WALCOTT PROPELS RIDERS TO BIG WIN:

Sebastian Walcott joited two home runs to anchor the Frisco RoughRiders to a 7-1 win over the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Friday night from HODGETOWN. Walcott led off the game with a solo blast to left, putting Frisco (29-19) ahead 1-0. Amarillo (21-28) then tied the game in the bottom of the second when Manuel Peña strolled an RBI single. The Riders then responded with seven unanswered runs. **Cam Cauley** drilled an RBI single in the top of the third to regain a 2-1 lead. Walcott then clobbered a three-run homer in the top of the sixth, expanding the Riders lead to 5-1. In the top of the ninth, **Frainyer Chavez** bounced an RBI groundout and then Ian Moller launched an RBI double off the glove of Sod Poodles right fielder Gavin Conticello to garner a 7-1 lead. The Riders bullpen quartet of **Larson Kindreich**, **Gerardo Carillo**, **Gavin Collyer** and **Skylar Hales** finished the Sod Poodles with four shutout innings and seven strikeouts. Frisco starter **Ben Anderson** (3-3) earned the victory, allowing one run on four hits while whiffing three over five innings. Amarillo starter Spencer Giesting (3-2) took the loss, allowing four runs and fanning five across 5.2 frames.

OFFENSE COMES ALIVE IN AMARILLO:

Since HODGETOWN opened in 2019, the RoughRiders have played 13 more games there than any other Texas League visiting team, and they have enjoyed their time offensively. In 75 games in the Yellow City, the Riders are averaging 6.4 runs per game and 1.75 home runs per game. For comparison, the Riders are averaging 5.0 runs per game and 0.95 homers per game overall since 2019. Since 2005, the RoughRiders have had 11 single games in which they have hit six or more home runs and seven of them have come

SAVE TONIGHT:

On Thursday night, **Janser Lara** became the 11th different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco is the only team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher **Robby Ahlstrom** and **Gavin Collyer** are tied for the lead in saves (four) for the Riders and **Skylar Hales** has recorded two saves. Frisco's 18 saves are tied for the most in Minor League Baseball and tied for the most in franchise history through their first 48 games.

OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 14 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .283/.338/.667/1.005 with five doubles, 13 RBIs and 12 runs scored. On Friday, he became the fifth Texas League teenager since 2005 to record a multi-homer game, joining the company of Keibert Ruiz (2018, 2x), Fernando Tatis Jr. (2018, 3x), Alex Verdugo (2016) and Mike Trout (2011). His eight home runs for a 19-year-old in Double-A are the fifth-most since 2005 through 49 team games, trailing Oscar Taveras (10), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (10), Delmon Young (9) and Tatis Jr. (9).

The RoughRiders overall are hitting .234 with runners in scoring position, but have struggled over their last 31 games. In that stretch, the Riders are 17-14, batting .193 (49-for-254)/.264/.315/.579 with RISP. Their .193 batting average is ninth in the Texas League and 27th among 30 Double-A teams.

ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. In his last 18 games, Ortiz is hitting .296 (21-for-71)/.383/.521/.904 with four doubles, four home runs and 16 RBIs. Over the last two seasons, Ortiz's five home runs in HODGETOWN are the most by a visiting player in the Texas League. He is hitting .333/.393/.667/1.060 with two doubles, five home runs, 11 RBIs and 11 runs scored in his career in Amarillo.

MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 25 this month, which is fifth in the league and have allowed 31, which is the most. Frisco's 4.59 ERA is seventh in the league during the month while they are 15-10 in May despite a -11 run differential.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .309 (30-for-97)/.447/.505/.952 over his last 29 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (37) and OBP (.430) while leading the league in walk rate (22.4 percent), a mark which also ranks 4th in Minor League Baseball (min. 150 PA). In May, he is hitting .325/.458/.494/.952, ranking seventh in average, first in OBP and fifth in OPS in the Texas League.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first eight starts, his 1.94 ERA is first in the Texas League. He has the best start to a season through eight starts in recorded franchise histroy by ERA. His 3.6 percent walk rate, 8.5 K/BB and 91.9 percent left on base rate are the best in the Texas League. His 51 strikeouts are the second most in the Texas Rangers organization and his 41.2 innings are the most thrown among Rangers farmhands.

-Recorded RoughRiders first quality start of the season on 4/11 at NWA, allowing two runs over six innings with six strikeouts to no walks. He moved up a day in the rotation, pitching on five days rest.

-On May 10th at San Antonio, Bratt took a no-hitter into the sixth inning before allowing a bloop single into right. He struck out a career-high 10 batters in the game before leading after six innings. The RoughRiders fell 2-1 on a two-run walk-off home run from Romeo Sanabria.

-In May, Bratt is 2-0 over four starts, owning a 1.29 ERA, 21.0 IP, 18 H, 4 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 27 K.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings

-In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over 53.1 IP to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.
