**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fourth in a six-game home-and-home series opposite the Fort Wayne TinCaps, the High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres, the first of three games in the Summit City. The Nuts are coming off a 4-5 homestand, winning two of three from the TinCaps after dropping four of six to West Michigan.

**Last Night: Lugnuts 2, TinCaps 1.** In front of a season high crowd of 9,917, **Brayan Buevas** made a leaping catch at the wall for the first out of the game, **Jonny Butler** made a lunging catch in left for the 27th out, and a pair of third-inning runs was enough behind 4 2/3 scoreless innings of relief from **Luis Carrasco**.

**On the Air:** Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, **Adam Jaksa** and **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** on the call.

**On Deck:** The Nuts and TinCaps play through Saturday before enjoying days off on Sunday and Monday. Then Lansing travels to Lake County to open a six-game series with the Captains leading into the Major League Baseball All-Star Break.

### LUG NOTES

**A Change From the Norm:** This is the first baseball season since 2008 that the Lugnuts have not hosted a game on Independence Day. (In that season, the Nuts returned home to host Great Lakes on July 5th following a July 4th tilt at South Bend.) The most unusual schedule occurred in 2005, in which the Nuts were on the road from June 30 - July 7, spending the 3rd in Cedar Rapids, the 4th in Dayton, and returning to Michigan's state capital on July 8th against A's-affiliated Kane County.

**Maddux Connections:** Last night, 2022 Lugnuts starter **Joey Estes** fired a complete game nine-inning shutout to beat the Angels, 5-0, on only 92 pitches. The last Major Leaguer age 22 or younger to throw a Maddux (9+ CG ShO under 100 pitches) was 2009 Lugnut **Henderson Alvarez III** on May 4, 2012, also against the Angels. The last Athletic, meanwhile, to toss a Maddux was also a Lugnut: 2013-14 Nut **Kendall Graveman**.

**Team Effort:** The Nuts' offense is tied for 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.254) and doubles (131) and ranks 1st in total bases (998), triples (32) and OPS (.737), and 2nd in runs scored (395) and slugging percentage (.392).

**To the Show:** 18-year-old **Leo Jimenez** played two games for the Nuts (at Fort Wayne, coincidentally) to end the 2019 season, the Lugnuts' last as the Single-A affiliate for the Toronto Blue Jays. Jimenez was called up Tuesday by the Blue Jays; when he makes his MLB debut, Leo will become the 188th Lugnut to reach MLB all-time and the fourth this year, joining **Max Schuemann**, **Brett Harris** and **Brady Basso**.

**What a Crowd!** The Nuts' 9,917 attendance on July 3 is the largest crowd in either Class A+ or A this season.

**Prospecting:** Lansing has four MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 24), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Brayan Buevas** (No. 29).

**History:** **Jake Garland** (5 IP), **Grant Judkins** (2 2/3) and **Colton Johnson** (1 1/3) tossed the 4th no-hitter in franchise history on June 13, blanking Cedar Rapids, 8-0, the first no-hitter in Lansing since April 21, 2003.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** A crowd of 11,114 saw the Lugnuts finally beat Lake County. After losing their first eight meetings with the Captains, in their first Midwest League season after moving from the South Atlantic League, the Lugnuts triumphed in the 10th inning when a routine two-out grounder from Justin Jackson took a bad hop over the head of second baseman Argenis Martinez, bringing in the tying and game-winning runs for a wild 7-6 Lugnuts win.

**2022:** With 10,055 in attendance, Tyler Soderstrom belted a walk-off three-run homer to center field to launch the Lugnuts to a 7-4 victory over the Great Lakes Loons (Yes, 7-4 on 7/4!). The game was a classic: Mac Lardner struck out eight batters in six shutout innings, but the Loons tied the game with an Alex De Jesus two-run double in the seventh off Brock Whittlesey. In the bottom of the eighth, after manager Phil Pohl was ejected arguing against batter interference, Kevin Richards delivered a two-out, two-run double off new Great Lakes reliever Braydon Fisher for a 4-2 lead. But with two outs in the top of the ninth, Eddys Leonard swatted a game-tying two-run homer to left-center off Trayson Kubo, setting the stage for the bottom of the ninth. It was Soderstrom's second walk-off home run of the year..

**In a Nutshell:** Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts... opened the 2024 season in a piggyback tandem with Wander Guante, who was promoted to Double-A Midland on May 14... on May 29, needed only 39 pitches to fire five scoreless innings against Peoria... promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas for an emergency relief appearances on June 23 at Tacoma, earning the win in a 20-10 victory; allowed first five batters to reach before recovering to record the next nine outs scorelessly...

**Glory Days:** Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

**Off to College:** Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

**WVU to the Pros:** First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the Fort Wayne TinCaps have featured two WVU teammates in Jackson Wolf and Ryan Berger; pitched against Bergert on May 26, 2023, and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

**Draft Day:** Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation..." Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect... Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Colby Thomas in the third round).
