THE SURGE - The Wichita Wind Surge continue the second half tonight in Midland. It's the fourth of a six game series. Wichita has dropped 21 of its last 26 games. The team has dropped five consecutive series. The 26 wins are the fewest amongst all Class AA teams, Birmingham, (26), Binghamton (27). Wichita finished the first half a franchise high 20 games back of first place, 27 wins in the second half of 2024 had been previous low for wins.

JUNE BLUES - The team has five wins in the month of June, 2nd fewest in MiLB, Class AAA Durham (4) and Class A Daytona (5) wins. The team is 5-16 this month and has been outhit in 16 of the 21 games and batting .205 with RISP for the month (38x185).

VS MIDLAND: Wichita leads the all-time series with Midland 39-24 and 19-14 all-time in The Tall City. The Surge won 8 of 12 last season and split the series in the LoneStar State. Midland leads the 2026 season series 2-1.

ON THE BUMP: Cory Lewis will get the start today for the Wind Surge, making his ninth start of the year. The knuckleballer has been tremendous in June, giving up just five earned runs in 20 innings across five starts. In his two starts last week against Springfield, Lewis gave up just one earned run over eight innings. Lewis made 15 appearances for Wichita, including 13 starts, in the 2024 campaign before spending all of 2025 with the AAA club in St. Paul.

WIND SURGE SHUT OUT BY ROCKHOUNDS 6-0: The Wichita Wind Surge (1-2) fell 6-0 to the Midland RockHounds (2-1) on Thursday night at Momentum Bank Ballpark. Four Midland pitchers, led by starter Jamie Arnold, combined for a three-hit shutout while offensively the RockHounds pounded out 16 hits, including three homers, on their way to victory. Marek Houston provided a bright spot for Wichita, picking up a double for his first AA extra base hit. He has a hit in each of his first three games at the AA level. Khadim Diaw and Quinn McDaniel also extended their on base streaks in the loss.

CRUSH EM COSSETTI - Andrew Cossetti has reached base safely in 16 of his last 18 games. He has homered in four of his last eight games and has driven in a run in five of last eight games. In June he has 6HR, 19RBI and a .368 OBP. Has hit two grand slams this season, the first two of his career,

AMICK AMBUSH - Billy Amick leads the team with 17 home runs and 50RBI. 17 HR is third in Texas League and 50 RBI is sixth in the league, 7th in runs scored. He leads the Twins Organization in HR and RBI.

OUCH - Caleb Roberts leads the league with 12 hit by pitches, he has been hit in 7 of 10 games leads league with 12 and nine in the month of June.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named High-A Cedar Rapids catcher Eduardo Tait and Double-A Wichita catcher Andrew Cossetti as Twins co-minor league Players of the Week, and Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher C.J. Culpepper as their minor league Pitcher of the Week. Cossetti, went 8-for-23 with four home runs and 12 RBI, including six walks in six games for the Wind Surge...he drove in multiple RBI in four-straight games, from Sunday-Wednesday.

THE ROSTER - The Wind Surge have made 86 roster moves, used 23 position players, 33 pitchers this season. The team has signed a franchise high nine independent league free agents in season.

MEDICINE MAN - Quinn McDaniel extended his on-base streak to nine games and has drawn 11 walks in his first eight games with Wichita.

DIAW TIME- Khadim Diaw has reached base safely in all seven games to begin his Wichita tenure.

THE FLYING HAWAIIAN - Kala'i Rosario leaves the franchise as the all-time leader in Home Runs (44), Runs (158), Walks (146), XBH (104), and second in hits, and doubles. He played in 249 career games with the Wind Surge, third all-time.

HOMER RUN LEADERS- Wichita leads the Texas League with 99 home runs. 59 of the 99 home runs have been solo shots this season. 14 different Surge players have gone yard and seven have had multi-homer games. 21% of the teams hits this season have been home runs.

THE PEN- Wichita relievers have pitched a league leading 356.1 innings so far this season. An average of 5 plus innings per game. The teams pen has earned the win in 24 of the 26 team wins, the bullpen has a 5.94 ERA, starters are at 4.65. Surge starters are 2-25, fewest wins in the league.

ICT NOTES -23 of the 26 wins the team have scored five or more runs. The Surge are 6-10 in one run games. Wichita is last in the league in batting average, second in walks, 1st HBP, and 8th in ERA, allowed most hits in all of AA. The team has 62 errors, tied most in the league.
