THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On May 19, 2017, Nashville shutout Sacramento 6-0 and allowed just three hits between starter Paul Blackburn and relievers Tucker Healy and Tyler Sturdevant. Both Renato Nunez and Ryan Lavarnway homered for the Sounds.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds host the Gwinnett Stripers tonight in the second of a six-game series. Jace Peterson and Hernán Pérez delivered two-out, run-scoring hits in the bottom of the seventh inning to lift the Nashville Sounds to a 9-8 win over the Gwinnett Stripers Tuesday night at First Horizon Park. Left-hander Wade LeBlanc gets the ball for Nashville against right-hander Jasseel De La Cruz for Gwinnett.

Wade LeBlanc: 36-year-old Wade LeBlanc makes his third start tonight for the Sounds. He has thrown 5.2 innings and has given up five runs on four hits with five walks and seven strikeouts. LeBlanc is in his second stint with the Milwaukee organization after beginning the 2021 season with the Baltimore Orioles. He made 6 appearances with Baltimore (1 start) and went 0-1 with a 9.45 ERA in 6.2 innings. He started against Oakland on April 24 and allowed 4 runs in 1.2 innings and was designated for assignment the next day. Milwaukee signed LeBlanc to a minor league contract on May 4 and assigned him to Nashville. The Major League veteran has a career record of 46-47 with a 4.55 ERA in 240 big league games. He was drafted by the San Diego Padres in the 2nd round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Jasseel De La Cruz: 23-year-old Jasseel De La Cruz gets the ball for the second time for Gwinnett tonight. He has pitched 4.2 innings and has allowed one run on three hits with five strikeouts. In 2020, the right-hander was recalled to the major-league roster for the first time in his career on September 15. He was optioned the following day without appearing in a game.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 0, Second: 0, Third: 1, Fourth: 12, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Off on the Right Foot: Nashville won their first series opener of the season last night. The Sounds fell to Toledo 8-6 and to Memphis 18-6 in previous series openers.

Start the Streaks: Dustin Peterson and Corey Ray have hit safely in their last five games. Peterson is batting .316 (6-for-19) with seven runs, two doubles and four RBI. Ray is batting .389 (7-for-18) with two runs, two doubles and three RBI. Zach Green (5 games, 5/5-11) and Dee Strange-Gordon (8 games, 5/4-Present) are the only other Sounds to have five-game hit streaks.

Comeback Bid: The Sounds posted their first win when trailing after six innings last night and recorded their largest comeback win (three runs).

Braves In Town: For the first time in team history, the Sounds are playing against the Triple-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves. However, it is not the first time the Sounds are playing against an Atlanta affiliate. When the Sounds were in the Double-A Southern League, they matched up against the Savannah Braves from 1978-83 and the Greenville Braves in 1984.

Start Me Up: Thomas Jankins recorded the longest start by a Sounds pitcher in the 2021 season on May 16. He worked 5.2 IP and gave up four runs on nine hits.

Come Early, Come Often: The Sounds are averaging a Minor League Baseball best 5,339 fans per game. The next closest franchise is Triple-A Albuquerque with a 4,908 average per game.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

Top Prospects: Nashville opened the 2021 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 5 prospect, left-handed pitcher Aaron Ashby is the No. 7 prospect, outfielder Corey Ray is the No. 24 prospect and left-handed pitcher Clayton Andrews is the No. 25 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,035-1,926. The 2,035 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

That Doesn't Hurt So Bad: The Sounds have five Major League rehabbers on the roster. Infielder Daniel Robertson (April 26 - concussion), infielder/outfielder Jace Peterson (April 23 - cryotherapy on left thumb), infielder/outfielder Tim Lopes (March 8 - right oblique), RHP Eric Yardley (May 1 - right shoulder strain) and RHP Bobby Wahl (April 10 - right oblique strain) are all on the current roster.
