## TODAY'S HEADLINES

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Saints scored the first run of the game on Thursday, despite not collecting a hit until the seventh inning. However, they could not hang on in a 3-2 loss to Louisville on Thursday night. Yunior Severino broke up the no-hit bid with one gone in the seventh, hitting a triple to right field. DaShawn Keirse Jr. drove him in on a sacrifice fly to score the game's first run. The Bats answered with a pair in the bottom of the seventh to take the lead. After Louisville added an insurance run in the eighth, the Saints got the tying run to third base after a Wynton Bernard RBI single. However, Keirse Jr. bounced into a double play to end the game. Louie Varland threw 5.2 innings of shutout baseball in the loss, extending his career streak to 20.0 consecutive innings against Louisville without allowing an earned run.

**AND THEY'RE OFF!** The Saints have ambushed the Louisville Bats in the first inning this season, scoring 28 runs in the opening frame. Those 28 runs are the most any team has scored against any opponent in the first inning in all of baseball. It is also tied for the eighth-most runs a team has scored against one opponent in any inning across all of baseball.

**JULIEN JUMPING ON BASE:** After his walk in the ninth inning on Thursday, Edouard Julien has reached base in 21 consecutive games, the Saints' second-longest streak of the season. The longest streak is held by Matt Wallner, who reached in 22 straight games before being recalled by the Twins. During his 21-game streak, Julien is hitting .284/.470/.473 (.943 OPS).

**REHAB ROUNDTABLE:** The Saints have two Major League Rehab assignments added to their roster in Brock Stewart and Zack Weiss. Stewart made his first appearance on Tuesday, striking out one and walking two. Weiss made his first Triple-A rehab outing on Wednesday, striking out four and allowing a hit in 2.0 innings.

**LOUISVILLE SLUGGERS:** Since joining the International League, the Saints have hit well at Louisville, sporting a .354 OBP, a .475 SLG, and an .829 OPS, which are all the best of any venue they've played in (home or road) and the 0.44 home runs per plate appearance is the best of any ballpark the Saints have played in, including CHS Field (0.38 HR/PA). It is also the sixth-best of any IL team in any ballpark since 2021 (min 12 games) and the best for any IL team at Louisville Slugger Field (including Louisville) since 2021.

**ELECTRIC EELES:** Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .522 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in five of the seven games he's played in, drawing four walks and been hit by a pitch four times. He is second among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .461 across three levels.

**WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH:** Chris Williams hit his 10<sup>th</sup> home run of the season on Wednesday and the 41<sup>st</sup> of his Saints career. He is now just two home runs away from tying Mark Contreras for the franchise lead at 43. Over his last 12 games, Williams is hitting 11-for-38 (.289) with a double, seven home runs and 11 RBI.

Williams has hit seven home runs in 11 career games at Louisville Slugger Field. His .156 HR/PA is the best for any Saints batter in Louisville and is tied for the best of any IL batter and any ballpark since 2021 (min. 30 AB) (Alex Jackson - Autozone Park). His 1.410 OPS in Louisville is the best for any Saints player in franchise history.

**SUMMERTIME SEVERINO:** In Yunior Severino's 40 games since May 21, he has hit .356 (52-for-146), with 10 home runs, drawing 29 walks to 40 strikeouts, owning a 1.073 OPS. Since June 1, Severino leads the IL in batting average (.369) and on-base percentage, sporting a .482 clip. He's third in OPS, at 1.104, ranking fourth in slugging percentage at .622. His 24 walks since the start of June are the sixth-most in the league.

**TWINS UPDATE:** The Minnesota Twins were off yesterday as they traveled out to San Francisco in advance of their three-game series against the Giants before the All-Star Break.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** 7/3 v DET...made Target field debut in second MLB start...allowed a career-high three home runs, giving up a career-high seven runs on a career-high nine hits over 5.0 innings...allowed a grand slam to Carson Kelly in the third inning, followed by a solo shot from Wenceel Pérez...allowed a two-run home run to Riley Greene in the fifth inning, allowing all seven runs via long ball...took first MLB loss in 9-2 Twins defeat.

