#### **WEDNESDAY'S RECAP**

The Chesapeake Baysox fell 14-0 in a rain-shortened game on Wednesday afternoon. After a 1 hour, 19 minute delay pushed back the start of Wednesday's contest, Erie jumped on right-handed starter Ryan Long, who took the loss for Chesapeake after allowing 8 runs accross three innings. The Baysox Ione hit came from Adam Retzbach - a double off the left field wall in the first. The game was called in the seventh after an additional 33-minute delay.

#### **GERMAN ON A MISSION**

RHP **Nestor German** was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week, after a career-high six, shutout innings against Harrisburg last Friday. German has not allowed a run across his last two starts (11.2 IP). The longest scoreless streak of German's career is 14 IP (7/14 - 8/2/24 with Single-A Delmarva/High-A Aberdeen).

#### LEAVE THE RETZ TO ADAM

C/1B **Adam Retzbach** is having a career year with the Baysox. Retzbach currently has career-highs in average (.263), OBP (.372), slugging (.454) and OPS (.826). Additionally, he is one home run away from matching a career-high from last season, in 35 fewer games played. This past week, Retzbach homered three times in four games for the first time in his professional career. Sunday was the fourth-career three-hit game for Retzbach, matching a career-high.

#### **READY TO 'RIQUE HAVOC**

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** has reached base in 24 of 29 games played to start the season after missing 32 games from April 11 - May 19 due to a left hamstring injury. The Orioles No. 2 prospect posted the highest OBP (.542) of any Eastern League player with at least 20 plate appearances this past week. Bradfield drew the most walks (8) and tallied the second-most stolen bases (5) in Double-A this past week.

#### THEY'RE JUST TRAVELLERS

The Baysox have been particularly strong on the road in 2025. Chesapeake has posted a record of 19-14 on its travels this season. The Baysox have won three-consecutive series on the road and have won five of six road series they have played so far this season.

#### ONE RUN WONDERS

Chesapeake has won 15 one-run games this season - which is tied for most in the Eastern League (Binghamton). The Baysox have played 27 one-run games this season, which is tied for the most in full-season MiLB (Reading).

#### **BULLPEN BEASTS**

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.95 ERA, which is fourth-best in Double-A and sixth-best in full-season MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 331 hitters, which is fourth-most in all of Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

#### SCOUTING THE SEAWOLVES

The Erie SeaWolves - Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers - enter Thursday with a 43-22 record. The two-time defending Eastern League champions currently hold a half-game lead over Akron for the first-half title in the Southwest division, with each team having four games remaining in the first half. Erie's roster includes nine of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB.com - C/1B Thayron Liranzo (5), RHP Jaden Hamm (7), LHP Jake Miller (15), RHP Joseph Montalvo (17), OF Roberto Campos (20), OF Justic Bigbie (25), RHP RJ Petit (28), and RHP Yosber Sanchez (30).

#### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Carlos Peña is Thursday's projected starter for Erie. Peña has spent each of the past two seasons with Double-A Erie, lowering his ERA by over a run this season, compared to last. The southpaw went just 3.2 innings his last time out - his shortest start of the season since moving to the SeaWolves rotation in May. Peña was signed by the Tigers in 2019.

2025: Named EL Pitcher of the Week for 6/10-6/15 after 6.0 shutout, one-hit innings and 6 K on 6/13 vs HBG. First Baysox player this season to be named EL Player/Pitcher of the Week. Has thrown 11.2 consecutive scoreless innings in month of June. Pitched 5.2 shutout innings and struck out six in Double-A debut on 5/16 vs AKR. Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 5/13. Started season in High-A Aberdeen. Made six starts and posted a 3.60 ERA with 37 K over 25 innings pitched over 10 walks allowed. Struck out seven batters in each of his final three starts with IronBirds before earning promotion. At time of promotion, was tied for 10th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts.

#### **ROBERTO MERCADO**

#### Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

#### **JORDIE HENRY**

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. The Chesapeake Baysox logos were created by Baltimore-based Younts Design, whose clients over the years have included a variety of professional baseball teams (including the Baltimore Orioles).







### **ALTERNATE IDENTITIES**

#### CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

#### **CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE**



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión<sup>TM</sup>" or "Fun Cup<sup>TM</sup>"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball<sup>TM</sup> teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

#### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
