### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

The last memorable August 10th for the Sounds came in 2014 when they swept a doubleheader against Round Rock. Infielder Jason Rogers drove in nine runs in the doubleheader and clocked three home runs in the 13-4 and 4-2 wins.

**Tonight's Games:** The Nashville Sounds and Indianapolis Indians will play two after yesterday's postponement for inclement weather. Nashville jumped out to an early 8-0 lead on Tuesday, holding on late for a 9-8 triumph. Southpaw Eric Lauer starts for the Sounds in game one against the Tribe's Roansy Contreras. Evan McKendry will get his second start as a Sound in the nightcap, facing Indy's Jared Jones.

**Eric Lauer:** 28-year-old Eric Lauer makes his third start of the season for Nashville and first since June 11. He is 1-1 with an 8.31 ERA (8.2 IP/8 ER) with the Sounds this season. The left-hander last appeared in relief on August 4, fanning five Durham Bulls in 2.0 innings. Since returning from rehab assignment with ACL Brewers on August 1, Lauer is 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA and seven strikeouts in two outings (4.0 IP). He started the season with Milwaukee, going 4-5 with a 5.48 ERA (45.2 IP/26 ER) in nine games (8 starts). The Elyria, Ohio native went 11-7 with a 3.69 ERA (158.2 IP/65 ER) in 29 starts for the Brewers in 2022. A product of Kent State University, Lauer was originally selected with the 25th pick of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft by San Diego.

**Roansy Contreras:** 23-year-old Roansy Contreras makes his season debut for Indianapolis tonight. The right-hander went 3-7 with a 6.59 ERA (68.1 IP/50 ER) and one save in 19 games (11 starts) with Pittsburgh this season. After allowing seven runs over his final two appearances with the Pirates (3.1 IP), Contreras was sent to their complex in Bradenton, Fla. He made one start for Single-A Bradenton on August 4, throwing 2.0 perfect innings. Contreras was acquired by Pittsburgh in a trade with New York-AL on January 24, 2021 as part of a package for RHP Jameson Taillon. He was originally signed by the Yankees out of his native Dominican Republic on July 2, 2016.

**Evan McKendry:** 25-year-old Evan McKendry starts for Nashville in game two. The right-hander is 8-4 with a 4.16 ERA (101.2 IP/47 ER) at Triple-A and is 0-1 with a 7.20 ERA (5.0 IP/4 ER) in one start for the Sounds. He was traded to Milwaukee in exchange for Sounds catcher Alex Jackson at the deadline on August 1, then faced his former team on August 3. McKendry took the loss, allowing four runs (all earned) on seven hits and four walks in 5.0 innings. He was the International League Pitcher of the Month in May and twice the IL Pitcher of the Week (May 9-14 and May 30-June 4) earlier this year, going 3-0 with a 0.31 ERA (29.1 IP/1 ER) across five games (4 starts) for the Bulls. McKendry was drafted in the ninth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Miami.

**Jared Jones:** 22-year-old Jared Jones starts for Indianapolis in game two. The No. 99 prospect in baseball and the No. 5 prospect in the Pirates system (MLB Pipeline) is 3-5 with a 3.31 ERA in 18 games (17 starts) in the minors in 2023. He is 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA in eight games for the Indians. Jones took a no-decision in his last start, going 5.2 innings at Gwinnett on August 4 (5 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 5 BB, 7 K). The Whittier, Calif. native was selected in the second round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft by Pittsburgh.

**The Legend of Pat the Bat:** Patrick Dorrian set career highs in both hits (4) and RBI (5) on Tuesday, smashing two home runs for the second time in four games and taking the team lead with 18 blasts this season. Over his past 14 games (since July 21), Dorrian is batting .365 (19-for-52) with seven home runs, 19 RBI, 11 runs, a .459 on-base percentage and a 1.344 OPS. Since then, Dorrian ranks among minor league leaders in slugging (2nd), homers (T-4th), extra base hits (T-4th, 13), OPS (5th), total bases (T-9th, 46) and RBI (T-10th).

**The Bull is Back:** On Tuesday, Abraham Toro continued where he left off in his first game with Nashville since July 25, extending his hitting streak to 12 games. Dating back to July 9, Toro is batting a scorching .440 (22-for-50) with eight doubles, two homers, 11 RBI, 15 runs and a 1.229 OPS with Nashville.

**Let's Get Rowdy:** Milwaukee Brewers first baseman Rowdy Tellez joined the Nashville Sounds on rehab assignment Tuesday, batting leadoff and playing first base. He led off the contest with a single registering at 110 mph off the bat. Tellez has been on the Brewers' 10-day injured list since July 5.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Tyler Black is the No. 5 prospect (No. 91 in baseball), left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** This will be Lauer's first career appearance against Indianapolis.
