CARDINALS GD UP EARLY, HANG ON TO BEAT DRILLERS: The Cardinals recorded 13 hits and held off a late rally from the Tulsa Drillers as Spring-field won its second straight game with an 8-7 victory on Saturday night at Hammons Field. Five different Cardinals had multi-hit games, and the top three hitters in the order went a combined 6-for-14. Mike Antico doubled and homered for the Cards and drove in 3 runs, and Nathan Church went 2-for-5 with a double and 3 RBIs. Jacob Buchberger had two hits to extend his hitting streak to 11 games, a career high. Wilfredo Pereira went 5.0 innings for his first win with Springfield this season, and Matt Svanson recorded the final two outs for his 6th save.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Kendall Williams** makes his 9th start of the season in the series finale for the Drillers...Took the loss for Tulsa in the series opener at Hammons Field, allowing 6 R (3 earned) on 6 H over 5.2 IP...In 4 starts in May is 0-4 with a 10.06 ERA...Started against the Cardinals on May 3 at ONEOK Field and took the loss allowing 6 R (3 ER) on 7 H in just 3.0 IP...In 2 starts against the Cardinals is 0-2 witha 6.23 ERA...Spent the 2023 season between 4 levels (all but Low-A) and went 4-7 with a 3.73 ERA over 17 appearances (16 starts)...Spent the 2022 season between Low-A Rancho Cucamonga and High-A Great Lakes going a combined 3-6 with a 4.32 ERA in 27 appearances (24 starts)... Acquired by the Dodgers in September 2020 from the Blue Jays in exchange for RHP Ross Stripling... The Cardinals won 4 out of 5 at ONEOK Field from April 30-May 4. The Cards and Drillers played a doubleheader on Wednesday to make up for the postponement on May 5.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERRE: The Cardinals have have had one of the top offenses in the Texas League all season long, but the Springfield bats have heated up again during this current homestand. Over their last 10 games, the Cardinals are batting .305 and have the top OBP (.371) and OPS (.811) in the Texas League during that time. Over their last 11 games, the Cardinals have 7 games with 9 or more hits.

For the season, Springfield leads all of Double-A in batting average (.272), OBP (.356), and hits (392).

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cards have struck out just 305 times in 44 games, the 3rd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. In the Texas League, Springfield trails the Frisco RoughRiders (302 K's in 43 games) for 2nd-fewest in the circuit. The RoughRiders are tied with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers for fewest in MiLB. Springfield is averaging just 7.15 K's per game.

CARDS PLAGUED BY BIG INNINGS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have had a hard time limiting the big inning. Springfield has surrendered 34 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 34 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 132 of the 247 total runs scored by the opposition, 53.4% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. Springfield has allowed that production in just 9.0% of their innings pitched. In the other 340.2 IP Springfield has allowed 112 runs, which comes out to 2.96 runs per 9 innings.

SEARCHING FOR LONGBALL ELIXIR: So far this season the Cardinals have been victims of the longball, getting dinged for 53 home runs in just 43 games, the most in Double-A. After allowing home runs in 10 straight games, the Cardinals have not allowed a longball in two straight against Tulsa.

HISTORIC HENCE: Cardinals right-hander **Tink Hence** put on a show Friday night at Hammons Field, firing 6.0 shutout innings with a career-high 13 K's in Springfield's 1-0 win over the Drillers. **Hence's** 13 strikeouts also tied a Springfield franchise record for strikeouts in a single game, matching **Trey Hearne** (May 8, 2009 vs NW Arkansas) and **Alex Reyes** (May 19, 2008 vs NW Arkansas). With his performance, **Hence** lowered his ERA to 2.76 (4th-lowest among qualified pitchers in the Texas League) and now has 59 K's (3rd in the league).

HOT CORNER, HOT BAT: After a slow start to the season, Cardinals INF **Jacob Buchberger** has gotten red hot over the last month. Since coming into play on April 14 batting .087, Springfield's 3B is batting .359 (32-for-89) over his last 26 games, and has hit safely in all but 3 of them. He has two separate 8-game hitting streaks during that stretch.

Buchberger is currently riding a career-high 11-game hitting streak, the longest active streak in the Texas League. During his hitting streak, **Buchberger** is batting .463 (19-for-41) with a double, a triple and a home run. He has multiple hits in 7 of his last 8 and 8 of his last 10 games.

TABLE SETTERS: The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis, **Bryan Torres**, **Nathan Church**, and **Mike Antico** have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined, the trio is batting .317 (121-for-382) with 70 R, 22 2B, 27 SB, 9 CS and have struck out a combined 59 times for a 13.7% K rate.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .302 (2nd in Texas League), and the Cardinals are hitting a league-leading .297 out of the 2-hole. Combined, the Cardinals batting .299 between the two spots in the lineup, tops in the league.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 19 straight games without a home run.


