#### **KNIGHTS EDGE JUMBO SHRIMP 2-1**

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp mustered only four hits offensively on Saturday in a 2-1 loss to the Charlotte Knights from 121 Financial Ballpark. The Knights broke open the scoring in the third inning with an RBI double from XavierFernandez. In the fourth, Fernandez added a sacrifice fly to make it 2-0. The Jumbo Shrimp were held off the scoreboard until the eighth, when Charles Leblanc smacked a solo home run. However, Jacksonville could get no closer in the defeat

### "NO OFFENSE, BUT..."

Jacksonville has tallied just nine runs total, including no more than three runs in each contest, over the first five games of their current series with Charlotte. The Jumbo Shrimp are hitting just 22-for-126 (.175/.271/.246/.517) with only one home run in this series; each part of the club's slash line places last in the 20-team International League during this stretch. Jacksonville registered at least five runs in 15 of their previous 23 games prior to this set. During that span, the Jumbo Shrimp ranked second in the IL in hits (229) while placing third in batting average (.286), fourth in OBP (.377), seventh in doubls (43) and eighth in both runs scored (133, 5.8 per game) and OPS (.818).

Over the last three-plus weeks, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 22 games the club has played since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 26 runs, 21 earned, on 58 hits (7.2 H/9) in 72.1 innings for a 2.61 ERA. During this stretch, Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 96 batters (11.9 K/9) against 44 walks (5.5 BB/9). Jacksonville's bullpen has gone 20 consecutive innings without yielding an earned run.

# MEN OF STEAL

While Jacksonville ranks just 11th in the 20-team International League in stolen bases with 114, the club has been exceptional in their efficiency at swiping bags. The Jumbo Shrimp have been successful on stealing a base at 83.2 percent of their attempts, a figure that ranks second in Triple-A. Over their last 16 games dating back to August 14, Jacksonville base runners have been successful on 15 of 17 stolen base attempts (88.2 percent).

#### THE AMAZING RACE

Somewhat remarkably, the top 11 teams in the International League are separated by just 5.0 games entering play on Sunday. Jacksonville checks in just 3.0 games out of first place, but the logiam means the Jumbo Shrimp are still only in eighth place. Thus, with just 19 games remaining in the regular season, in order to win the IL's secondhalf championship and earn a playoff berth, Jacksonville would have to make up that 3.0-game deficit while also leapfrogging seven other teams. If first-place Durham and Lehigh Valley even finish the season 10-9, because each club holds the tiebreaker over Jacksonville by virtue of head-tohead record, the Jumbo Shrimp would need to finish 14-5 (.737) while also hoping the five other teams ahead of them do not record a better record down the stretch.

#### TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season. Trov Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 32 games with the Jumbo Shrimp this year, Johnston is 45-for-128 (.352/.421/.586/1.007) with 10 doubles, one triple, six home runs and 27 RBIs. Johnston has reached base at least once in each of his first 31 games, an on-basee streak that marked the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since at least 2010. Including his time with Double-A Pensacola, Johnston has driven in 110 runs in 116 games this season, which ranks second in MiLB.

# JERARSSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion endured a terrible slump in the middle of the year. In 46 games from May 16-July 14, the Bayaguana, D.R., native went just 23-for-163 (.141/.258/.380/.638) at the plate with just one double, one triple, 12 home runs, 19 RBIs and 24 walks (12.6 BB%). Encarnacion struck out a remarkable 80 times, a rate of 42.1 percent over his 190 plate appearances. In his last 26 games, however, the 26-year-old is 23-for-86 (.267/.402/.488/.890) with four doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs and 20 walks (18.7 BB%). Encarnacion has trimmed his strikeout rate to 35.5 percent (38 in 107 PA) during this recent hot stretch.

-Named the Tennessee Gatorade National Baseball Player of the Year in 2018 after posting a 0.09 ERA and going 11-0 with 148 strikeouts in 76 innings.

-Led MLB in pickoffs (9) in 2021, the most in a single season since Eric Lauer (10) in 2018. The Padres own three of the highest single-season pickoff totals since 2016: Clayton Richards (8, '17), Weathers (9, '21) and Lauer (10, '18).

-Traded from San Diego to Miami on August 1 in exchange for first baseman Garrett Cooper & right-handed pitcher Sean Reynolds.

# 2022 SEASON

-Set career high in appearances with El Paso (31) and IP (123.0).

# 2021 SEASON

-Posted a 6.38 ERA in 18 starts but made 12 appearances out of the bullpen, where he posted a 2.49 ERA.

# 2020 SEASON

-Spent the campaign at the club's alternate training site before being added to the Padres' NLDS roster.

-Made his major league debut in Game 1 of the NLDS vs. Dodgers, becoming the second pitcher and sixth player to make his debut in the postseason (Shane McClanahan, Alex Kirilloff, Adalberto Mondesi, Mark Kiger and Bug Holliday).

# 2019 SEASON

-Made 22 starts for the TinCaps, striking out 22.8% of hitters while walking just 4.6%.

-He allowed two ER or less in each of his first seven starts, posting a  $1.78\ \rm ERA$  (6 ER in  $30.1\ \rm IP)$  from April 4 - May 26.
