Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the A's, play the opener in a six-game home-and-home series against the Fort Wayne TinCaps. The Nuts are 5-4 vs. the TinCaps this year, losing two of three games in Fort Wayne to open the season before winning four of six at home in late April. These will be the final meetings of the season between the clubs.

Last Game: Lugnuts 6, Dragons 1. Trailing 1-0 entering the last of the seventh, Ryan Lasko homered, T.J. Schofield-Sam lashed a three-run double, and Tommmy White ripped a two-run homer in a dramatic six-run eruption, lifting the Nuts to victory and clinching a series split with Dayton. The Lugnuts had lost three of the first four games of the series, 13-8, 9-4, and 19-4, rallying back to hold Dayton to four total runs over the weekend.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and TinCaps play at Parkview Field through Thursday, then the series shifts to Lansing for Friday, July 4, through Sunday, July 6.

First Things First: The Lugnuts activated first baseman **Darlyn Montero** from the 7-day Injured List, while first baseman **T.J. Schofield-Sam** was promoted to Double-A Midland. Schofield-Sam leads the Midwest League in batting average (.337), base hits (87) and HBPs (23). Montero had been on the IL since May 2 (hamate injury), missing 50 games (the Nuts went 24-26).

Big Nate: Outfielder **Nate Nankil** has been spectacular as of late, going 1-for-3 with a walk on Saturday to extend his hitting streak to 13 games (24-for-51, .471) and his on-base streak to 19 games (30-for-74, 6 BB, 3 HBP, .405 avg., .470 OBP, .568 slugging). Nankil is 2nd in the Midwest League in batting average (.319), tied for 3rd in doubles (18) and 5th in base hits (79). He batted .379/.443/.517 in June.

Anything's Possible: Joshua Kuroda-Grauer has hit safely in his last nine games (17-for-41, .415).

Hello, Truist Park: Third baseman Tommy White and Lugnuts 2025 Opening Day starter Gage Jump (now in Double-A) will represent the Athletics' organization at the 2025 All-Star Futures Game in Atlanta, it was announced on MLB Network yesterday. White, the A's No. 6 prospect, joins Luis Morales (2024), Denzel Clarke (2022), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. and Bo Bichette (2017) and Angel Perdomo (2016) as active Lugnuts to play in the Futures Game.

From The 517 to The Show: Last night, 2023 Lugnut Colby Thomas made his Major League debut, pinch-hitting (and popping out) before recording an outfield assist at the plate to help the A's beat the Tampa Bay Rays, 6-4. Thomas is the sixth Lugnut to reach the Majors this season (Max Muncy, Gunnar Hoglund, Jack Winkler, Denzel Clarke, Jack Perkins) and the 199th all-time.

Prospecting: The Lugnuts have eight of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 6 Tommy White, No. 9 Joshua Kuroda-Grauer, No. 11 Steven Echavarria, No. 15 Ryan Lasko, No. 16 Rodney Green, Jr., No. 26 Nate Nankil, No. 29 Tzu-Chen Sha and No. 30 Wei-En Lin.

Midsummer Classic: Major League Baseball All-Star Game voting has advanced to phase 2, with three former Lugnuts (Toronto first baseman Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., A's shortstop Jacob Wilson and Toronto catcher Alejandro Kirk) each making the final two at his position. A run-off vote will determine the starter between Guerrero and the Yankees' Paul Goldschmidt, Wilson and the Royals' Bobby Witt, Jr., and Kirk and the Mariners' Cal Raleigh. A little more on Wilson, who played 23 games for the Lugnuts in 2023: he ranks 2nd in the Majors to Aaron Judge in both batting average (.340) and base hits (106) and is on pace to become the first ever rookie to start the All-Star Game at shortstop for the American League. The last Athletics starting shortstop in the All-Star Game was Bert Campaneris in 1974.

Mark it Down: Closer **Mark Adamiak** is tied with Hartford's Welinton Herrera for the Minor League Baseball saves lead, recording his 13th save on Saturday night in Lansing's 4-3 victory.

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in fewest strikeouts (511), 2nd in batting average (.260), 2nd in base hits (651), 2nd in doubles (144), 4th in on-base percentage (.353), 3rd in total bases (963) and 4th in OPS (.738).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is 1st in the league in holds (30), tied for 1st in complete games (2),1st in fewest HBPs (26), 1st in fewest balks (4), 2nd in fewest walks (275) and tied for 2nd in saves (20).

In the Field: The Nuts have turned 77 double plays this season, good for 2nd best in the Midwest League.

History vs. Fort Wayne

The Lugs are 224-238 vs. the TinCaps, 120-102 in Lansing, 104-136 at The Fort. Last year: 8-10, 4-5 at Fort Wayne.

2019 was the last time the Nuts opened in FW, splitting a four-game home-and-home series. Before that: 2009 to open Parkview Field, a three-game TinCaps sweep.

JULY 1ST IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2013: Chris Hawkins's two-out bases-loaded grounder up the middle in the bottom of the ninth seemingly lifted the Lugnuts to walk-off victory over the Great Lakes Loons. But Santiago Nessy, the Lugnuts' base runner at first, did not run to second base, turning around and celebrating with his teammates. The Loons executed the force play at second base, erasing the game-winning run, and then defeated the Lugnuts in ten innings, 5-4.

2017: Drama in South Bend! With two balls and two strikes on J.B. Woodman, the bases loaded, two outs, and the South Bend Cubs clinging to a 5-4 lead, Woodman injured an abdominal muscle hitting a foul ball against closer Wyatt Short and was forced to leave the game. He was replaced by pinch-hitter Bo Bichette who took Ball 3 high, fouled one off to the right, and then swung and missed a high fastball to end the game.

No-No History: Facing the Cedar Rapids Kernels on June 13, 2024, relieved Jake Garland to open the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 combined no-hitter of the Kernels... it was the 4th no-hitter in franchise history as well as the first home no-hitter since 2003.

At Pella High School: 2016 lowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-lowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.
