RIDERS SPLIT DOUBLEHEADER WITH ARKANSAS:

On Wednesday night at Riders Field, the Frisco RoughRiders split their doubleheader against the Arkansas Travelers, dropping game one 9-4 before bouncing back for a 13-3 game two victory. In game one, Arkansas (40-24) lifted two home runs off of Frisco (35-28) starter **Blake Townsend** (3-3) in the first two innings, taking a 4-0 lead. The Travelers plated their nine runs in the first five innings total. The Riders got their first two runs the same way, as **Arturo Disla** blasted two solo home runs against Ryan Hawks (4-3). **Malcolm Moore** collected his first Double-A hit in a two-run RoughRiders' sixth inning, but Frisco fell 9-4. Game two started out much stronger for the Riders, who scored instantly against Arkansas starter Abdiel Mendoza (4-2). Playing as the road team in the makeup game, Frisco got a leadoff home run into the lazy river from **Frainyer Chavez** in a two-run first frame. Then, the Riders tallied four runs in the second inning, including a Chavez RBI single and a **Marcus Lee Sang** triple that plated two. **Josh Trentadue** pitched three innings, allowing just an unearned run in his first start since moving to the bullpen and left with the Riders leading 6-1. Up 6-3 in the sixth inning, Chavez rocked a double off the wall in left-center field to score another run and Lee Sang, Disla and **Julian Brock** all followed with RBI hits. At the end of the inning, Frisco led 11-3. **Ryan Lobus** (5-2) pitched two innings to close it out in relief as the Riders eventually ballooned the lead to 13-3.

RIDERS ON THE VERGE:

With just 4 games remaining in the first half of play, Frisco's magic number to clinch is 2. The Riders have made the playoffs 10 times, most recently in 2024, with two championships in 2004 and 2022. The Riders have won the first half 8 times, most recently in 2024. Frisco can clinch tonight with a win and a Midland win over Amarillo.

12-INNING MADNESS:

For the first time in franchise history, the Riders have played back-to-back 12-inning games on Sunday in San Antonio and Tuesday in Frisco, going 1-1 in the games. Since 2018, when the extra-innings rule with an automatic runner at second was instituted, the Riders have played just 6 12-inning games with a third of them in the last two games. The last time the Riders played 13 innings or more was 2017.

LORD, I WAS BORN A TRAVELERS MAN:

The Riders took the series from Arkansas in June 3-2 and will play a make-up game on Wednesday as part of a doubleheader, beginning at 5:05 p.m. In the series in North Little Rock, the Riders outscored the Travs 21-19, holding Arkansas to a .191/.286/.298/.584 slashline.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been great lately and is now 5th in Double-A with a 3.88 ERA and 1st in the Texas League. Over the last 20 games, the Riders have the best bullpen ERA in the Texas League (3.24). Last week in San Antonio, Frisco threw 24.2 innings from the arm barn, allowing just eight runs (2.92ERA). In the last 9 games, the starters have also dominated, going 3-1 with a 3.02 ERA, the third-best ERA in Double-A.

RAFE AT HOME:

Riders infielder **Rafe Perich** has had an incredibly clutch introduction to his new team, homering 5 times in his first 18 games with the RoughRiders. All of his 5 home runs have either tied the game or gave the RoughRiders the lead, including a game-tying home run in the 9th and a walk-off home run in the 9th. His 16 total home runs this year lead the Rangers organization. Between High-A Hub City and Frisco, he won May Texas Rangers Player of the Month, hitting .327/.427/.714/1.141 with 11 home runs and 32 RBIs.

ONE-RUN MADNESS LATE:

The RoughRiders are just 9-12 in one-run games this year. Out of the 12 one-run losses, the RoughRiders scored at least one run in the final inning to make it a one-run loss in 6 different games this season, just coming up short. Only 3 of the 12 losses featured a blown lead from the Frisco bullpen. The Riders have been the best run-scoring offense in the 7th inning or later in Double-A (148 runs) and the 2nd-best team in Double-A in ERA in the 7th inning or later (3.44).

GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

Frisco's 55 runs in the first inning this year are 5th in the minors, hitting .286 (73-for-255) in the first with 13 home runs. They have scored in the first inning in 26 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 14 games this season. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 15-27 (including a combined 7-10 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 21-1 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 14-16 in 1 or 2-run games.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 64 games the RoughRiders are 2nd in the Texas League with 575 hits. They are second in the league in batting average (.266) and 2nd in runs (406, 6.3 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 44 percent of their games (28-of-64). The Riders are 5th in the Texas League in homers (80), 1st in doubles (116), 3rd in SLG (.438) and 2nd in OPS (.802).

ABOUT WINSTON

-Signed by Rangers for \$10,000 in 2019.

-Worked on increasing his fastball velocity from the low 90s when he signed. He spent the fall of 2023 at the Rangers spring training facility and working out in the biomechanics' lab where the velocity was up to 99 mph.

-Looking to become the first player born in Payita to make MLB debut.

2026 SEASON

-Enters the 2026 season as the No. 4 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB Pipeline.

-Made best start of the season on May 29th at Arkansas, going 5.2 IP. 2 of the 3 runs he allowed scored after he left the game.

2025 SEASON

-Entered the 2025 season as the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB Pipeline.

-Was named First Team All-Spring Breakout after throwing three perfect frames with six strikeouts on March 16th, 2025 against the Giants prospects.

-Was placed on the Injured List with a Back Stress Reaction on April 22nd. Activated on August 29th.

2024 SEASON

-After the graduation of Wyatt Langford from MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30, Santos went from unranked to No. 15.

-Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on April 23rd after striking out 12 in 5.0 scoreless innings during 5-3 win over Greensboro on April 19th.

-Owned 0.44 ERA over four April starts, striking out 31 over 20.2 IP to just seven walks.

-After striking out just 19.9% of batters in 2023, he recorded a 30.5% K-rate with Hickory in 2024.

-Poured in best Double-A start in second outing against Arkansas, allowing one unearned run over five innings with seven strikeouts in a win.

-Participated in the Futures Game in Arlington, allowing an unearned run over one inning pitched.

-In first career postseason start at Midland on 9/17, he picked up the loss, but struckout a career-high tying 12 batters over six innings while allowing two runs (one earned) on four hits and walking two. Frisco lost 2-0.

-3.38 SO/BB figure was 2nd-best in TEX org. (3.84-Jose Corniell) and 9th-best in SAL (min. 75.0 IP).

-Placed on the 7-day I.L. on 5/10 with hamstring tightness; activated 5/16.

CHAD COMER

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.
