Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, look for the series victory in the finale of a six-game series at the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Lansing has prevailed each of the last two days and has won three of the first five games in the series, leaving Great Lakes with a 6-5 overall lead in the 18-game season series.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa take care of the Nuts' call via StreamGuys, while Brad Tunney and John Vicari crush the MiLB TV call.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 11, Loons 8 (11 innings). For the second straight contest, the Nuts' relief crew outpitched the Great Lakes bullpen and outlasted the Loons in 11 innings. Brayan Buelvas and Colby Halter homered to tie the score in the eighth inning, and Henry Bolte lined a tie-breaking, two-out two-run single in a three-run 11th-inning rally to send the Lugnuts to victory.

On Deck: The Nuts return home on Tuesday, May 14th, for the start of a six-game series with the Lake County Captains.

Wouldn't You Know it: Yesterday was the first Lugnuts win of the season on a Saturday.

The Comeback Nuts: Lansing rallied from 2-0, 4-3 and 5-4 deficits in Friday's 7-6 victory, and then came back from 2-0, 4-2 and 7-5 deficits to win yesterday.

Streaking: Cam Masterman enters today on a 12-game on-base streak; the team-high for the year is 17 games, set by Will Simpson.

A'round the A's Org:

- Right-hander **Joey Estes**, who spent the full 2022 season with Lansing before making his MLB debut last year, returned to the Majors last night for the A's and fanned five Mariners while allowing two hits and one run in five innings, and **Max Schuemann** supplied a three-run double in an 8-1 Oakland road victory.
- In Triple-A, **Jacob Wilson** went 3-for-5 in a Las Vegas 4-3 loss to Round Rock, and is now hitting .439 (47-for-107) and slugging .664 in 26 games between Vegas and Double-A Midland.
- In Double-A, **Jack Cushing** whiffed six in five perfect innings and the RockHounds bullpen carried that perfect until one out into the ninth inning, broken up by former Loon Jose Ramos, in a 14-0 rout of Tulsa. **Brennan Milone** went 4-for-5 to lead a 16-hit barrage.
- And in Single-A, **Cole Conn** blasted a two-out, go-ahead grand slam to send Stockton to a 7-6 victory over San Jose.

Fan-tastic: The Lugnuts have struck out a season-high 14 Loons each of the last two games, with the tone set yesterday by six strikeouts from **Luis Carrasco** in four scoreless one-hit innings.

Best in the League: The Lugs' offense tops the Midwest League with 156 walks drawn and 13 triples. Lansing has scored 170 runs this year, second to only Great Lakes.

Individual Efforts: **Henry Bolte** is 2nd in the league in runs scored (26), tied for 3rd in steals (13) and tied for 7th in RBIs (23); **Brayan Buelvas** is tied for 5th in runs (24), tied for 5th in RBIs (24) and tied for 6th in steals (11); **Will Simpson** is tied for 1st in triples (3), tied for 2nd in walks (27), 8th in OBP (.459), 9th in slugging (.515), 8th in OPS (.974) and 4th in RBIs (25). Reliever **Colton Johnson** leads the league with 12 appearances and is tied for 3rd with four saves.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes three MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 28). In Eric Longenhagen's Top 32 A's prospects for Fangraphs, he gives a nod to Morales at No. 3, Simpson at No. 28 and **Will Johnston** at No. 32. Keith Law placed Morales at No. 7 and Bolte at No. 17, giving a nod to Morales as his sleeper prospect of the organization, writing "Morales is a wild card given his age and lack of experience, yet those also make it easy to dream on the package of stuff and tools, and he offers as much upside as anyone in this system."

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: The Lugnuts started right-hander Ryan Koch (pronounced "Cook") against South Bend right-hander Ryan Cook (pronounced "Cook"). Jorhelyn Chavez and Brian Van Kirk hit back-to-back solo home runs in the 7th, but those were the only runs allowed by Cook in a 6-2 Silver Hawks win at The Cove.

2012: Kevin Pillar, batting sixth in the order, tied both the Midwest League and the Lugnuts franchise records, going 6-for-6 with a ninth-inning grand slam and six RBIs in a 16-4 rout at Fifth Third Field against the Dayton Dragons. Noah Syndergaard picked up the win in relief, striking out seven Dragons in four innings.

In a Nutshell: Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts... 75-pitch limit today.

Good Company: Shares March 3 birthday with Alexander Graham Bell (1847), Jackie Joyner-Kersey (1962), Herschel Walker (1962), Tone Loc (1966), Jessica Biel (1982), Camila Cabello (1997) and Jayson Tatum (1998).

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Colby Thomas in the third round).

WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th round) and Ryan Bergert (6th round); pitched against Bergert on May 26, 2023, and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

Glory Days: Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Mid-season Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels, who played 11 years (2001-2011) in MLB.

Prospecting: Until midseason 2023, MLB Pipeline had ranked Watters the No. 26 prospect in the A's organization and the A's No. 12 pitching prospect... his grades: Fastball 60, Curve 60, Changeup 45, Control 45, Overall 40... his scouting report: "Watters is a strong presence on the mound at 6-foot-4. His fastball was up to 99 mph during his junior year and touched triple digits in his time as a reliever. He also possesses a plus pitch in his power curve, missing plenty of bats as a true 12-to-6 that sits in the mid-80s. There's also a mid-80s changeup in there, though it's less polished compared to his other two offerings. Command will need to improve for Watters to have a chance to start at the next level. While the stuff was high-octane in college, he usually had little idea of how to locate it. Given his track record as a reliever, there's a strong chance he ends up back in the bullpen, where he can rear back and overpower hitters with two plus pitches."

Minor League Path: Signed at age 18 in 2019 and immediately began his professional career that season with the Dominican Summer League A’s... following the pandemic, opened in the 2021 Arizona Complex League before receiving three appearances with Stockton... received emergency start in Midland in 2022, allowing six runs in 1 1/3 innings... spent all of 2023 with the Ports, leading Stockton in starts (18), innings (109 2/3), hits allowed (107), runs allowed (73) and walks (53)... limited RHH to .208 avg./.663 OPS compared to .295/.843 for LHH.... CS/ATT: 6/11... was far better in 2023 as a starter (4.14 ERA, .239 avg. in 91 1/3 IP) than as a reliever (10.80 ERA, .300 avg., 18 1/3 IP)
