Reading continues its final series of the season at Binghamton. The Rumble Ponies clinched the season-series over Reading and lead it 12-3.

Looking Back

Reading fell 2-1 last night on a Rowdey Jordan walk-off double off Andrew Baker. Baron Radcliff hit a solo homer for Reading in the 7th to put them up at the time and Carlos Francisco tossed a scoreless eighth. Matt Osterberg was excellent, going seven innings and allowing no runs on three hits. It was the third time a Reading starter went seven innings this season. The R-Phils also struck out a season-high 19 times.

He Dunn Gets on Base

With a walk last night, Oliver Dunn extended his on-base streak to 19 games. If Dunn can reach 20 games, it will mark his second on-base streak of 20-plus games in 2023, with his other coming from May 26 to June 23 (22 games). Dunn leads the team and Eastern League in on base percentage at .402 and also leads the league in OPS at .918.

Parkinson's Final Start

David Parkinson will make his final Double-A start of 2023 tonight. He has had a bounce back season after missing 2022 and going 1-11 with a 7.64 ERA in 2021. Dating back to July 7, Parkinson is 7-1 with a 1.74 ERA over 11 appearences. He struck out 61 and allowed a .208 opponents average over that span. His League Ranks are: ERA (4th), Wins (T4th), SO (10th), IP (4th), BAA (10th), WHIP (9th) and WPCT (3rd).

Road Success

With Wednesday night's win, Reading has guaranteed a winning record on the road in 2023, with a 35-31 record and three games to play. The R-Phils were just 23-44 at home this season. Their winning percentages are .530 on the road and .343 at home in 2023.

Closer On Lock

Orion Kerkering earned the first six-out save of his career Wednesday night, as he struck out a season-high five hitters. He has now converted on his last seven save oppurtunities and has not allowed a run in his last seven outings and 14 of his last 15 appearences.

Around the Organization

The Phillies were off last night and begin a series in St. Louis tonight. Lehigh Valley beat Rochester 10-2 as Kody Clemens hit his 15th home run of the season. The IronPigs remain three-games back of Durham for a playoff spot with nine games to play. Jersey Shore fell at Hudson Valley 6-2 to even the series at one. The teams will play a deciding game three tonight with the winner advancing to the South Atlantic League Championship against Greenville. Clearwater fell to Lakeland 10-2 last night to also even their series at 1-1. The Threshers and Flying Tigers will play a winner-take-all game three tonight with the winner advancing to the Florida State League Championship.

The Rumble Ponies clinched the second-half title on Sunday and will match up with Somerset next week in the playoffs. Last week, Binghamton went 4-2 on the road at Hartford. Pony on the Bump

Dom Hamel makes his makes his third start against Reading this season, whomst he has thrown 13 innings and allowed just two runs with 20 strikeouts against in two starts. Hamel struck out 11 against Reading in seven innings on July 26. Overall, Hamel is 8-6 with a 4.01 ERA over 25 games/24 starts (119 IP, 106 H, 47 BB, 152 SO). He split 2022 between Single-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn, going 10-3 with a 3.25 ERA over 25 games. The Mets No. 16 Prospect was drafted in the third round in 2021 out of Dallas Baptist.
