**RHP Walbert Urena (0-2, 9.00 ERA) vs. RHP Peter Heubeck (0-3, 4.94 ERA)**

**TODAY'S GAME:** Welcome to LoanMart Field, as your Quakes continue their 12-game, 13-day home stand, with game two of a six-game set against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE 66ERS:** Today is game 11 of 27 between the two clubs, with 15 of those coming here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes swept a six-game set in San Bernardino the last time these two teams matched up and after last night's loss, are 8-2 against the 66ers this year. Last season, the Quakes went 14-16 against the 66ers overall, 9-9 at home.

**LAST GAME:** The 66ers blanked the Quakes on Tuesday night, taking the opening game of the six-game set at LoanMart Field, with an 11-0 victory. Inland Empire starter Leonard Garcia (2-2) was brilliant, allowing one hit and three walks over six scoreless innings. The 66ers blasted three home runs on the night, including two off Rancho starter Chris Campos (5-2), who endured his second straight loss, allowing seven runs (six earned) over just 2.1 innings. Jesus Galiz had a pair of doubles, accounting for two of Rancho's three hits on the night. The loss for Rancho ends their three-game winning streak and drops their lead in the South over the Storm to 4.5 games with 20 to play.

**UNFORTUNATE FIRSTS:** The Quakes were shut out yesterday by the 66ers, marking the first time in 2023 that they've been held scoreless. Rancho has been on the right side of the shut out four times this year, including once against Inland Empire (April 6). Earlier on the home stand against the Storm, the Quakes became the last team in the league to lose three straight games, as Rancho suffered it's first three-game losing streak of the year.

**NEWELL PROMOTED...AND THEN GOES OFF:** OF Chris Newell slugged a pair of home runs in his High-A debut on Tuesday, and helped Great Lakes score a franchise-best 20 runs, as they routed Beloit by a final of 20-0. Newell put together an MVP-caliber season over the first two months of 2023 for the Quakes, with a .312 average (sixth in the league), 14 homers (first), 38 RBIs (second), an on-base percentage of .426 (fourth) and the top slugging percentage (.662) along with the top OPS in the Cal League at 1.088. In addition to the loss of Newell, Cameron Decker went on the Injured List. Taking their respective spots on the roster are OFs Luis Rodriguez, who hit .241 with 11 homers and 67 RBIs in 110 games for Rancho in 2022 and Josue De Paula, who both join the Quakes from Extended in Arizona.

**THE CLOSE ONES:** The Quakes have played in some pretty tight ballgames already this home stand, as Sunday's 3-2 win was the third one-run game in the Storm series. Rancho went 2-1 in those contests to improve their record in one-run games to 9-7. Seven of their 16 one-run games have come against the Storm, going 5-2.

**PETER HEUBECK:** Right-hander Peter Heubeck makes his tenth start for the Quakes and third against Inland Empire. In two prior starts against the 66ers, he's allowed just two hits and four walks while striking out eight over seven scoreless innings of work. In his last outing, he allowed just one run on two hits over four innings in a no-decision against the Storm on May 25. In 2022, Heubeck went 0-1 with a 7.39 ERA over 15 games (13 starts). Heubeck was a third round pick (101 overall) in the 2021 draft out of Gilman High School in Baltimore, Maryland.

**WALBERT URENA:** Right-hander Walbert Urena will be making his eighth appearance and seventh start of the year, his third appearance and second start against the Quakes. In two games against Rancho this year, he's 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA, while surrendering seven runs on nine hits with six walks over seven innings. His last outing overall was against Visalia on May 24, where he allowed seven runs on five hits over just 3.2 innings in a loss. Urena, who is ranked by MLB Pipeline as the Angels 17th-best prospect, was signed out of the Dominican Republic in 2021.

**NEXT HOME GAME:** The Quakes are home through this Sunday against Inland Empire. Thursday is also Viva Los Temblores, as the Quakes will transform into Los Temblores de Rancho Cucamonga, as part of MILB's Copa de la Diversion program. Friday is another Family RV Family Feast Night, featuring \$2 hot dogs, \$1 Pepsi products and \$1 ice cream sandwiches. Game time for both nights is 6:30pm. Get tickets at rcquakes.com.
