- The Blue Jays won an injury-shortened series finale over Clearwater, 2-1 in five innings on Saturday night.
- The game was called after five innings after Yeuni Munoz suffered an injury sliding into second base on a stolen base attempt. After a delay, Munoz was carted off the field, and both teams agreed to call the game complete.
- Munoz has since been released from the hospital and has been placed on the 7-day IL.
- Joey Votto launched a solo home run in the fourth inning to tie the game at one his first on his rehab assignment.
- Edward Duran delivered the lead with an RBI triple later in the inning.

#### **SERIES SUCCESS**

With last week's five games to one series win, the Blue Jays have achieved a split or better in seven of their last eight sets. Dunedin has especially been strong at home, having gone without a series loss at TD Ballpark since Clearwater took four of six from the Jays April 16-21 (six series).

#### FELIZ'S AWARD WINNING WEEK

Cristian Feliz became the first Dunedin Blue Jay to earn a Florida State League weekly award this season as he was named the FSL Player of the Week on Monday. In six games against Clearwater, Feliz went 8-17 with 3 HRs and a league-leading 1.591 OPS. His 454 foot shot Friday night tied Axiel Plaz for the longest home run in the FSL this season (May 18 at Tampa). Feliz's home run on Tuesday jumped off the bat at 116 MPH - the hardest hit ball in the league this season.

#### **HEATING UP**

The Blue Jays have won six of their last seven games entering tonight's series opener with Tampa. The hot stretch comes after the team lost five of seven games. Dunedin's 5-1 start to July is tied for the best in the FSL.

#### LEAVING 'EM STRANDED

Dunedin limited Clearwater hitters to 10-53 (.188) with runners in scoring position last week, including a 1-11 mark Friday night.

#### **RESTED ARMS**

With Saturday's shortened contest and days off Sunday and Monday, Dunedin's bullpen is remarkably rested. All 10 of the Blue Jays bullpen arms have at least three days of rest entering tonight's series opener.

#### **BLUE JAYS BATS ARE BOPPIN'**

The Blue Jays tallied at least nine hits in all five full games last week against Clearwater, hitting .294 on the week - the highest mark in the FSL.

#### FERNANDO IS THE FUTURE

It was announced last Tuesday that Blue Jays RHP Fernando Perez would represent Toronto in the All-Star Futures game on Saturday July 13 in Arlington. In 13 starts this season, Perez ranks among the Florida State League leaders in ERA (3.60), Ks (76), innings (70), and WHIP (1.04). Perez is the first active member of the Dunedin roster to be selected since Francisco Rios in 2016. Perez had his best month of the season in June, pitching to a 2.86 ERA in 22 innings across four starts.

#### ANOTHER CLOSE ONE

Dunedin played its 29th one-run game this season on Saturday - the most one-run contests in the FSL this season. The Jays are 14-15 in those contests. 54 of the Blue Jays 80 games this season (67%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 28-26 record in those games.

#### HITTERS PARK

TD Ballpark has proved to be the second-most home run friendly park in the Florida State League this season, as the Blue Jays and their opponents have combined for 71 home runs at the Venue. Bradenton's LECOM Park has seen the most homers with 74, while BayCare Ballpark is third with 64. The Blue Jays lead the league with 39 home runs allowed at home.

#### NICE TO SEE YOU, NIMMALA

In five games since his return to Dunedin from the FCL Blue Jays, Arjun Nimmala is 10-27 (.370) with six extra base hits. Nimmala was placed on Dunedin's development list on May 14, and then was assigned to the FCL Blue Jays on June 3. Nimmala was the Blue Jays first round draft pick last season, and is the organization's third-ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline.
