 NORTH LITTLE ROCK, AR - Starting pitcher Alec Marsh struck out 10 across five innings, including a stretch of eight straight, but the Northwest Arkansas Naturals provided little in the way of run support, shut out for the first time this eason by a 5-0 margin against the Arkansas Travelers. After Marsh surrendered a two-run triple in the first inning, he retired the next 11 batters in a row through the end of the fourth inning, including eight straight strikeouts, with a 1-2-3 second inning and then striking out the side in the third and fourth innings. <i>He is the first Naturals pitcher to strike out more than 6 batters in a row in one game, the 2nd to strike out 8 straight at any point, the first being Juan Abreu in 2008.</i> He allowed a pair of runners to reach in the fifth, snapping the strikeout streak, but struck out his 10th batter, setting an individual season-high for Naturals pitchers, as the Wisconsin native also pitched 5.0 complete innings for the first time this season. Holden Capps followed Marsh with 1.1 scoreless innings, then after Yefri Del Rosario stranded a pair of Capps' baserunners in the seventh, was tagged for three runs on five hits in the eighth, as Arkansas added important insurance runs. The sole hits of the night for Northwest Arkansas were all singles, in the second from John Rave, the third from Tucker Bradley and the fifth from Maikel Garcia, an inning where the Naturals stranded the bases loaded. Travelers starter Connor Jones fired 8.0 scoreless innings, allowing the three hits and just one walk, while hitting two batters and striking out eight.

The Naturals are 5-5 all-time when playing on May 20

On May 20, 2019, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals dropped a close contest to the Arkansas Travelers at Dickey-Stephens Park by a 4-3 margin. In the game, Naturals center fielder and leadoff hitter Nick Heath went 2-for-4 and stole four bases, becoming just the second Naturals player to ever accomplish that feat, the first since **Derrick** Robinson did so on April 26, 2010 and August 24, 2011. After singling to begin the game in the top of the first, Heath stole second, then stole third as a part of a double steal with Khalil Lee. He bunted for a hit in the third and stole second, then reached on an error in the eighth and stole second again, his 4th steal of the game.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 18 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?

Through 35 games, the Naturals have stolen 50 bases in 61 attempts (average 1.43 steals/game) and *pulled off a double steal 8 times*.

- 50 steals ranks third in the Texas League, tied for sixth in Double-A and tied for 28th in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's 12 steals (in 14 attempts) ranks fourth in the Texas League and tied for 10th in all of Double-A, while Nate Eaton's 10 steals (in 🔹 11 attempts) ranks tied for eighth in the league.

WHAT YOU KNOW ABOUT PITCHING DEEP?

In the month of May, Naturals starting pitchers have thrown 66.0 innings of the staff's 131.2 total (50.1%), up from 44.3% of the April innings.

- As a staff, the Naturals 4.78 ERA in the month of May ranks 4th in the Texas League, with six of 15 starts lasting 5.0 innings or longer and 12 of 4.0 innings or more.
- Across 15 May games, Naturals starting pitchers have a 3.82 ERA (28 ER in 66.0 IP) with 80 strikeouts (10.91 K/9) and a .193 opponents' average.
- innings or more in each of his last SIX outings, including a trio of scoreless starts, 6.0 innings on 4/26 vs. AMA, then 7.0 innings on 5/7 @ SPR and 5/13 vs. WCH.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring five runs or less, the Naturals are just 2-16, while 14-3 when scoring six runs or more.
- The Naturals are 5-15 when recording nine hits or less, but 11-4 when recording 10 hits or more.
- The Naturals are 16-5 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 0-14 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 13-6, whereas 3-13 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 2-8 in one-run games this season, meaning eight of their 19 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- Each of the Naturals' last three losses have been by just a run, as well as five of nine losses in the month of May.
- The Naturals have had the winning run ate the plate in five losses this season (all one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in nine losses this season (including seven of their lone-run losses).

OOPS!... **D**REW **D**ID **I**T **A**GAIN

On Monday, starting pitcher Drew Parrish was named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week, for the second consecutive week.

- In each of his last two starts, Parrish has thrown 7.0 scoreless innings, striking out four at Springfield on May 7 and tying a career-high with nine strikeouts on May 13 against Wichita.
- Among gualified Texas League pitchers, he has the lowest ERA (2.13) and WHIP (0.76), while ranking second in opponents' batting average (.158). Parrish also ranks second in the league in innings pitched (38.0) and tied for ninth in strikeouts (33).

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop Maikel Garcia has reached base in 31 of the 34 games he has appeared in this season, reaching base twice on 22 occasions.

- 26 27 28 His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year and tied for the 15th-longest in club history ... it is 29 32 also tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS. 33 34 35
- In 161 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 67 times (43 hits + 24 walks), for a .419 on-base percentage
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied fourth in steals (12), tied fifth in hits (43), tied eighth in doubles (11), tied eighth in runs scored (29) and tied eighth in walks (24) ... he ranks among the Double-A leaders in runs scored (tied 10th) and steals (tied 10th).
- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first three walk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.

PUSHIN (**P**)ORTER

Reigning Texas League Pitcher of the Week Drew Parrish has thrown 5.0 Catcher Logan Porter has guietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest, on-base percentage (.426), while ranking second in OPS (.896), third in batting average (.301) and seventh in slugging percentage (.470).
- Porter has hits in 16 of 24 games he's played in this season with eight multi-hit games, and has reached base in 22 of 24 games
- In the month of May, Porter is hitting .326 (15-for-46) with a team-best four home runs, along with eight runs batted in and a 1.013 OPS.

It's Gonna Be Massey

Since the calendar flipped to May, second baseman Michael Massey has been one of the top hitters in the Texas League, batting at a .365 (19-for-52) average with a .955 OPS across 13 games, while driving in a team-best 14 runs.

- 27 17 After two slow weeks to start the season, Massey has turned things 11 around, raising his batting average nearly 100 points, from .213 after April 21 to the .307 it sits at now. 57 44 32 35 29
- His hot streak began April 22, homering in three consecutive games, April 22 to 24 in Frisco and went from having no homers through the first 11 games of the season, to having six in his last 21, leading the team in homers.
- Massey has reached base in 26 of 33 games he's played this year, with already 12 multi-hit games, including six in May.
- Massey ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied fourth in runs batted in (30), tied eighth in hits (42) and tied 10th in doubles (10).
- The second baseman is scattered all across the Royals' organizational leaders, ranking second in total bases (70), runs batted in, hits and batting average and tied second in doubles and extra-base hits (16), also ranking third in slugging percentage (.511), fourth in OPS (.860) and tied for fourth in home runs (6).


