ABOUT SUNDAY: The Cyclones lost an early 2-0 lead to Jersey Shore who stormed back to beat Brooklyn 3-2 Sunday at ShoreTown Ballpark, earning a series split. LHP **Nick Zwack** tossed four scoreless for the Cyclones, but RHP **Oscar Rojas**, who was terrific on Tuesday, allowed a game-tying two-run home run to C **Karl Ellison**. OF **Johan Rojas** scored the go-ahead run on a double play ball in the sixth. The Cyclones left six men on and went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position.

ROUGH N' ROWDEY: OF **Rowdey Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State, has been well-rounded in his first full season. The Brooklyn outfielder leads the team with 68 total bases and 16 doubles to lead the entire Mets organization. On the league leaderboard, Jordan ranks third behind Winston Salem's Luis Mieses (19) and Greenville's Ceddanne Rafaela (17).

BMAC ATTACK: OF **Brandon McIlwain** has been on base in 10 of his past 12 games, hitting .400 with a .489 on-base percentage. McIlwain currently ranks first on the team with a 127 wRC+ and has already set a new career-high with nine stolen bases. His .375 on-base percentage ranks first and his .291 batting average ranks third in the Mets organization.

MONEYBALL MATT: C **Matt O'Neill** ranks second on the Cyclones with a 124 wRC+ and a .373 wOBA. O'Neill leads Mets minor leaguers with more than 100 plate appearances with a 20% walk rate. O'Neill's 124 wRC+ number ranks sixth in the entire organization.

NEWCOMERS: Following the promotions of both RHP **Jordan Yamamoto** and RHP **Hunter Parsons**, the Mets promoted LHP **Nathan Lavender** and RHP **Luis Moreno**. Moreno has been used as both a starter (25 times) and reliever (18 times) in his Mets career that began in 2019, while Lavender came to the Mets out of Illinois in the 14th round of

vs. ABERDEEN: The Baltimore Orioles affiliate comes to Coney Island for the first time this season for the second head-to-head series. May 3-May 8, the IronBirds won four out of five games. The 'Birds have the best record in the league and are home to seven of the Orioles' Top 30 MLB Prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. OF Colton Cowser (No. 4) and 3B Coby Mayo (No. 7) are in the top 10.

the 2021 MLB Draft and has been used exclusively in relief.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley, the Cyclones have completely turned around their power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 17 home runs in the past 14 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

ARM ASSISTANCE: RHP **Mike Vasil** and RHP **Carson Seymour** joined the team in Bowling Green last week after earning their respective promotions from Low-A St. Lucie. Vasil, the No. 21 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*, was drafted out of Virginia in the 8th round last season, while Seymour was selected in the 6th round out of Kansas State last year.

'CLONES ON THE RISE: OF **Jake Mangum** and INF **Luke Ritter**, two Cyclones from both the 2019 and 2021 clubs, are now with Triple-A Syracuse, sitting just one more promotion shy of the major leagues. On the pitching side, RHP **Bryce Montes de Oca** and RHP **Michel Otanez** are also with the Syracuse Mets.

BIG WEEK IN BKLYN: The Cyclones return home from a two-week road trip, taking on the Aberdeen IronBirds for seven games in six days. Thursday night is Pride Night at Maimonides Park and Friday the team celebrates "The Nine Night," celebrating Black history in baseball. On Saturday, it's DC Comics Super Heroes night with 2,000 bobbleheads of Superman.

MORE-ENO: Luis Moreno makes his High-A debut today for the Brooklyn Cyclones, facing the league's best team -- the Aberdeen IronBirds.

WELCOME: Moreno earned the promotion on Wednesday, June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

BIG YEAR: The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as "quality starts."

2022: With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

ELIMINATING HOMERS: Moreno's 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

JUMP IN: Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
