TEEING OFF

- HOW IT WENT DOWN: The GreenJackets hit the road on August 8th for a twelve-game road • trip. After dropping two agonizing games to Salem in the first three days on the road, the GreenJackets ripped off a trio of wins to take their first series since the end of June. However, their momentum was destroyed by the trio of Dylan Crews, Andrew Pinckney, and Yohendry Morales, as the FredNats took 5 of 6 in demonstrative fashion. Augusta gave up 47 runs, their most in a series this year, while being outscored 40-14 in their losses last week. Sunday, Augusta was one-hit for the first time this year.
 - MURPHY MARCHES ON: Before the series with Charleston, the Braves announced Owen Murphy's departure to High-A Rome. In his first two August starts, Murphy went 11.1 innings, giving up four hits and two runs while striking out 17. On 8/11, Murphy took a no-hitter into the 7th inning, eventually departing after 6.1 innings of work and eight strikeouts. Of the teenagers who have thrown 50+ innings in MILB this year, Murphy ranks first in strikeout rate and K-BB%. Murphy was named the Player of the Week for August 7th-August 13th, and fanned nine Fred-Nats in his win on 8/18 to bring his strikeout total to 26 in his three outings this month.
- TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: Luis Vargas will make his fifth start with Augusta this season, hoping to shake off last week's struggles. Vargas did not make it through the first, a harbinger of what was to come over the course of the week. Charleston hit Vargas hard at the Joe in late July. Ian Seymour will make the start for the RiverDogs, as he continues to ramp up his return from injury.
- SERIES STRUGGLES: The GreenJackets have now won just two series since the last week of May, splitting three and losing five since 5/28. The nine games below .500 as of 8/21 marks their season low. The season series between Augusta and Charleston is tied, 9-9.
- SHAY'S STADIUM: No new arm has made the impact like what Shay Schanaman did on the • road trip. In his first two outings of his professional career, he went 3.0 scoreless innings while striking out 5 batters. The only baserunner he allowed was a hit-by-pitch with two outs in the ninth inning on Sunday, when he picked up his first professional save. In his third outing on August 17th, he stranded the two runners he inherited, and wound up going 3.1 innings without allowing a run. He has given up just two hits in his first 6.1 innings of professional action, all scoreless.
- **EXPO-SPEEDO:** E.J. Exposito stole another base last series, bringing him to 19 on the season. The New York native has now stolen 16 straight bags without being caught. The season record for Augusta is 17 consecutive successful stolen bases, held by Bryson Worrell.
- **EVERYBODY MOVEMENT:** The GreenJackets have dominated on the basepath this month. • Augusta leads the league with 47 stolen bases in August so far, while only being caught 9 times. However, the GreenJackets are bottom in the league in OPS (.570) this month while also recording just four homers. Charleston have an August OPS of .785, second in the the league only to Fredericksburg, who just took five of six from Augusta.
