TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds wrap up a six-game series against the Gwinnett Stripers on Sunday afternoon. RHP Johan Oviedo with square off against RHP Nolan Kingham. First pitch is scheduled for 12:05pm CDT.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Redbirds dropped their fourth straight game by a 6-5 final against the Stripers on Saturday. In the fifth, seventh and eighth innings, Memphis stranded runners at third base, while they stranded the bases loaded in the eighth. Aaron Brooks (0-2) took the loss after allowing five runs to cross, including an Alex Dickerson three-run homer, with two-outs in the third. Alec Burleson had a three-hit outing and drove in a pair of runs, including his ninth homer of the season. Paul DeJong and Ben DeLuzio also had multi-hit efforts, with DeLuzio slugging his fifth homer to lead off the ninth inning. The bullpen gave up just one run over the last four innings.

REDBIRDS VS STRIPERS: Memphis trails Gwinnett 4-7 in the season series and are 13-24 against the Stripers dating back to last year. Overall, the Redbirds will play the Stripers 27 times this season, the most they will see a team in 2022. The Redbirds opened their season against the Stripers at AutoZone Park and split the six-game series after dropping the series finale. Throughout the 10 games, Memphis has been outscored 43-47, trails in ERA (4.26 to 3.94), has been out-hit (.222 to .260 BAs; .685 to .738 OPS) and have struck out 113 times against Gwinnett pitching. These two teams will next meet for a three-game series to start the second half of the season on July 22 at AutoZone Park.

RIDING THE STREAKS: Saturday's 6-5 loss pushed the Redbirds' losing streak to four games, one shy of their season-high. Memphis lost five straight from 5/6-5/10 (including losing both ends of a doubleheader) but rebounded by rattling off a six-game winning streak, their longest of the year. Over this four-game stretch, the Redbirds have lost three 1-run contests and a 2-run game. Entering this series, Memphis was 7-1 in 1-run games. The offense has averaged 3.25 runs over those four games, about two runs shy of their season average (5.24).

MUDDY WATERS - I FEEL LIKE GOING HOME: Memphis wraps up their 12-game road trip on Sunday before return to AutoZone Park. The Redbirds are 6-5 during this stretch, with five of the six wins coming against Norfolk. In the last 11 games, the pitching staff has posted a 3.83 ERA (40 ER in 94IP) with 92 strikeouts while the offense has hit just .235 (88-for-375) with 10 homers, 40 walks and 52 runs scored and 17 stolen bases. Burleson is the only member of the Redbirds lineup hitting over .300 during this stretch (.390 with 16 hits).

BURLY TIME: Alec Burleson followed up his three-hit performance on Friday with a three-hit performance on Saturday. He knocked in a pair of runs, including slugging his 9th home run, and it marked his 13th multi-hit game of the season. Against Gwinnett, Burleson has hit five homers, including a pair of game-tying home runs and the go-ahead, game winning shot in the seventh inning on opening night. Burleson is riding a season-high seven game hitting streak, 1-4th most among active IL hitting streaks, and is hitting .448 (13-for-29) with a double, three homers, 10 RBIs and a 1.241 OPS over that span. He also has a hit in 11 of his last 12 games, slashing .388/.400/.633 with three doubles, three homers, and 15 RBIs. The Charlotte-native ranks among IL leaders in home runs (T-5th with 9), RBIs (T-7th with 29) and slugging percentage (8th with .568). The 23-year-old leads the active Memphis roster in batting average, doubles, home runs, RBIs, runs, total bases, slugging percentage, and OPS.

WHEN IT MATTERS: When runners are in scoring position, Burleson doesn't miss. The Redbirds' outfielder ranks among the best in Triple-A in batting average (.424, 7th), homers (4, 6th), slugging percentage (.848, 5th) and OPS (1.320, 5th) in that situation. His 22 RBIs rank 14th while his 36 plate appearances are tied for 118th most out of 200 qualified hitters. With RISP as a team, Memphis ranks 9th in Triple-A with a .272 batting average, second with a .511 SLG, and sixth with 18 home runs and an .845 OPS. They have also left the least amount of baserunners on in Triple-A, stranding just 349 runners this season, an average of 8.5 per game. They've also had the third fewest plate appearances with RISP (374).

