TONIGHT'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds travel to take on the Charlotte Knights (Triple-A, Chicago White Sox) in game one of a six game series at Truist Field. Right-handed pitcher Hunter Dobbins is slated to get the MLB Rehab Start in game one for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Jonathan Cannon for Charlotte.

SUNDAY'S RECAP: The Memphis Redbirds split an Easter doubleheader with the Norfolk Tides (Triple-A, Baltimore Orioles) on Sunday afternoon at AutoZone Park. In the 9-1 Norfolk win in game one, Memphis pitching walked a season-high 11 batters and hit four more Tides batters. Of the nine runs allowed, only two scored on a base hit. Starting pitcher Brycen Mautz (0-1) allowed five runs (four earned) on one hit and four walks in his 1.2-inning AutoZone Park debut. First baseman Blaze Jordan went 2-for-3 in the club's first loss of the season. Seven of the nine Memphis batters reached safely in game one. The Redbirds took control of their 7-3 game-two victory immediately. Jordan smacked a two-run, two-out double to grab the lead in the bottom of the first. All seven runs in the game scored via two-out RBI hits. First baseman Bligh Madris drove in two with a double in the third. Shortstop Cesar Prieto smacked a run-scoring single in the fourth. Third baseman Ramon Mendoza and second baseman Bryan Torres both added insurance with an RBI in the fifth. Skylar Hales dominated over 2.2 innings out of the bullpen. The right-handed pitcher allowed two hits, walked one and struck out three in his scoreless effort. Ryan Fernandez pitched a perfect seventh to close out the victory.

ITS THE BEEST STAART E-VER!: The Memphis Redbirds set a franchise record for an unblemished start (5-0) with a 4-3 walk-off win over the Norfolk Tides (Triple-A, Baltimore Orioles) on Wednesday afternoon at AutoZone Park. Memphis improved to 5-0 when third baseman Blaze Jordan was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded in the 10th inning, the best-ever start for the franchise. The bruiser proved to be the Southaven, Miss. native's first walk-off RBI as a Redbird. The record ultimately stands at 7-0 with the club's Thursday night and Friday afternoon victories over Norfolk. The win streak was snapped in game one of Easter Sunday's doubleheader.

CAREER NOTES

- Acquired by the Cardinals in a four-player deal that sent Willson Contreras to the Red Sox in December of 2025.
- Previously ranked as the No. 11 prospect in the Red Sox organization in 2025 by Baseball America.
- Made his Major League debut against the Cardinals in the second game of a doubleheader on April 6, 2025 as the Red Sox won 18-7.

2025

- Began the season on the Worcester (AAA) roster, but was selected to Boston during the home opening weekend. Placed on the Injured List twice, first with a right elbow strain (June 22-July 10). Then suffered a right ACL tear in his first MLB start back vs. TB (July 11) and finished the rest of the season in the 60-day Injured List.
- ACL injury surgery (Aug. 12) was performed by Dr. Daniel Cooper at the Carrell Clinic in Frisco, Texas. Made his Major League debut against the Cardinals appointed as the 27th player for the second game of a doubleheader on April 6 as the Red Sox won 18-7.
- Became the 17th Red Sox starting pitcher in the Live Ball Era (since 1920) to earn a win in MLB debut at Fenway Park and the first since Anthony Ranaudo in 2014 vs. NYY.
- Was the 14th Red Sox pitcher in the Live Ball Era to win each of their first two career games, joining Tanner Houck (2020) as the only ones in the last 10 years. The only other Red Sox in the Live Ball Era to play both of their first 2 career games at Fenway Park and win was Clay Buchholz in 2007
- Pitched in 13 games for Boston, starting 11. Pitched 5.0 innings or more in each of his first five career starts (April 6-May 14).
- Held his opposition to three runs or less in 7-of-11 starts with one run or less in four of the starts; two scoreless.
- Struck out a career-high seven batters over 4.0 innings in a no decision vs. BAL (May 24).
- Became the first rookie starter since 2007 (Daisuke Matsuzaka) to record two wins vs. the New York Yankees over a period of seven days
- Made four appearances and two starts in the minor leagues with Worcester (AAA) and Portland (AA).
- Red Sox won his final four starts of the season. Held his opposition to four hits or less in his last four starts.

