**RAYNER, RAINER SEND 'CAPS TO SWEEP:** The West Michigan Whitecaps scored three runs in the first inning and rode the hot start to complete a five-game sweep of the Lansing Lugnuts in a 4-1 win in front of 5,838 fans on a Father's Day Sunday at LMCU Ballpark. Starting pitcher Rayner Castillo (1-5) collected his first win of the season, while Detroit Tigers No. 2 Prospect Bryce Rainer collected two hits in a win that gives West Michigan a 13-4 record against their archrivals. The Whitecaps finished with just six hits, but three of them came in the first inning, as catcher Ricardo Hurtado and infielder Garrett Pennington combined for three RBI. As a team, West Michigan has posted a .275 batting average in June – the highest among any team in the Midwest League Eastern Division after posting a league-low combined average of .208 in May.

**BABY STEPS:** The Month of May saw the Whitecaps post a combined record of 4-23, but June is starting to see a turnaround of sorts. Since the calendar flipped to June, the Whitecaps have posted a mark of 11-5. Coincidentally, the Whitecaps parent club, the Detroit Tigers went 6-22 in May and have collected a record of 11-6 in June.

**SKUBAL'S WEST MICHIGAN CAMEO:** Defending two-time American League Cy Young Award-winner pitcher Tarik Skubal dazzled in a Major League Rehab Assignment with the West Michigan Whitecaps as they blanked the Dayton Dragons 8-0 in front of 8,967 fans on June 7 at LMCU Ballpark. Skubal saw his first live game action since undergoing arthroscopic surgery on May 4, and he didn't skip a beat, throwing 44 of 54 pitches for strikes while completing five shutout innings with six strikeouts in the victory. West Michigan secured its first series win since completing a six-game sweep of the Lansing Lugnuts with a 12-4 win on April 19. Skubal is now back and pitching for the Detroit Tigers.

**RAINER, JACOBS LEAD TIGERS PROSPECTS IN WEST MICHIGAN:** Infielder Bryce Rainer (No. 2, MLB Pipeline) was added to the Whitecaps roster on April 21 after a strong showing during spring training. The 20-year old is fully recovered from a shoulder injury that limited him to just 35 games last season after becoming the #11 overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft – taken just two spots behind Pirates SS and MLB's No. 1 Prospect, Konnor Griffing. The California native currently sits as the No. 46 MLB Prospect by MLB Pipeline. The left-handed hitting shortstop that's drawn comparisons to Corey Seager joins left-handed pitcher Ben Jacobs (No. 6, Baseball America), righty Lucas Elissalt (No. 17) and OF Jackson Strong (No. 26) as the other MiLB Prospects listed inside the Detroit Tigers Pipeline Top-30.

**ROUGH COUPLE WEEKS:** On April 24, the Whitecaps sat in first place in the Midwest League Eastern Division with a record of 12-7, but from April 25 until May 10, the Whitecaps lost a franchise record 14 consecutive games. On May 9, a 5-3 loss to the Dayton Dragons at LMCU Ballpark put the losing skid at a franchise-record 13 games, breaking the previous record of 12 set back in 2011, a season that saw the Whitecaps still manage to finish with a winning record of 70-69.

**STILL GOT THAT PITCHING:** Despite the Whitecaps early-season struggles, the 'Caps still sit with a Top-3 team ERA in the Midwest League. Last year, the 'Caps posted the lowest earned run average in the Midwest League (3.17) with the next closest team in the Quad Cities River Bandits coming in at 3.29. Pitching Coach Dan Ricabal, now back for his third season with West Michigan, has guided his pitching staff to a Top-5 team ERA in each of his three seasons with the club.

**LORD OF TWO RINGS:** The Whitecaps won the 2025 Midwest League Championship on September 16, 2025 with a 3-1 win over the Cedar Rapids Kernels. Coincidentally, the Lakeland Flying Tigers won the Florida State League title the exact same night, leading a handful of Whitecaps players who played for both teams throughout the season to collect a second championship ring, including infielders Woody Hadeen and Garrett Pennington, and outfielder Jackson Strong. The rings were given out before a Detroit Tigers Spring Training game by President of Baseball Operations Scott Harris back in March.

**AWARDS SEASON:** To finish off the historic 2025 season, the Whitecaps had numerous players collect postseason honors. Infielder Kevin McGonigle, now playing for the Detroit Tigers, was named the Midwest League Prospect of the Year, while infielder Izaac Pacheco became the 4th player in franchise history to win Midwest League MVP. Pacheco joins Robert Fick, Gorkys Hernandez, and Wynton Bernard as league MVP's. Infielder John Peck and Pitcher Colin Fields both made the Post-Season All-Star Team, while manager Tony Cappuccilli was named Midwest League Manager of the Year. Moreover, René Rivera, the 2026 Whitecaps skipper, collected the Florida State League Manager of the Year honors while leading the Lakeland Flying Tigers to a Florida State League Title.

**FOR DAYTON:** RHP Ty Floyd makes his first start for the Dragons this season after having been skipped in the rotation to be placed on the Injured List during the Dragons visit to West Michigan earlier this month. Floyd, who was selected by the Reds in the Competitive Balance Round-A of the 2023 MLB Draft, played for one of the most memorable college baseball teams in recent memory, having been the No. 2 starter behind Paul Skenes for LSU on their 2023 National Championship team. Skenes, who was selected first overall, was followed by Floyd's college teammate in outfielder Dylan Crews who was picked second by the Washington Nationals. Floyd has had multiple elbow surgeries over the past few years, and he made it back for two rehab appearances in the Arizona Complex League (12:0 K:BB in seven innings) and two appearances for the Dragons (7:4 K:BB in 6:1 innings) before landing back on the shelf.

Rainer can use his long levers to get moving at a good clip, and while he may not have wowed with the glove in Lakeland because of slower actions, his plus-plus arm strength -- retained from his days pumping mid-90s fastballs on the bump -- covers up plenty. Much will be tested for him coming off the major shoulder injury, but Rainer also used the downtime to add more strength, setting up what could be a big comeback.
