CARDIAC CARDS STRIKE AGAIN, TOP RIDERS WITH FOUR-RUN 9TH:

The Cardinals scored four runs in the top of the 9th inning and tied a season high with 16 hits as Springfield defeated the Frisco RoughRiders in come-from-behind fashion 7-6 on Wednesday night at Riders Field. **Bryan Torres** went 5-for-5, **Dakota Harrris** had three hits and **Jimmy Crooks** homered for the second straight to lead the Springfield offense. Springfield starter **Tink Hence** struck out 6 over 4.0 one-hit innings and **Matt Svanson** notched his 21st save of the season with a 1-2-3 9th inning.



DPPDSING STARTER: Right-hander Kumar Rocker makes his 4th start this season for Frisco...Has cruised through his 3 starts since being added to the RoughRiders' roster on July 26, allowing just 5 H with 16 K and 1 BB over 11.0 IP...Last start came on Friday, August 9 at Midland when he fired 4.0 scoreless innings allowing 3 H with 8 K on a season-high 51 pitches...Has not thrown more than 4.0 IP with Frisco...Also made 3 appearances in the ACL where he went 0-1 with a 6.43 ERA, surrendering 8 R (5 ER) on 11 H in 7.0 IP...Made 6 starts with High-A Hickory in 2023 going 2-2 with a 3.86 ERA and racking up 42 K to just 7 BB in 28.0 IP...Season was cut short due to an elbow injury in May that required Tommy John surgery...Made his pro debut in the Arizona Fall League in 2022 where he went 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA in 6 starts...Selected with the 3rd overall pick by the Rangers in 2022 and signed for an under-slot \$5.2 million after pitching for the Tri-City Valley Cats of the Frontier League where he made just 5 starts and threw 20.0 innings...Drafted 10th overall in the 2021 draft by the Mets out of Vanderbilt but did not sign... Decorated college career that saw him win the College World Series Most Outstanding Player as a freshman in 2019 and throw a 19 strikeout no-hitter against Duke in the Super Regionals...24 years old

CARDINALS TRAVEL TO METROPLEX FOR ONLY MEETING AGAINST RIDERS: The Cardinals head to North Texas for a six-game series against the Frisco RoughRiders (Double-A, Texas Rangers). This week's series is the only meeting of the regular season between the two first-half champions in the Texas League.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

RDAD WARRIORS: To date, the Cardinals have been the best road team in the Texas League. Springfield is 33-19 (.635) away from Hammons Field this season, and .500 at home (29-29). The Cardinals' .635 road winning percentage is the 2nd best in all of Double-A behind the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) who are 36-19 (.655). The Birds have a road ERA of 3.78 as opposed to a 5.18 mark at home.

This week represents a clash of strengths; the RoughRiders own the best home winning percentage in Minor League baseball at .673 (35-17). The Cardinals' back-to-back wins over Frisco at Riders Field is just the 3rd time the Riders have lost 2 straight home games this season, and the first time since Midland won 2 straight on May 23-24. Frisco has not lost 3 straight home games in 2024.

POWER SURGE: The 2024 season has been a tale of two halves when it comes to the Cardinals' power numbers. With 41 homers in 41 games in the 2nd half, Springfield has already eclipsed its 1st half total of 37. The Cards are on pace for 69 longballs in the 2nd half of Texas League play, a number that would have been good for 3rd in the 1st half.

The Cardinals lead the league in runs scored (214, 5.2/game) and OPS (.761) in the 2nd half and are 2nd in SLG (.415). In the 1st half, the Cards were 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712).

GRINDIN': The Cardinal lineup has been one of the hardest in the minor leagues to strike out all season long. With 790 K's in 109 games (18.8% K rate), Springfield has the 2nd-fewest whiffs in all of full-season ball, trailing only the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (MIL) of the Midwest League (758 K; 18.6% K rate).

HITTING (IN) THE "DOG DAYS" OF AUGUST: After putting together their best month of the season with a 16-7 July, the Cardinals have gotten off the a good start in the month of August. With a 7-5 record in the month, the Cards lead the Texas League with a .285 batting average through its first 12 games and have also scored a league-high 65 runs (5.4/game). The Birds have racked up double-digit hits in each of their last 4 games, totalling 55 knocks during that time and are batting .359.

FOR STARTERS: The Springfield rotation has been on a solid run since the last day of July. Over their last 13 starts since July 31, Cardinals starters are 4-2 with a 2.45 ERA, striking out 67 batters to just 17 BB in 58.2 IP. Over their last 8 starts since August 6, Cards starters have a 1.85 ERA.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 34 games dating back to the final day of the first half on June 23, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the Euless, TX native leads all qualified hitters in the circuit with a .360 average while adding 10 of his 11 HR this season and a league-high 32 RBIs, . **Crooks** during that stretch is slugging a league-high .664 and has a 1.073 OPS. In his first 44 games of the season, **Crooks** batted .282 with 1 HR and a .786 OPS.

Among active qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, **Crooks** is tied for the top spot with **Bryan Torres** in batting average (.318) and OBP (.406), while ranking 1st in SLG (.511) and OPS (.917). He has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games.

HISTORIC NIGHT FOR TORRES: With a 5-for-5 performance on Wednesday night, **Bryan Torres** set a new career high and tied a franchise record for hits in a game. The five-hit plateau had been reached 9 other times in Springfield history, most recently by **Chandler Redmond** on August 10, 2022 at Amarillo as a part of his famous home run cycle.

KING OF THE "K": With 26 strikeouts over his last 3 starts, Cardinals starter **Quinn Mathews** reclaimed the MiLB lead in whiffs. With 157 K's, **Mathews** leads **Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson** of the Cleveland organization by one (156). Among qualified pitchers in the minor leagues, **Mathews** is 6th in K/9 at 12.62.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 21-for-21 and his 21 saves and 43 appearances lead all of Double-A. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 19.0 IP (0.47 ERA) and is 11-for-11 in save opportunities. **Svanson** has been unscored upon over his last 16 appearances, allowing just 9 H with 14 K over his last 18.0 IP. The Cardinals are 44-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.


