- Dunedin evened the series at one game apiece, taking game two from Daytona 3-2 on Wednesday afternoon at TD Ballpark.
- The Jays fell behind early, as the Tortugas scored twice in the second inning, including a check-swing RBI single from Ricardo Cabrera.
- Following the third, Dunedin starter Juaron Watts-Brown faced the minimum and finished six innings, matching his season-high with nine strikeouts.
- The Blue Jays claimed the lead in the bottom of the fifth, scoring on an RBI singles from Adrian Meza and Manuel Beltre, and a sac fly from Edward Duran.
- Irv Carter worked two scoreless innings, setting up Kai Peterson's save, in which he stranded the tying run on second base to end the game.

HALFWAY HOME

Tonight's game marks the final contest of the first half. With Wednesday's win, Dunedin ensured a record of .500 or better - marking the first time the Jays have done so in the first half since winning the FSL North first half title in 2019 with a 41-24 mark.

DUNEDIN NIGHTS: THE RETURN OF RICKY T

Tonight, the D-Jays welcome back Toronto's No. 1 prospect, Ricky Tiedemann on rehab from AAA-Buffalo, as he recovers from left elbow inflammation. Tiedemann made his pro debut with Dunedin in 2022, pitching to a 1.80 ERA in 30 innings before being promoted to A+ Vancouver, then AA-New Hampshire to finish the season.

LONG TIME, NO LEFTIES

Ricky Tiedemann's rehab start for the Jays marks the first time a left hander has started for Dunedin since Connor O'Halloran was promoted to A+ Vancouver following his May 21st start at Bradenton.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Wednesday's 3-2 victory marked Dunedin's 23rd one-run game this season. The Jays are 11-12 in those contests. 44 of the Blue Jays 65 games this season (67%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 22-22 record in those games.

OFFENSIVE OUTAGE

After a 10-run outburst in Friday's win over Bradenton, the Blue Jays offense has slowed down. Dunedin has been held to three runs or fewer in four straight contests. Across those four games, the team is hitting .153 with a .495 OPS and just four extra base hits.

REHAB CITY, USA

With Ricky Tiedemann's start today and Joey Votto's yesterday, Dunedin has hosted 12 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Tuesday, infielder Cade Doughty re-joined the Jays' roster for his second rehab stint of the season and homered in his first at-bat. Other notable rehabs include Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirotta (AAA).

MISTAKES AT A MINIMUM

Dunedin committed two errors Tuesday night, marking the first time in 14 games the Jays committed more than one. The Blue Jays committed just one error in last week's series with Bradenton. Dunedin's 58 errors are the third fewest in the FSL this season, and the team's .975 fielding percentage is second-best in the league.

ALL GOOD STREAKS COME TO AN END

By not reaching base on Tuesday, Blue Jays catcher Nic Deschamps snapped a 16-game on base streak, as he had reached in every game he had played this season. Deschamps spent 25 games on the IL with a shoulder injury, starting in Mid-April.

SERIES SUCCESS

With Friday night's win over Bradenton, the Blue Jays clinched five straight sets with a split or better. Across that stretch, Dunedin has earned three splits and two series wins. Dunedin has split three of its last four series.

DEFENDING HOME TURF

Dunedin has lost just one series at home this season: April 16-21 vs Clearwater. In five sets at TD Ballpark, the Jays have split three times and won twice.
