Position Description

Cleanup Crew

Summary The clean-up crew will be responsible for cleaning the stadium immediately following each game. Throwing trash from designated areas into dumpsters. Blowing the concourse. Cleaning bathrooms and dugouts. Cleanup crew reports two and half hours <u>after</u> the start of the game and stays until job is complete.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following: removing trash/recycling, picking up trash from the seating bowl, blowing of seating bowl and bleachers, clean and restocking restrooms, cleaning concourse, and cleaning all bathrooms and dugouts. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. Other duties may be assigned.

Qualifications To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Must be at least 16 years of age, must be able to stand for long periods of time, must maintain a neat appearance and have strong customer service skills.

Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is <u>frequently</u> required to use hands to finger, handle, or feel and talk or hear. The employee is <u>frequently</u> required to reach with hands and arms. The employee is <u>frequently</u> required to stand; walk; sit and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. The employee must <u>frequently</u> lift and /or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision and ability to adjust focus.

Work Environment

While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is regularly exposed to outside weather conditions, which may include heat, cold and various forms of precipitation.
