## SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (15-6, 58-32) vs. TULSA DRILLERS (10-11, 36-54)

LHP BRYCEN MAUTZ (3-2, 3.62 ERA) vs. RHP PATRICK COPEN (0-2, 2.36 ERA)

**SETTING THE SCENE:** Springfield visits Tulsa (LAD) for the 1st game of a 6-game series ... are 11-1 vs. the Drillers this season ... is the 2nd the of 2 trips to Oklahoma this season ... went 5-1 in a 6-game series at ONEOK Field from May 20-25.

**MAUTZ ON MOUND:** LHP Brycen Mautz makes his 16ht start and 2nd vs. TUL ... has allowed 2-orfewer runs in 10 of last 11 starts ... pitched 5.0-scoreless frames in last start on 6/13 at CC with 5 strikeouts, no walks, and 2 hits ... has a 1.20 ERA in last 3 starts (2ER/15.0IP) ... in only start vs. TUL on 6/11 struck out a season-high 9 over 6.0-shutout innings.

LAST TIME OUT: Springfield took the rubber game of their 3-game vs. WCH in a 7-4 win Sunday ... IF Ramon Mendoza slugged a solo HR, and OF Chase Davis and IF Jeremy Rivas each had 2 hits and combined for 3 RBI at the top of the order ... LHP Ixan Henderson allowed 2 runs over 5.1 IP to pick up his 6th win.

**DUB STEPS:** Friday's win vs. WCH capped off a 45-15 (.750) stretch over the Cardinals' previous 60 games ... enters Tuesday's game with a TXL-best 58-32 record, tied for a season-high 26 games above .500 ... also hold the TXL's best 2nd half record at 15-6.

**SERIES BUSINESS:** Springfield has won 7 of its last 8 series beginning with its early June 6-game set at Frisco ... is 10-7 in series openers, 13-4 in series finales, and 2-0 in rubber games ... has swept 3 series (including 2 6-gamers) and has not been swept this season.

**X MAN:** LHP Ixan Henderson ranks 2nd in the TXL with a 2.43 ERA after allowing 2 runs over 5.1 IP in his last start Sunday ... is in the top 5 in WHIP (1.18) and strikeouts (90).

**BULL-D0ZA:** IF Ramon Mendoza tied C Leonardo Bernal for the team with 11 HR on Sunday ... his previous career-best HR total was 6 in 2023 with Peoria (A+) ... hit 3 HR all of last season over 212 AB at 2 different levels ... is the club's active leader and ranks 8th in TXL with an .833 OPS.

**LET IT BERN:** C Leonardo Bernal enters Tuesday's game riding an 8-game hitting streak ... hitting .313 (10x32) during the stretch which began on 7/4 at NWA.

**ALL THAT RAQUET:** LHP Nick Raquet earned his 8th win in relief on Friday and is 2nd in the TXL in wins ... has an 0.83 ERA in 23 appearances and has now allowed an ER in last 15 appearances (since 5/25 at TUL) ... has a 0.98 WHIP and .215 OBA.

SHUFFLING CARDS: IF Brody Moore rejoined the Cardinals from Memphis (AAA) on Friday ... hit .174 with 2 HR over 19 Double-A games earlier this season ... LHP Michael Watson and RHP Cade Winquest were transferred to SGF from Peoria (A+) ... Watson made his Double-A debut with a scoreless inning of relief on Sunday ... Winquest is slated to start Wednesday at TUL.
