**CARDIAC PATS:** Tuesday's 7-6 loss marked Somerset's third straight one-run game, moving them to 12-12 in 24 one-run games, which ranks 2nd in the Eastern League (Richmond). The result also marked Somerset's sixth straight game decided by three runs or less, bringing their record to 22-18 in such games.

**GRAND CENTRAL STATION:** On Tuesday night, Connor McGinnis became the sixth different Somerset Patriot to hit a grand slam this season, joining Owen Cobb, Tyler Hardman, Garrett Martin, Coby Morales and Miguel Palma. Somerset's six grand slams are the most in Double-A, tied for second in MiLB and are the most by a Double-A team through the season's first 64 games since Frisco's seven grand slams in that span in 2023. After not hitting any grand slams during the 2025 season, the Patriots' six are the most in a single season since 2023, when they hit nine.

**McGREAT COMPANY:** Connor McGinnis clubbed his first Double-A home run to cap a five-run third inning on Tuesday night. McGinnis becomes the second Patriot this season to record his first Double-A home run on a grand slam, joining Owen Cobb (4/9 @BNG). McGinnis is the first Patriot to hit a grand slam in Portland since Spencer Jones' first Double-A home run was also recorded on a grand slam at Hadlock Field on 8/30/23. McGinnis became the 14th different Somerset Patriots better to hit a home run this season.

**SLAMMIN' MCGINNIS:** Including his grand slam on Tuesday, Connor McGinnis set a new career-high by racking up 5 RBI of Somerset's six total runs in the game. In doing so, he extended his active on-base streak to a career-best 11 games. During the streak, McGinnis is slashing .231/.302/.308 with 1 HR, 7 RBI and 3 BB.

**DOWN THE STRETCH:** Since May 12, the Patriots' record of 20-11 is tied for 1st in the Eastern League (Hartford). With five games remaining in the first half, Somerset sits 1.5 games back of Hartford. Hartford ends the first half on the road this week with a six-game series at Reading.

**MAMBA MENTALITY:** On Tuesday, Coby Morales used his team-leading 17th multi-hit game of the season to extend his active hit streak to five games. During the streak, Morales is 7-for-21 with 1 HR, 3 RBI and 3 R.

**DJ GOT US FALLIN' IN LOVE:** DJ Gladney used a two-run double in the third inning on Sunday to extend his team-best active on-base streak to 14 games. During the streak, Gladney is 17-for-58 (.293/.349/.707) with 6 HR, 11 XBH, 18 RBI, 12 R and 5 BB. Since hitting his first home run of the season on May 2, Gladney is slashing .266/.336/.621 with 12 HR, 19 XBH, 30 RBI, 23 R, 13 BB and 8 SB.

**BRIDGEWATER BOMBERS:** The Somerset Patriots enter today having hit homers in 10 of their last 11 games, 26 of their last 30 games and in 50-of-64 games this season. Their 103 home runs this season are the most through 64 games in Double-A during the Research Tool Era (since 2005). The Patriots lead all Double-A clubs with 102 HR and have scored 178/381 (46.7%) runs this season on the long ball.

**POWER PACE:** The Patriots' 222 HR pace through 64 games is on track to beat the Double-A Research Tool Era record set by Somerset in 2022 with 205 home runs.

**SOMERSET SHOVING:** The Patriots pitching staff enters today with a Double-A best 673 strikeouts, which ranks T-8th in MiLB. On Tuesday night, Somerset pitchers combined for 10 strikeouts for the second straight game. The Patriots' 27.7 K% ranks fifth among all full season MiLB teams.

