#### **INDY BITS**

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Despite Matt Gorski and Matt Fraizer combining for five runs driven in, the Indianapolis Indians fell 8-7 to the lowa Cubs in 11 innings on Wednesday afternoon in the second game of the series at Principal Park. Fraizer opened scoring in the top of the second with his first Triple-A home run on a changeup from top Cubs prospect Cade Horton. A half-inning later, lowa's BJ Murray responded with a solo shot of his own against Indians starter Cam Alldred. After Alexander Canario gave lowa a 3-1 lead with a two-run single in the third, the Indians got one run back in the fourth and took a 4-3 lead in the sixth thanks to back-to-back RBI extra-base hits from Gorski and Fraizer. David Bote put lowa back in front with a three-run home run to left in the bottom of the sixth, but the Indians drew even in the eighth thanks to a bases-loaded walk and a fielder's choice. After the duo of Ethan Roberts and Brad Wieck worked a scoreless top of the eleventh for lowa, Miles Mastrubuoni plated the winning run against Indians reliever Geronimo Franzua with a ground ball to second base that wasn't handled cleanly, allowing placed runner Darius Hill to score from third base.

**LEGGING OUT A LEAGUE LEAD:** Matt Gorski continued his torrid stretch in Triple-A yesterday, roping a two-run triple for his fourth consecutive game with at least one extra-base hit and multiple RBI. His triple yesterday was his International League-leading fifth in 33 games with Indianapolis, which bests his 2022 total of four between Single-A Bradenton, High-A Greensboro, Double-A Altoona and Indianapolis as a new career high. Since finishing a single shy of the cycle on Saturday vs. Toledo, he is 8-for-16 with seven extra-base hits and 15 RBI, good for a 1.563 slugging percentage and 2.087 OPS. He was one base shy of extending his three-game home run streak after launching a pair at Principal Park for his fifth career two-homer game and first since July 4, 2023 with Double-A Altoona vs. Erie on Tuesday. In nine games dating back to May 11, he owns a .382 batting average (13-fof-34) with 10 runs, two doubles, two triples, five home runs and 19 RBI.

RAKE LAMB: Jake Lamb set a new season high with four hits yesterday vs. lowa to extend his current on-base streak to 23 games since April 18. It was his first four-hit game since June 21, 2023, with Triple-A Salt Lake vs. Sugar Land. During his on-base streak — which narrowly bests Nick Gonzales' 21-game streak as the longest by an Indians batter this season and is tied for the third-longest in the International League this season — he is hitting 357 (30-for-84) with 16 runs, 10 doubles, one home run, 17 RBI, .437 on-base percentage and .949 OPS. He has now reached base safely in 33 of 34 games this season with a .350 batting average (43-for-123), 20 runs, 11 doubles, three homers, 23 RBI and 21 walks.

DAVIS GETS IT DONE: Henry Davis entered yesterday's game as a pinch hitter in the ninth inning and roped a two-out double in the top of the 10th inning, give Indianapolis a short-lived lead in extra-innings. He is currently working a streak of at least one extra-base hit in four consecutive games since Saturday vs. Toledo. He launched his fourth home run in a six-game stretch on Tuesday night at lowa, going 2-for-5 with a career-high four runs, double, homer, three RBI, two walks and a stolen base. Davis has now reached base safely in 12 of his 13 games with Indianapolis since May 7 with the third-most home runs among team leaders (trailing Matt Gorski's 6 and Malcom Nuñez's 5).

WELCOME TO THE HOME RUN CLUB: Matt Fraizer launched his first career Triple-A home run yesterday at lowa, going 2-for-4 with a double, home run and three RBI. It was his first three-RBI performance of the season — with his five RBI combined in the first two games at lowa marking his first multi-RBI performances of the year as well. He has now hit four extra-base hits in his last three games, including a triple on May 19 (2) vs. Toledo.

**ROAD WARRIOR:** Reliever Brent Honeywell tossed scoreless eighth and ninth innings yesterday, keeping the game tied at 7-7 to force extra innings. He has been a force to be reckoned with on the road, allowing just one earned run with eight strikeouts across 8.2 innings in six appearances. In 16 total appearances, he is 1-1 with a 6.20 ERA (14er/20.1ip) and 21 strikeouts.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians continue their six-game series against the I-Cubs — their first of three this season — tonight at 7:38 PM ET at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa. The Indians went 10-14 against Iowa last season, logging a 3-9 record in two series on the road. Continuing the series for Indianapolis tonight is LHP Michael Plassmeyer (1-3, 5.96), making his second start since being reinstated from the injured list. Countering for the I-Cubs will be RHP Dan Staily (0-3, 5.89), who has never faced Indianapolis in 89 career Triple-A appearances (86 starts).

MIKE ON THE MOUND: Michael Plassmeyer excelled in his first start back from the injured list on May 16 (2) vs. Toledo, tossing 3.0 one-hit, shutout innings with four strikeouts. He began the season on a high note, surrendering just one run in each of his first two starts (9.0ip combined) with 14 strikeouts. He then gave up multiple runs in his next three appearances before being placed on the 7-day injured list on April 23. In total, he is 1-3 with a 5.96 ERA (15er/22.2ip) and 30 strikeouts in six games (six starts).

THIS DATE IN 1998: For the second time in five days, Indians center fielder Pat Watkins recorded a four-hit game en route to an Indianapolis win. Tied at 4-4 through seven innings, the Indians plated eight runs in the eighth and two in the ninth to run away with a 14-4 victory at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Indy had 20 hits as a team, with Watkins and shortstop Damian Jackson accounting for eight of the knocks. Watkins had three doubles, and the Indians tallied nine extra-base hits in total (seven doubles, one triple, one home run).

#### TONIGHT'S STARTER

**Michael Plassmeyer:** The southpaw Plassmeyer will make his seventh start of the season and fourth on the road today vs. lowa.

**Last Outing:** Plassmeyer took the no-decision in the second game of a doubleheader on Thursday in Indianapolis by punching out four over 3.0 innings.

Against the I-Cubs: Plassmeyer has never faced lowa.

**Walk It Off:** Of his 14 starts last season with Lehigh Valley, four ended in walk-off fashion — three in favor of the IronPigs. In those three team wins, two of which were come-from-behind victories, Plassmeyer was backed by 27 runs of support.

2023: Began the season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley and went 3-4 with a 5.05 ERA (38er/67.2ip) and 74 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts). ... Struck out a season-high seven batters over 6.0 two-run innings on 4/21 vs. Worcester; matched that mark on 9/2 vs. Syracuse. ... Was placed on the 7-day injured list on 5/31 and was transferred to the 60-day IL on 7/25 with an undisclosed injury. ... Made three rehab starts with High-A Jersey Shore and allowed one run with nine strikeouts in 8.0 innings of work. ... Reinstated from the IL on 8/27 and went 2-0 with a 1.52 ERA (4er/23.2ip) and 27 strikeouts in his next five games (four starts) with Lehigh Valley. ...
