Back Home

The Fightin Phils return home and continue a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Hartford Yard Goats, on Thursday night. It is the 15th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season, and ninth-of-12 in Reading. The season-series is tied 7-7.

Reading Falls Wednesday after Late Hartford Rally

Four-unsnwered runs late from Hartford downed the Fightin Phils 7-4 on Wednesday night. The Yard Goats struck first with two runs in the top of the first inning off Taijuan Walker. Reading then responded with three in the bottom of the second to grab the lead. Trevor Schwecke had a two-run triple, then scored on an Erick Brito sac fly. Reading and Hartford each added a run in the third, but from there the Yard Goats outscored Reading 4-0 the rest of the way for the victory. Walker allowed two-earned runs on four htis over 2.2 innings, with three strikeouts. Dylan Covey allowed one-unearned run over two innings, and Christian McGowan surrendered three runs on six hits over 3.1 innings, with four strikeouts and took the loss.

Crawford Cruising

Phillies No. 3 Prospect Justin Crawford is on a roll since joining Reading on Friday, July 19. So far with the Fightin Phils, Crawford is slashing .351/.415/.459, with an .874 OPS. He's added five runs, four doubles and has four RBI. Crawford is currently on a four-game hit streak and has hits in seven-of-nine games he's played with Reading. Included in that is four multi-hit games, including back-to-back two-hit games.

Mr. Otto-Matie

Otto Kemp has proven to be a reliable bat in the Reading lineup since joining the Fightin Phils on June 11 from High-A Jersey Shore. Since June 11, Kemp leads the Eastern League in home runs at nine and is fourth in RBI with 27. He's also sixth in slugging percentage at .519 and seventh in OPS and .869. He's proven to be a clutch hitter as well, as he had a walk-off base hit in Reading's win on Tuesday against Hartford.

A Look Back at July

The Fightin Phils ultimately finished the month of July with a 10-13 record, which came on the heels of a 13-12 month of June. Reading finished the month on a strong note though, going 8-5 over the final 13 games of the month, dating back to July 13. Reading's home run roll continued in July, as they were tied for the month homers hit in the Eastern League at 25 for the month.

Deadline's in the Rearview

The 2024 MLB Trade Deadline is now in the rearview mirrow and the Fightin Phils saw a couple of small changes to their roster. Sam Aldegheri was traded to the Los Angeles Angels in a deal that brought back reliever Carlos Esteves for the Phillies. Reading also added pitcher Seth Johnson from Baltimore, who received Gregory Soto from the Phillies. Johnson posted a 2.63 ERA with Double-A Bowie this season and will start Saturday's game against Hartford.

Updated Prospect Rankings

Following recent promotions and the trade deadline, the Fightin Phils have seven of the Phillies top-30 prospects on their roster, according to MLB Pipeline: Justin Crawford (3), Gabriel Rincones Jr. (9), Seth Johnson (10), Jean Cabrera (15), Christian McGowan (17), Caleb Ricketts (22) and Robert Moore (27).

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 1, 2023: At Hartford, the R-Phils bats explode for a 9-4 win over the Yard Goats. Carlos De La Cruz drove in three runs, and Oliver Dunn had three hits (triple shy of cycle) and four RBI. Josh Hendrickson matched a career-high, and set a season-high, with eight strikeouts. The bullpen remained hot with four-shutout innings in the series-opening win.

Hev Hartford

Hartford enters tonight after finishing in first place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 38-30 record. They are second in the Northeast Division with a 17-11 record in the second half of the season. Hartford most recently took five-of-six from Harrisburg at home. Following this week, Hartford heads to Richmond. Hartford's roster features 12 players ranked amongst the Colorado Rockies' top-30 prospects: Chase Dollander (1), Adael Amador (2), Yanquiel Fernandez (4), Zac Veen (5), Sterlin Thompson (6), Benny Montgomery (10), Ryan Ritter (12), Carson Palmquist (14), Gabriel Hughes (15), Warming Bernabel (16), Mason Albright (22) and Jaden Hill (27).

Goat on the Bump

Righty Bradley Blaock makes his Rockies' organization debut tonight on the mound. He was acquired from the Brewers, along with pitcher Yujanyer Herrera, in exchange for pitcher Nick Mears. Blalock has spent the majority of the season with Brewers' Double-A Biloxi, going 5-2, with a 4.08 ERA over 16 starts (75 IP, 69 H, 27 BB, 64 SO). Blalock also made one appearance out of the bullpen for Milwaukee on June 20 at San Diego, not allowing a hit or run over an inning. He made his final start with Biloxi on July 24 at Pensacola, earning the win. He pitched 5.1 innings, allowing no runs on four hits, with three walks and four strikeouts. Blalock split 2023 between the Red Sox and Brewers organizations, as he was traded to Milwaukee in 2023 in exchange for third baseman Luis Urias. The 23-year old was drafted by Boston in the 32nd round of the 2019 draft out of Grayson High School in Loganville, Georgia.
