LAST TIME OUT

Allentown, PA (April 8, 2023) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders split the doubleheader with Lehigh Valley on Saturday. They dropped the first contest 3-0, but came back with a vengeance to take the second 7-4. The RailRiders hit four home runs in the latter contest to seal their series victory taking four games in their first road trip.

Game 1: The RailRiders broke up a perfect game in the fifth thanks to back-to-back singles from Jesus Bastidas and Jose Godoy. The visiting team could not plate a run and a season-high five errors in the field didn't help their cause.

Mitch Spence (L, 0-1) got the start throwing four and two thirds innings of work. The righty let up three runs, all unearned, on five hits. He struck out a season high five batters. Barrett Loseke made his Triple-A debut. Loseke came in for Spence in the fifth and stranded two runners on. He pitched the sixth cleanly.

Game 2: Scranton/Wilkes-Barre got the offense early going in the first inning. After Michael Hermsillo was hit by a pitch to reach, Jamie Westbrook doubled him home to get on the board.

Jamie Westbrook and Michael Hermsillo both launched long balls out to left field. Andres Chaparro made it homered as well with his solo shot to dead center. It was his first hit of the 2023 season to put SWB up 5-3.

Billy McKinney got in on the party as well with a solo shot of his own to start the sixth inning.

Nick Ramirez opened the bullpen game for the RailRiders. He tossed 1.2 innings allowing two runs on three hits. Deivi Garcia (W, 1-0) finished out the third and completed three total innings letting up just one run. Matt Bowman inherited a runner, but left him on the base paths in the fifth. He gave up one run on one hit in the sixth. James Norwood (S,1) allowed one run in the seventh but struck out three batters to slam the door shut.

NEWS & NOTES

LONG BALLERS - In a seven inning contest the RailRiders hit four home runs, the most in a game this season. Three players, Michael Hermsillo, Billy McKinney, and Andres Chaparro each launched their first of the season. Jamie Westbrook had his second of the summer. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has now recorded 11 home runs as a team, tying them for 7th in the league. Jake Bauers leads the way with three of his own.

FIELDING FAUX PAS - After a five error contest in game one of the doubleheader on Sunday, the RailRiders have an International League and Minor League leading fourteen errors on the season. Andres Chaparro has made five miscues at third base to start the summer, while Jake Bauers has three at first. The Oklahoma City Dodgers and Salt Lake Bees are next in line with twelve errors in 2023.

LEADING THE CHARGE - Manager Shelley Duncan has given every player on his roster a day off after playing five games in six days on the road. Five players have got the nod in eight out of the nine contests so far. Rookies Jesus Bastidas, Andres Chaparro, and Elijah Dunham along with Michael Hermsillo and Jake Bauers have been the everyday starters, rotating positions and batting order.

RUN DIFFERENTIAL - Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has kept pace with their opponents in terms of run scoring. The team has scored 35 runs over the course of the nine game season with Jamie Westbrook crossing the plate six times. Jesus Bastidas, Rodolfo Duran, and Jake Bauers have each plated five runs to lead the team in RBIs. The pitching staff has given up 34 runs, which makes the run differential +1 in favor of the home team. Ryan Weber has allowed a high of eight runs. Three pitchers have still not allowed a run to cross, while Mitch Spence has only let up unearned runs.

LOSEKE LOOKS GOOD - Barrett Loseke, 26, made his Triple-A debut this season after being called up on Sunday. Loseke tossed a clean inning and a third allowing just one hit and one walk while recording his first strikeout. He inherited a runner in his debut and after issuing a walk, he got a lineup to end the frame. Loseke was originally drafted in the 17th round in 2018 out of the University of Arkansas. He has been a reliever his entire professional career. Last season he pitched 64.1 innings in 37 appearances for a 3.50 ERA. Loseke issued just 25 free passes to his 73 strikeouts.

INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE - The team's pitching is third in the league with a low 3.32 earned run average. The staff is led by the bullpen which has tossed 57% of the innings. SWB has given up just 28 earned runs, while SYR has given up 33. The Mets are just below them with a 3.96 ERA. Out of 30 teams in the league, the RailRiders are fifth from the bottom with a .231 team average. Syracuse is at the top of the list with a team average of .289 at the plate.

PITCH CLOCK CUES - Only three pitch clock violations have been issued against the RailRiders so far this season. All three have come against the opening pitcher and none against the batters. Mitch Spence, Nick Ramirez, and Randy Vasquez have been tagged for an automatic strike for not coming set in time.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Oswald Peraza (#3 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) alongside outfielder Elijah Dunham (#18), Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle, (#29) will both be essential parts of the pitching staff. Peraza made his big league debut at the end of last season and even aided the Yankees in their postseason race.

ATOP THE FARM: Sean Boyle stacks up well against the other pitchers in the Yankees Minor League system. Last season, he recorded the most games started (27), most wins (13), most innings (155.1), and most strikeouts (160) among the farm system.

PUZZLER PITCHER: Last season, Boyle brought back an old trend of solving a Rubik's Cube. After getting his teammates invested in Somerset, he brought one to the Major League clubhouse at Spring Training this season. It's become a go to distraction and a competitive outlet. His record solve time is 32 seconds, but he likes to practice before every start.

QUALITY & QUANTITY: Boyle's final ten games in Double-A (2022) were quality starts. Across the three starts prior to the streak, Boyle allowed 21 R (19 ER) over 13.1 IP, equaling an ERA of 12.83. In Boyle's first start vs. Binghamton (5/30), he allowed a career-high 10 runs. In his last non-quality start before the streak vs. the Rumble Ponies on 6/5 he gave up three home runs in the first three innings of the game, before proceeding to retire the final 7 batters he faced to earn his 2nd win of the season.

BOYLE'S NO-NO DUO: In his third career Triple-A start, Boyle threw a seven-inning no-hit against the Worcester Red Sox on August 19, 2021. It was the first no-hitter in the history of Polar Park. Max McDowell was behind the plate that night. Boyle was part of another no-hitter, tossing four no-hit innings in a combined no-no on July 10, 2021 with Hudson Valley (A+) against the Brooklyn Cyclones.