FROM REDBIRDS TO CARDINALS: Matthew Liberatore made his MLB debut Saturday against Pittsburgh. He did not factor into the decision and allowed four runs on seven hits, including a home run, in 4.2 innings. Nolan Gorman made his MLB debut on Friday and in his first plate appearance, collected his first major league hit. Liberatore became the seventh Memphis Redbirds to debut with the Cardinals this season, joining Jake Walsh, Juan Ypez, Kramer Robertson, Packy Naughton and Brendan Donovan. Following his start, Liberatore was optioned to Memphis while Angel Rondon was recalled from the Taxi Squad.

WALK THIS WAY: In his last plate appearance on Saturday, Kramer Robertson single to right field for his 21st hit of the year. Robertson now has as many base hits (21) as he does walks this season, while his on-base percentage (.367) is a full .161 points above his batting average. The Waco, TX native's 16.4% walk rate ranks 13th among qualified Triple-A hitters (via FanGraphs). He has walked in 18 of 29 games played and has reached base in all but three games. Among Triple-A East leaders last season, Robertson ranked third in walks (62) and ninth in OBP (.366).

DINGERS: On the season, Memphis has hit 65 homers which leads all of Triple-A. That mark ranks T-2nd in MiLB with Amarillo (Diamondbacks Double-A), trailing only Greenville (69, Reds Low-A). Overall, Memphis has hit home runs in 32 of 41 contests. Out of the 65 homers, 38 have been solo shots and 11 have been three-run jacks. The Redbirds became the first professional baseball team to hit 50 home runs in 2022, doing so in 26 games. In 15 games since May 6, Memphis has hit 15 home runs, including 10 on this recent road trip. Memphis has hit 42 of their 65 on the road, the most in minor league baseball. Six Redbirds have five or more home runs on the season.

TODAY'S STARTER: Johan Oviedo makes his ninth start of the year against Gwinnett on Sunday.

LAST TIME OUT: Oviedo allowed just one run in his final frame to Gwinnett on Tuesday, earning his third win of the season. He struck out six batters and lasted seven innings, the second time this season he has gone seven frames. He and Matthew Liberatore are the only two teammates to have a pair of seven inning outings in Triple-A.

KEEP THE BALL ON THE GROUND!: The big-fly has been Oviedo's weakness to start 2022. He has allowed 12 home runs in seven starts, the second most in MiLB and Triple-A. The right-hander currently has a 2.72 home runs per nine innings rate and a 28.6% home run to fly ball ratio according to Fangraphs (2022 MLB average is 10.1%). In 2021, Oviedo allowed 1.16 homeruns per nine innings after giving up seven long balls in 12 appearances.

LAST SEASON: It was a roller-coaster travel schedule for Oviedo in 2021. The Havana-native started the season in St. Louis, split time with Memphis in May, stayed with the Cardinals in June, road the taxi again in July, and finished the rest of the season in Memphis. He almost split time evenly between MLB and Triple-A, making 13 starts with the Cardinals and 11 with the Redbirds. The theme throughout the organization was struggling with command: he allowed roughly 5 BB/9 (12.9 BB%) and 15 total home runs. However, the strike-out stuff is omnipresent, as he K'd 59 batters in 54.1 IPs with Memphis.

WITH MEMPHIS: Oviedo struggled with the Redbirds last season, posting a 1-6 record with a 6.13 ERA in 12G (11GS). He did, however, work strikeouts, K'ing 12 batters in 6.1 innings against Nashville last September. Overall, he had a 10 starts of 5-strikeouts or more with a 24.1% K-rate.

WITH THE CARDINALS: Oviedo made his MLB debut on 8/19/20 for St. Louis against Chicago at Wrigley Field... Struck out Javier Baez for his first MLB strikeout... Was on the roster for the 2020 Wild Card Series at San Diego but did not appear in a game. In his two year MLB career, he has made 19 appearances (18GS). His best outing came against the Marlins on 6/16/21, when he pitched seven scoreless innings. Oviedo is still looking for his first MLB win.

PROMISING FUTURE: From the St. Louis Dispatch; "Last season he posted a higher strikeout percentage (17.3%) than Jake Woodford (15). He matched Adam Wainwright in groundball percentage (47.5). He surrendered fewer home runs per nine innings (1.25) than Jack Flaherty (1.41). His average fastball velocity (95.1 mph) was better than the MLB average (93.8). His slider made major leaguers swing and miss nearly 44% of the time"

SCOUTING REPORT: Oviedo spots a speedy fourseam fastball that averaged nearly 97 mph during Spring Training. He throws that pitch over 55% of the time. His second best pitch is his slider, then his curveball. The slider averages 87 and gets more flyballs than most others' right-hander sliders. He's also been playing with a sinker.
