LAST TIME OUT: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats scored early and struck out plenty of Reading Fightin' Phils in a 6-3 win on Tuesday night. New Hampshire struck out a season-high 18 batters on the night with 11 of the strikeouts coming from starting left-hander Ricky Tiedemann. The Blue Jays No. 1 prospect set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts in 3.2 innings. Alan Roden led off the game with a solo home run, his sixth at Double-A. Rainer Nunez drove in a pair with a single back up the middle and Trevor Schwecke made it a four-run first inning with an RBI double. Michael Turconi hit his second Double-A homer to give New Hampshire a 5-1 lead after the top of the fourth. Reading plated two unearned runs home in the fourth off Tiedemann but Will Robertson scored on a wild pitch in the seventh to extend the lead 6-3. New Hampshire's bullpen combined for 5.1 scoreless innings and seven strikeouts after the southpaw departed in the fourth. Troy Watson threw two innings with four strikeouts to pick up the win.

RICKY RETURNS TO FORM: LHP Ricky Tiedemann struck out a career-high 11 batters last night in 3.2 innings, his first double-digit strikeout performance of the year and his second of his career. At one point, the Blue Jays No. 1 prospect fanned eight batters in a row. It's the second time this year at Double-A where Tiedemann has recorded every out via the strikeout after he struck out nine in three innings in his 2023 debut on April 13 vs Portland.

HIRALDO IS HOT: 2B Miguel Hiraldo is one of the hottest hitters right now in the Fisher Cats lineup. The second baseman is hitting .349 with a team-leading seven homers and a team-leading 26 RBI in the month of August. The 22-year-old has driven in the second most RBI in the Eastern League this month and has driven in the most RBI by a Fisher Cat in a single month this

WE GO OUTTA HERE IN AUGUST: After hitting two more homers last night, New Hampshire has hit 36 home runs in August, tied for the most this month along with Reading. The last time the Fisher Cats led the league in homers for a single month was in May when they blasted 38 along with Somerset. Miguel Hiraldo, Damiano Palmegiani and Alan Roden have led the team in home runs this month with seven, six and six, respectively.

ROCKIN' AND RODEN: OF Alan Roden has been on a tear at the plate over his last 10 games. The Blue Jays No. 7 prospect is hitting .439 (18-for-41) with three doubles, four homers and eight RBI and has struck out only six times. Last night, Roden hit a leadoff homer, his sixth of the season and on the month, part of a 2-for-5 night at the plate.

MICHAEL ON THE MOUND: RHP Michael Dominguez makes his fifth Double-A start and his second against Reading. The 23year-old is coming off his best start as a Fisher Cat since being promoted on Aug. 1 where he matched his career-high nine strikeouts over 5.2 innings last Thursday against Binghamton in a no-decision. Dominguez has gone five or more innings in two consecutive starts. Last time vs Reading on Aug. 10, he struck out four and gave up four runs and walked four in 4.1 innings.

BERROA & LEO TO BUFFALO: Steward Berroa and Leo Jimenez both earned promotion to Triple-A Buffalo on Tuesday. It's the first time they have been promoted to Triple-A in their careers. Jimenez hit a career-high eight homers, drove in 44 runs, and collected 25 extra-base hits and matched the team's longest on-base streak this season, reaching in 24 consecutive games from June 16 – July 22. Berroa played 103 games with the Fisher Cats this season after playing three games in 2021 and 22 last year. He ranked second in the Eastern League at the time of his promotion with 43 stolen bases, one behind Portland's Corey Rosier.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (72-61) fell 5-4 to Washington at home last night as the Blue Jays fell 3.5 games out of the final wildcard spot. Davis Schneider cracked his sixth homer to put Toronto on the board in the third inning. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. grounded out with the bases loaded to cut the lead to one in the bottom of the ninth, but Danny Jansen popped out to end the game...Buffalo (62-63) blanked Indianapolis 2-0 on a combined five-hitter. Mitch White went the first five innings for the win. The Bisons had only three hits, one an RBI double in the second by Steward Berroa, plating Leo Jimenez. Jimenez had reached on a hit-by-pitch - and Jimenez left the game in the fourth inning after he was hit again. Both Berroa and Jimenez were playing for the first time at Triple-A...Vancouver (73-46) and Hillsboro were postponed due to unplayable field conditions...Dunedin (58-62) was rained out at Daytona Beach
