LOW FIVE: The Omaha Storm Chasers dropped their fifth consecutive game on Friday, losing, 12-3, to the Columbus Clippers. RHP Brandon Barker allowed eight runs on seven hits in the fifth inning-the most hits and runs allowed in a single inning this season by Omaha-putting the Chasers down by 10 runs. 1B Nick Pratto homered for the second consecutive game, blasting a two-run shot in the seventh inning. INF Bobby Witt Jr. went 3-for-5 with two doubles.

LATE SUMMER SLIDE: Omaha's five-game losing streak is the longest losing streak of the season, bringing the team's record in August to 5-12. The Chasers recorded their only losing month of the season in July (12-16) after going 16-7 in May and 16-10 in June. During the current five-game losing streak, the Chasers have been outscored $44-15$, bringing the season run differential to -13 .

ON THE MEND: SS Adalberto Mondesi (strained left oblique) rejoined the Storm Chasers on Thursday for his third rehab assignment with the team this season. He had gone 0 -for-13 with four strikeouts in five rehab games with Omaha from 8/3-8/10 before being returned to Kansas City from the initial rehab assignment on 8/15. Mondesi has played 15 total rehab assignment games this season between Omaha ( 10 games) and Northwest Arkansas (five games). In 10 games with Kansas City across two stints, Mondesi is 13 -for-36 (.361) with five doubles and four home runs. RHP Kyle Zimmer (neck/trap spasms) made his fifth rehab apperance of his current assignment on Thursday, taking the loss after allowing three runs on four hits in 1.0 innigns. He has thrown 6.0 innings with seven strikeouts and two walks since joining the Chasers for a rehab assignment on $8 / 11 \mathrm{vs}$. IOW.

DUAL THREATS: The Omaha Storm Chasers continue to lead Triple-A East in both home runs (151) and stolen bases (109). INF/OF Ryan McBroom leads the team and is second in the league with 22 home runs, while OF Edward Olivares has 13, OF Kyle Isbel and INF Bobby Witt Jr. have nine, and 1B Nick Pratto has eight. Isbel leads the team and is fifth in the league with 21 stolen bases, while INF Lucius Fox has 13, OF Edward Olivares has 12, and OF Rudy Martin has eight. OF Dairon Blanco hit nine home runs and stole a league-best 32 bases prior to his promotion from Double-A Northwest Arkansas and now has 10 total home runs and 32 steals this season.

20-20 VISION: INF Bobby Witt Jr. is one of three players in Minor League Baseball (Romy Gonzalez - CWS, Anthony Volpe - NYY) with 20+ home runs and 20+ stolen bases in 2021. Witt Jr., the consensus No. 3 prospect in baseball per Baseball America and MLB Pipeline, has 25 home runs-third-most in Minor League Baseball-and 20 stolen bases this year, including nine home runs and six steals with the Storm Chasers. He is the first Kansas City Royals minor league player to record a 20/20 season since OF Alex Gordon hit 29 home runs and stole 22 bases for Double-A Witchita in 2006. Gordon earned Texas League Player of the Year and Baseball America Minor League Player of the Year honors. Through 27 games with the Storm Chasers, Witt Jr. is batting .287/.354/.600 with nine doubles, nine home runs, 20 RBIs, and 26 runs scored.

HOME RUN RACE: C MJ Melendez is currently tied for the most home runs in Minor League Baseball (31) with Miami Marlins prospect Griffin Conine. Melendez hit 28 home runs at the Double-A level and has four with the Storm Chasers since his debut on $8 / 11$ vs. IOW while Conine hit 23 home runs at the High-A level and has eight with Double-A Pensacola. Melendez' father, Mervyl is the head baseball coach at FIU while Conine's father, Jeff, is an associate head coach at FIU. OF Jeff Conine played for Omaha in 1991, 1992 and 1998, hitting 20 home runs in 110 games with Omaha in 1992

FOR OMAHA: RHP Jackson Kowar makes his 15th start (16th appearance) with Omaha. He allowed a season-hightying five runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings on $8 / 15 \mathrm{vs}$. IOW, striking out six while tying a career-high with five walks. Kowar has a 10.13 ERA in three outings in August, allowing a combined 12 runs in 10.2 innings with 11 walks and 14 strikeouts. The right-hander's 99 strikeouts this season rank second in the league behind Nashville LHP Aaron Ashby (100). Kowar's 3.75 ERA would rank fourth in the league if he had enough innings to qualify (4.0 IP shy).

FOR COLUMBUS: RHP Brad Peacock makes his ninth start (10th appearance) with Columbus since signing a minor league contract with Cleveland on June 25. Peacock allowed four runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings in his last start on $8 / 15 \mathrm{vs}$. TOL. He faced the Storm Chasers on $8 / 4$ at Huntington Park, allowing a leadoff home run to OF Rudy Martin before striking out eight and walking two in 4.0 innings of one-run ball. The right-hander has a 4.01 ERA in 181 career Major League games spanning nine seasons, including eight with the Houston Astros (2013-2020). Peacock recorded his best season in 2017, posting a 3.00 ERA in a career-high 132.0 innings ( $34 \mathrm{G} / 21 \mathrm{GS}$ ) with a career-high 161 strikeouts and 57 walks and winning the 2017 World Series.