- Signed by the Cardinals as a minor league free agent with an invitation to 2026 Major League Spring Training.
- Has been signed as a minor league free agent by the White Sox (2022), Braves (2023) and Twins (2024). Was traded twice from the Braves to Orioles and back to the Braves six weeks later.
- Played the second half of the 2023 season with the Uni-President 7-Eleven Lions with the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Pitched in 43 career Major League games posting a 4-1 record with a 4.21 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 72.2 innings. Made his Major League debut with the Kansas City Royals against the Milwaukee Brewers, Sept. 18, 2020.
- Earned his first Major League win versus the Boston Red Sox, Sept. 20, 2024, in a 12-inning affair for a 4-2 Twins win during the pennant run.
- Went 24 appearances without allowing a home run to start the 2024 season.
- Suffered two injuries in the minor leagues, a left shin contusion (6/25-7/11/19) and a right ulnar collateral ligament (7/13-8/13/21), both while with Omaha (AAA).
- Selected to the 2018 Texas League All-Star Game in Midland. Tossed a scoreless inning for the North Division.
- 2018 Arizona Fall League Pitcher of the Week (10/14-20).
- Tossed two complete games vs. Hagerstown, tied for the South Atlantic League lead.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023 Rule 5 pick from Boston spent his first full season in the Majors and appeared in a professional season high in games (62) and innings pitched (66.2)
- Became the first Rule 5 Selection to play an entire season with St. Louis since RHP Matt Bowman (2015).
- His 62 appearances led 2023 Major League Rule 5 Draft Picks and were the most by any Cardinals Rule 5 Draft Pick in the season immediately following his selection.
- His 62 appearances for St. Louis in 2024 were the most by a Cardinals rookie since Giovanny Gallegos (66 in 2016).
- Made Major League debut on April 3, 2024 at San Diego, striking out the side in the 9th inning. Became the 38th pitcher in MLB history and the 2nd Cardinal (Braden Loper, March 31, 1998 vs. Dodgers) to strike out three in 1.0 inning pitched in an MLB debut.
- According to Baseball Savant, threw his Slider 48.1% of the time in 2024 (573 of 1,191 pitches), most of any pitch. Ranked among 2024 leaders in Run Value (9, T-11th) & Hard-Hit Pct. (23.5, 6th) among pitchers to throw 400+ sliders.
- Was one of 11 prospects invited to the 2023 Red Sox rookie development program.

- Appeared in three games for Palm Beach in the 2024 playoffs compiling 3.0 innings with eight strikeouts while recording a save.
- Appeared in three games for Springfield in the 2025 playoffs and struck out seven batters over 5.0 innings allowing an unearned run with a save in his only opportunity.
- Pitched a career-high 3.1 innings with Palm Beach vs. Bradenton (8/2/24). Struck out a career-high seven batters over 3.0 innings vs. St. Lucie (5/18/24) with Palm Beach; a game which he threw a career-high 53 pitches.

Arizona Diamondbacks

- Yerzy was drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the second round of the 2016 Major League Baseball draft, 52nd overall. He was the third-highest Major League Baseball draft pick ever from the Greater Toronto Area, behind Josh Naylor (12th overall in 2015 by the Miami Marlins) and Joey Votto (44th overall in 2002 by the Cincinnati Reds). He had signed a letter of intent to attend the University of Notre Dame, but instead signed for a signing bonus of \$1.214 million. It was the 11th-highest bonus ever given a Canadian baseball player. Arizona scouting director Deric Ladnier said: "He has massive power." D-backs manager Chip Halesaid "Now he's just got to graduate high school and ... start his career... he's as good looking of a 17-year-old as I've seen."
