BRUCE'N UP THE PLACE: Bruce Zimmermann will make his 10th start of the year and coming off his last appearance where he worked four-plus scoreless innings against Norfolk last Sunday. It came after he allowed seven runs (6 ER) his first start of the week against the Tides. Sunday was one of three scoreless outings on the mound this year for the southpaw and the first time when he did it as the starter.

ON THE HEND: Logan Henderson saw his seven-game winning streak in Triple-A come to an end on Thursday night. After beginning the season with a loss in his first start, the Brewers' no. 12-rated prospect rattled off 10 straight wins, including his first three Major League starts. Overall, the Sounds and Brewers entered the day 11-1 in his starts and 12-1 when he has pitched. Thursday night was the first time allowing two home runs in a game this season and first since September 10, 2024, and only the third time in 58 professional games where he has allowed multiple home runs. The four earned runs were the most he had allowed in a game since allowing five in his only other loss of the season back on March 29th.

HIP, HIP: Jorge Alfaro was the lone Nashville player to record a multi-hit game, finishing the night 2-for-3 with his first triple of the year. Thursday night was his first action of the series and first since last Friday in Norfolk when he also turned in a multi-hit game. He's up to 12 multi-hit performances on the season, breaking a four-way tie for the second-most on the team this year behind Raynel Delgado (13).

DOUBLE TRIPLE: Andrew Vaughn begins his Brewers/Sounds tenure with a hit in three-straight games with his triple in the bottom of the seventh on Thursday night. It was the first time this season that Nashville has had multiple triples in the same game. The team is up to 19 triples on the year, second-most in the International League behind Toledo (23).

STREAKY GOOD: RHP Joel Payamps extended his streak without allowing an earned run to four straight games. It's tied for the longest streak by an active pitcher for the Sounds along with Elvin Rodriguez. Over his last four, Payamps has worked 4.0 IP and allowed two hits with four strikeouts and a walk. With one of the five hits for Nashville, INF Oliver Dunn extended his current hitting streak to five games and hitting .389 with a home run and two RBI during his streak.

SAY IT AINT SO: Tyler Jay saw his 15 game, 17.0 IP streak without an earned run come to an end on Wednesday night. The 15 games and 17.0 IP were both tops on the team this year and his 15 games were the second-longest active streak going in the International League behind Iowa's Riley Martin who has yet to throw in this series. Jay's streak was also tied for the fourth-longest by a pitcher in the minors this year. It was the first loss of the season for Jay and his first loss since July 9, 2024, while he was with Triple-A Syracuse. Through 21.0 IP and 21 appearances, Jay owns a 0.86 ERA and has allowed just three runs (2 ER) on 13 hits. He is second on the team in appearances this year behind Jesus Liranzo (22 G).

RISP IT TO GET THE BISCUIT: Nashville ended Thursday's game 2-for-14 with runners in scoring position and 11 left on base. Through 68 games, Nashville is hitting .255 with RISP (14th in the IL). The 497 batters left on base this season ranks 12th in the IL.

ZERO, NADA, ZILCH: Nashville pitched their way to their 11th shutout win of the year on Tuesday night for back-to-back nine-inning shutouts for the second time this year. The Sounds are tied for the lead in the minors in shutouts this season and the 11 shutouts are already tied for the fourth-most in a single-season for the Sounds dating back to 2005. The team had 12 shutouts in 2006, 2012, and most recently in 2021.

WELCOME HOME: Andrew Vaughn suited up for the Sounds for the first time since being traded to the Brewers from the Chicago White Sox last Friday. The former no. 3-overall pick in the 2019 MLB Draft made his first hit with the Sounds a memorable one with a seventh-inning grand slam. It's just the second grand slam hit by a Nashville player this year and the first since Daz Cameron hit one on April 19th on the road in Charlotte. Tuesday night was his second career professional grand slam and his first since September 18, 2022, against the Detroit Tigers.