**APPEARANCE PRIOR:** 6/28 @ AZ...Made MLB debut, opposite Jordan Montgomery, and earned the win in Minnesota's 13-6 victory...allowed five runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings with one walk and two strikeouts...allowed one baserunner (BB) in innings 1-3...surrendered four runs on a home run and five singles in the fourth...exited after the fifth inning with a 13-5 lead. Seven hits allowed tied a season high from May 5 vs. Louisville

**MOWING THEM DOWN:** In his start on May 22, 2024 in Buffalo, Festa retired the first 10 batters that he faced. After getting a flyout to center field to start the game, he then struck out the following seven batters, setting a new franchise record. With two outs in the third, Steward Berroa slapped a ball to second base to snap the streak. His seven consecutive punchouts surpassed Joe Ryan (8/20/21 vs Iowa) and Ronny Henriquez (5/28/22 v Indianapolis).

**A PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES:** In just his ninth professional pitching appearance, Festa was a major part of a no-hitter. On May 10, 2022 with Fort Myers, he threw 6.0 no-hit innings, striking out a career-high 11 batters in a combined no-hitter for the Mighty Mussels. Jaylen Nowlin followed with 2.0 perfect innings and struck out three. Hunter McMahon tossed 1.0 hitless inning to finish it off, a 3-0 win.

**ONE, TWO, THREE, YOU'RE OUT!:** On July 24, 2022, Festa allowed three consecutive singles between the third and fourth innings. The final two batters of the third inning reached, as did the first of the fourth. Festa got three outs, but did not retire a batter because promptly picked off each of the three batters, one after the other.

**你好:** While attending Seton Hall Prep in New Jersey, Festa was a member of the National Chinese Honor Society... **BIGGER, FASTER, STRONGER:** Goal in the offseason leading up to 2024 was to add some muscle, so he can be prepared to go an entire season. He said it's sort of tough for him to do certain exercises given his height and narrowness. Last season he was listed at 185 pounds and came into Spring Training in 2024 10 pounds heavier at 195.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** 7/5 v GWN...made eighth start of the season, pitching a season-high 6.0 innings, allowing four runs on six hits, walking two and striking out four...three of four runs allowed scored in the second inning with two outs...allowed five consecutive hits, four singles and a double...in the third, gave up a triple to Eddie Rosario, who scored on a sacrifice fly...retired nine of final 10 batters, with the lone runner reaching on a dropped third strike...received third win in 11-5 Saints victory.

**APPEARANCE PRIOR:** 6/30 @ IOWA...made seventh start of the season and second of the series, throwing 5.0 shutout innings, allowing four hits and striking out six...struck out the first five batters he faced...first baserunner came via error from Edouard Julien in the second inning...allowed first hit with one out in the third, an infield single from Darius Hill...allowed another infield single to Owen Caissie, stranding both runners on base...retired six in a row before allowing a pair of singles in the fifth inning...allowed only six balls to leave the infield...recorded a season-high six strikeouts, five of which were swinging...second start of the season that went at least 4.0 innings and no earned runs...took a no-decision in a 9-1 Saints loss.

**FROM THE TWINS TO THE TWINS:** The last 2 seasons for Plutko have been spent in the KBO, where he has dominated for the LG Twins, going 26-8 between the 2022 and 2023 seasons. After signing for \$500,000 in 2022, he went 15-5 in his first season, re-signing for \$ 1.4 million in 2023. He followed that campaign with a season that saw him go 11-3, but did not make it to the championship series due to a hip injury.

**REMEMBER THE PAC 12:** Plutko finished his career as one of the best pitchers in program history at UCLA, where he finished his three-year stint there with second-most wins (29), starts (52) and IP (351.1) in school history. His career ERA of 2.25 and 272 career strikeouts both rank 7th on UCLA's all-time lists. His sister, Sara, was a three-year soccer letterwinner at University of Oregon and his wife, Allison, was a four-year gymnast at UCLA and was on same team as gold medalist Carly Patterson.

**LEAVE A MESSAGE AFTER THE TONE:** When he was promoted to Triple-A Columbus (Cleveland organization) in September, 2021 he missed the phone call from Cleveland's Director of Player Personnel Carter Hawkins because he was at a friend's wedding. They had just got done saying, "I Do" and got done taking the bridal party photos. Got a call from Cleveland and he put it straight to voice mail. When the call came again his wife Allison prodded him to answer because it could be important, so he did.

**NOT PERFECT, BUT STILL PRETTY GOOD:** On June 2, 2018, Plutko was spinning a gem with Columbus, not allowing a baserunner until the ninth inning at Syracuse when he issued a one-out walk. He followed that with a fly out and a strikeout to finish off the no-hitter. It was just the ninth complete-game no-hitter in the IL since 2005. It continued a stellar stretch for Plutko, who took a no-hitter into the sixth just two starts prior with Cleveland against the Chicago Cubs
