The last memorable August 10th for the Sounds came in 2014 against Round Rock. Infielder Jason Rogers drove in nine runs three home runs in the 13-4 and 4-2 wins.

The Legend of Pat the Bat: Patrick Dorrian set career highs in both hits (4) and RBI (5) on Tuesday, smashing two home runs for the second time in four games and taking the team lead with 18 blasts this season. Over his past 14 games (since July 21), Dorrian is batting .365 (19-for-52) with seven home runs, 19 RBI, 11 runs, a .459 on-base percentage and a 1.344 OPS. Since then, Dorrian ranks among minor league leaders in slugging (2nd), homers (T-4th), extra base hits (T-4th, 13), OPS (5th), total bases (T-9th, 46) and RBI (T-10th).

The Bull is Back: On Tuesday, Abraham Toro continued where he left off in his first game with Nashville since July 25, extending his hitting streak to 12 games. Dating back to July 9, Toro is batting a scorching .440 (22-for-50) with eight doubles, two homers, 11 RBI, 15 runs and a 1.229 OPS with Nashville.

Let's Get Rowdy: Milwaukee Brewers first baseman Rowdy Tellez joined the Nashville Sounds on rehab when they swept a doubleheader assignment Tuesday, batting leadoff and playing first base. He led off the contest with a single registering at 110 mph off the bat. Tellez has been on the Brewers' 10-day injured list since July 5.
