ON THE ROAD

The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas get set for the second of six games on Wednesday night from Southwest University Park. Round Rock is scheduled to send out RHP Shane Greene to start against El Paso RHP Nolan Watson. First pitch is scheduled for 7:35 p.m. CT.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT

Round Rock topped El Paso 8-4 in Tuesday's series opener at Southwest University Park. Round Rock LF Dustin Harris began the scoring in the top of the first as he blasted his first home run of the season to make it 2-0, bringing in RF Elier Hernandez. El Paso would answer back in the bottom of the first as 3B Matthew Batten followed up with an RBI single to cut the lead to 2-1. Chihuahuas LF Bryce Johnson homered to open the bottom of the third inning and knotted the game at 2-2. After Express 2B Jonathan Ornelas walked, CF Derek Hill singled in the top of the fourth to take the lead back for the Express, 3-2. For the second time in the game, Harris would hit one over the right field fence, doubling the Round Rock lead to 4-2 in the top of the fifth. Dungan would score Johnson on an RBI-groundout in the bottom of the fifth to bring El Paso back within one at 4-3. Later in the frame, C Brett Sullivan tied the game at four apiece when he doubled home Batten. DH Andrew Knapp homered to open the sixth, putting the Express back ahead, 5-4. In the top of the eighth, C Sam Huff tacked on another solo home run. The fourth long ball of the night for Round Rock made it a 6-4 game. The Express would add two more runs for a final of 8-4.

SHANE'S THROWING STRIKES

Express RHP Shane Greene is slated to make his first start of the season. Greene's first appearance of 2024 came in relief on March 31, where he pitched one inning. He owns a 24-29 record in the Major Leagues with a 4.50 ERA (237 ER/473.2 IP) in 345 games and 33 starts across 10 seasons.

HUFF IS HERE FOR MORE

Express C Sam Huff continued his hot start to the season on Tuesday night. The righty is 6-for-15 with two doubles, a triple, a home run, five RBI, two walks and three strikeouts in his first four games. On Tuesday, Huff went 3-for-5 with a triple, home run and RBI, falling a double shy of a cycle.

SMOOTH LIKE BUTTER

E-Train OF Dustin Harris had his best game of the season in the series opener on Tuesday. The Land O' Lakes, Florida native hit two home runs en route to a four-run victory. Harris hit just 14 home runs a season ago across 127 games between Double-A Frisco and Triple-A Round Rock, so he'll look to improve on that number in 2024.

LEAVING THE STATION

Round Rock combined for four home runs in the contest Tuesday night. They are now tied for third in the Pacific Coast League in team home runs with six to start the 2024 campaign.

HELLO HERNANDEZ

RHP Jonathan Hernandez was added to the Express roster prior to Tuesday's game on a Major League rehab assignment from the Texas Rangers. He appeared in the game recording a perfect sixth inning of work, while striking out one Chihuahua.

JAX ATTACK

The E-Train welcomed INF Jax Biggers into the fold on Tuesday as he was promoted from Double-A Frisco to take the place of INF Justin Foscoe, who is seeking his Major League debut after he was called up by the Texas Rangers. In his Triple-A season debut, Biggers went 1-for-3 with an RBI.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