## 2026 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

### JAMES COOPER: Manager (1st year)

James Cooper enters his first season as manager of the Somerset Patriots, his fifth overall year in the Yankees organization and his fourth consecutive as a minor league manager. He spent the 2025 season as the manager of the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades, after serving as manager of the Single-A Tampa Tarpons in 2024 and beginning his minor league managerial career with the FCL Yankees in 2023. Under Cooper's leadership in 2025, Hudson Valley finished with a franchise-record 79 wins (79-50), being eliminated from playoff contention on the final day of the regular season. During the season, the Renegades finished second in AVG (.235), H (970), OBP (.336), SLG (.363), OPS (.699), third in R (598) and HR (547). In 2024 at the helm for Tampa, the Tarpons led the FSL in SB, while ranking second in AVG, H and 2B, and fourth in OPS. During Cooper's first assignment with the Yankees organization in 2022, he served as defensive coach for the FCL Yankees, where he helped the team with the 2022 FCL Championship. The following season, Cooper made his managerial debut with the FCL Yankees and was named the Florida Complex League Manager of the Year in 2023, when his team led the FCL in runs, hits, triples, RBIs, AVG, OBP, SLG and OPS.

### MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (2nd year)

Mike Fransoso enters his second season as a coach in Somerset and within the Yankees organization. Under Fransoso's leadership during the 2025 season, the Patriots' offense ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 129 HR (2nd), a .691 OPS (4th) and 600 R (5th). Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots (2018-2019) during the team's run as an independent team and also the Pittsburgh Pirates organization (2013-2015). He previously coached in the Seattle Mariners organization (2021-2024), serving as the hitting coach and interim manager for the Double-A Arkansas Travelers in 2024, when he helped manage the team to a Southern League Championship.

### DEMETRE KOKORIS: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Demetre Kokoris enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees. He served as the pitching coach in Hudson Valley in 2025 and guided the team to a league-best 2.82 ERA and 20 shutouts. Prior to joining the Yankees, Kokoris, coached in the Texas Rangers (2022-2024) and Toronto Blue Jays (2019-2021) organizations. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as the bullpen coach for the Triple-A Round Rock Express, and was the pitching coach for the Single-A Down East Wood Ducks in 2022. Prior to joining the Rangers, he was the pitching coach for the Short-Season Class-A Vancouver Canadians (2019-20) and was a rehab pitching coach (2021) with the Blue Jays. Before entering the professional coaching ranks, Kokoris was a college pitching coach at Chemeketa Community College, Point Loma Nazarene University, and Santa Barbara City College. He has also served as the pitching coach for the Greek National Team since 2021.

### UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (2nd year)

Uziel Viloría enters his second consecutive season as a defensive coach in Somerset and his second season with the Yankees organization. Under his leadership in 2025, the Patriots posted a franchise record .983 fielding percentage. Viloría began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloría signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), reaching High-A Jersey Shore in 2022 and 2023.

### CALEB HAMILTON: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Caleb Hamilton enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees organization. After a playing career that included MLB experience with the Minnesota Twins (2022) and Boston Red Sox (2023), Hamilton completed his first year in coaching as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley in 2025. During his final season playing in 2024, Hamilton saw time in 39 games for the Rocket City Trash Pandas, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. He was drafted by Minnesota in the 23rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Oregon State University, where he was an All-Pac-12 performer for the Beavers. Despite not catching in college, Hamilton made 323 of his 574 professional appearances as a catcher, and he played at least one game at all nine positions.

After being traded to the Yankees from the Cubs entering the 2025 season, Arias spent the year on the Yankees' 40-man roster. He broke camp on the 7-day IL for Triple-A SWB, before being reinstated following a minor league rehab assignment on 7/19 and having his option transferred to Double-A Somerset. Ended the season in Somerset with 17 relief appearances in which he went 3-0 with a 2.57 ERA, 2 HLD, 1/3 SV, 15 BB and 29 K in 21.0 IP.

**Career Notes**

Re-signed with the Yankees as a minor league free agent on 11/26/25 and was extended a non-roster invite to Major League Spring Training. Arias was originally acquired by the Yankees from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for cash considerations on 1/15/25, after he was designated for assignment by the Cubs on 1/12/25. Initially signed an international free agent contract with Blue Jays in 2018, but did not appear in a game before his release in 2020. Signed with the Cubs in 2021 and spent the first four seasons of his career in the Cubs minor league system.
