BACK ON TRACK: After winning six out of the seven games last week against Delmarva and 10 out of the last 11 overall, the FredNats will look to keep the good times rolling and continue to move up the standings as the first half winds down. This week, the team welcomes the Charleston RiverDogs, Single-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays and back-to-back Carolina League champions to town. Charleston has struggled this season, coming in with a 21-30 record. The RiverDogs split their series last week with Augusta, but won the last three games of the series to come in with some momentum. RHP Riley Cornelio gets the series opening start for the FredNats, and the 7th round draft pick out of TCU will look to build on some momentum of allowing just five runs in his last 13 innings. Today is Cornelio's 23rd birthday.

ABOUT LAST GAME: The FredNats walked off Delmarva for the third time of the series in the finale. Armando Cruz got his second walk-off hit of the week, and Murphy Stehly reached base four times, including with an RBI double. The FredNats took advantage of two Delmarva errors to score runs, and the bullpen allowed just two runs in five innings, with Brad Lord finishing the game with two scoreless innings and earning his first career professional win.

CARDIAC NATS: The FredNats have come up big in clutch situations of late, and the team's record has drastically improved because of it. The FredNats already have five walk-off wins this year, which leads all of MiLB. Three of those walk-offs came last week against Delmarva. The team is 8-6 in one-run games, but have won five out of the last six one-run affairs. The FredNats are also 4-1 in extra innings this year, with three of those wins coming in walk-off fashion.

LA CASA: In his return season after playing just 45 games due a back injury last year, Brady House is quietly having one of the best offensive years out of anyone in the Carolina League. House is third in the league in average (.312), first in OPS (.925) and second in slugging (.536) by one thousandth of a percentage. He's also played an exceptional defensive third base after making the positional switch from shortstop. He hit his sixth home run on Saturday, and had his first career two homer game last week on the road in Salem. Sunday was House's 20th birthday.

BULLPEN WORK: In this strong stretch for the FredNats, the bullpen has locked it down. In the bullpen's last 45 innings, the group has allowed just 10 earned runs for an ERA of 2.00, and opponents are hitting .187 against the group. Five different pitchers have recorded saves this year for the FredNats.

STRUGGLES AGAINST THE SOUTH: 20 of the 23 wins for the FredNats this year have come against the Carolina League North Division, which Fredericksburg is in. In two series against teams from the South Division, the team is just 3-9. It won one game in a road series at Fayetteville, and two games in a home series against Columbia. Beginning with this series against the RiverDogs, the FredNats will finish the first half playing three straight South Division opponents: Charleston, Myrtle Beach and Columbia.

HISTORY MADE: In the 7th inning of last Thursday's game, Elijah Green's first home run at Virginia Credit Union Stadium was the longest this three-year-old ballpark has ever seen. Hawkeye data said it traveled 436 feet, but it's very possible that it was longer due to it quite literally leaving the park. It gave the FredNats a 7-6 lead and they would eventually win 8-7.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 32, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and ZSP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

TONIGHT'S START: Riley Cornelio made his professional debut for the Fredericksburg Nationals in a start at Fayetteville this season, after being selected in the 7th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. The 22 year-old righty more than answered the bell, firing five innings with just one earned run, while picking up seven punchouts to just a pair of walks. However, he was saddled with the loss in a 3-2 defeat against the Woodpeckers.

A stalwart for the TCU Horned Frogs, Cornelio led the team in '22 with 15 starts, and also finished first with 77 strikeouts in 75.0 innings of work.

The right-hander excelled in Big 12 action, posting a 3.12 ERA with 40 strikeouts in just seven starts. His work earned him 2nd Team All Big-12 honors.

HIGH HONORS: Cornelio was a highly touted arm coming out of Pine Creek HS in Monument, Colorado. Baseball America tabbed him as the top overall draft prospect in the state for 2019, as he earned both the Perfect Game and Gatorade Colorado Player of the Year award in his senior campaign

LAST TIME OUT: Riley Cornelio was sharp in his most recent outing against the Delmarva Shorebirds last week. Cornelio tied his season-high with seven strikeouts, while walking just one and allowing only a pair of earned runs. Cornelio is scheduled to start on Sunday this week as well.

Today is Cornelio's 23rd birthday.
