers, the southpaw signed with the Toronto Blue Jays. He pitched for Triple-A Buffalo (as well as the Rookie-level GCL Blue Jays in 2018) in 2018 and 2019, but following an injury, opted for free agency following the 2019 season. Morimando spent the 2020 season pitching for Canberra in the Australian Baseball League, posting a 3-3 record and 2.87 ERA in eight games, including six starts (42.0 IP, 33 H, 10 BB, 47 K). He signed with the Marlins in February 2021.
