SHOREBIRDS LOSE SERIES FINALE BY ONE RUN: The Delmarva Shorebirds fell in the series finale to the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers on Sunday afternoon by a score of 2-1, their second straight loss by that exact score. They grabbed the lead in the fifth with on an RBI single in the infield by **Erison Placencia**. But the Cannon Ballers would tie the game on an RBI single by **Mario Camilletti** with two outs in the bottom half of the inning. They would then take the lead in the sixth on a bases-loaded walk and Delmarva would be unable to break-through late in the game and would fall by a single tally. The defeat was their fifth in a row in the series after winning the opening match-up on Tuesday.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Juan De Los Santos makes his 18th appearance of the season and 11th start of the season as he begins the series against the Lynchburg Hillcats. He'll face right-hander **Alonzo Richardson** who will be starting for the 19th time in 2023. This will be the third time Richardson will throw against the Shorebirds and Delmarva had great success against him last time out on June 29 as they scored seven runs on 9 hits and he would take the loss in an 8-0 defeat. The offense for Delmarva scored 3 runs on 5 hits across five innings against him on May 24.

BACK LIKE HE NEVER LEFT: Trendon Craig has had an instant impact for the for the Shorebirds since rejoining the team on June 9 after two months on the IL. In 29 games since returning, Craig is slashing .303/.405/.486 with 13 extra-base hits, 16 RBI, and 15 stolen bases. Craig has reached base safely in 34 of 38 games with the Shorebirds and has multiple hits in 13 games with Delmarva. His 16-game on-base streak that was snapped on June 23 is the longest by a Shorebirds hitter this season.

HEY STIVEN: Stiven Acevedo has come out of the All-Star break hot as he's reached base in 12 of 14 games he's played in since the break. He has especially thrived batting in the leadoff spot in his last 11 starts as he has 5 multi-hit games while scoring 7 runs, and stealing 3 bases in that short span. His run at the top included a leadoff home run on the first pitch of the game versus Kannapolis on July 25.

HEATING UP AT THE HOT CORNER: Third basemen **Anderson De Los Santos** has begun find his stride at the plate. After picking up a walk-off hit in extra innings against Augusta on June 24, De Los Santos is batting .264 in his last 21 games with 9 extra base hits and 14 RBI. The 19 year old is batting .286 during the month of July with 5 multi-hit games and has three 4 RBI games this season.

NEW MONTH, FRESH START: The Delmarva Shorebirds will look to right the ship after a tough finish to the month of August where they lost 10 of their final 12 games, including losing 5 of 6 in their last two series against Charleston and Kannapolis. Delmarva has had success this season against the Lynchburg Hillcats as they've taken four of six games in each of the first two series, giving them an 8-4 overall record against the Cleveland Guardians affiliate.

TODAY'S STARTER: Juan De Los Santos gets the start in the series opener against the Lynchburg Hillcats

LAST OUTING (7/26 vs CSC): De Los Santos worked four inning of scoreless relief last Wednesday on the road against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers, taking a no-decision in a 5-3 defeat.

vs. LYNCHBURG: This will be the third time this season De Los Santos will pitch against the Lynchburg Hillcats, with his best performance coming against them the last time he saw them as he tossed four scoreless innings to earn a save in an 8-0 victory on June 29.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: 2022 was overall a nice season for De Los Santos as he established himself as one of the more consistent arms in the Delmarva rotation early in the season. The right-hander had a strong first two months of the season before a tough June where he had an ERA of 8.44 in five appearances. The length of his starts began to go down in July as he easily eclipsed his prior career high in innings thrown as he finished season with 79.2.

Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. 
