JACKSONVILLE EDGES CHARLOTTE 3-2

José Devers' RBI triple in the eighth inning on Wednesday led Jacksonville to a 3-2 victory over Charlotte in front of a sellout crowd of 9,060 fans at 121 Financial Ballpark. The Jumbo Shrimp grabbed the lead in the second on an RBI single from **Jonathan Guzman** and a bases-loaded walk from **Troy Johnston**. The Knights came right back to tie in the third on a **Wynton Bernard** solo homer and **Oscar Colás** RBI double. The score remained that way until the eighth, when Devers' triple put Jacksonville out in front. **Evan Fitterer** matched a career-high with 7.0 strong innings.

HOME FREE

In their third home series of the season, the Jumbo Shrimp took four out of six games from the Norfolk Tides at 121 Financial Ballpark, marking their first home series victory of the season. From there, Jacksonville failed to win any of its next five home series, posting a woeful 6-21 (.222) record in the process. Finally, by taking two of three games from the Charlotte Knights, the Jumbo Shrimp halted this stretch. The club is now 2-4-3 in sets at 121 Financial Ballpark.

BATMEN

Heading into play on June 16, Jacksonville had mustered only 304 runs in 68 games (4.5 per game), which ranked last out of 30 Triple-A teams. The Jumbo Shrimp also placed just 20th in batting average (.254), 25th in OBP (.337), 24th in slugging (.409) and 24th in OPS (.746) in the first 68 games of the season. Jacksonville has registered at least nine hits in 10 of their last 16 games, sparking an offensive resurgence from the club. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp rank third in Triple-A in hits (161), fourth in batting average (.293), 10th in OBP (.365), 11th in OPS (.819) and 14th in SLG (.454) while scoring 82 runs (5.1 per game).

GET PITCH OR DIE TRYIN'

Jacksonville has gone 15-9 in their last 24 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 17 of those 24 affairs. Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in runs allowed (84) and ERA (3.14) while ranking third in WHIP (1.33) and OPS against (.717), fourth in batting average against (.243) and tied for fourth in fewest hits allowed (196).

QUIT PLAYING GAMES WITH MY START

Somewhat incredibly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 21 of the last 23 games, with 17 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and nine being scoreless. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 37 runs, 32 earned, on 90 hits (8.6 H/9) in 94.1 innings for a 3.05 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 91 strikeouts (8.7 K/9) against 40 walks (3.8 BB/9) during this stretch. Rather remarkably, the Jumbo Shrimp have started 14 different pitchers over these 23 contests.

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, **Javier Sanoja** was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 45 of his last 51 games, notching 20 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 68-for-201 (.338/.409/.493/.902) at the plate with 16 doubles, three triples, three home runs, 34 RBIs, 25 walks and 26 runs scored.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

Jacksonville outfielder **Griffin Conine** has been stellar since early May. Over his last 49 games, the Duke product is 52-for-171, slashing .304/.379/.591/.970 with 11 doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 33 RBIs, 21 walks and 31 runs scored. Among the 119 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks 14th in HR/FB (25.4 percent). On the season, he ranks tied for 10th in the IL in extra-base hits (32), tied for 14th in homers (15), 20th in SLG (.513), tied for 23rd in hits and tied for 24th in doubles (16).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville relievers have nearly worked more innings (370.2, 15th-most in Triple-A) than their starters (373.1, eighth-most in Triple-A). However the club's starting pitching ERA of 4.32 ranks leads all Triple-A rotations. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has collected a 4.30 ERA, which places sixth... Over his last 35 games, **Troy Johnston** is hitting .351/.412/.550/.962 with seven doubles, two triples, five home runs, 21 RBIs, 12 walks and 27 runs scored.

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Division III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2024 SEASON

-Missed 26 games with an injury from May 22-June 21.

2023 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Led qualified pitchers in ERA (3.32).

-Among the 119 Southern League pitchers with at least 30 IP, Monteverde ranked 40th in stranded runners (71.3%).

2022 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.

-Over his final 13 starts in High-A, Monteverde went 3-4 with a 2.30 ERA. He pitched 70.1 innings, yielding only 54 hits (.211 batting average against) and striking out 75 against 21 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Six of his seven outings were in a relief role. Prior to that, he had not pitched in relief since 2017, his freshman year at Virginia Wesleyan. Even during that 2017 campaign, 11 of his 15 appearances were starts.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Monteverde's favorite pitcher growing up was Clayton Kershaw

-His favorite book is "To Kill a Mockingbird" and favorite movie is "American Pie."
