LAST GAME

The Baysox fell 3-1 to the Harrisburg Senators on Wednesday night. A pitcher's duel in the early stages, Bowie right-hander Chayce McDermott struggled with command walking five batters through 3.2 innings. In the fourth, Harrisburg would cash in on a one-out walk to Jack Dunn, as Leonel Valera singled, advancing Dunn to third, before he was plated on a sacrifice fly from Jackson Cluff to give the Senators a 1-0 lead. That would be all the offense until the eighth inning, when Cluff would strike again, with a two-run triple to right-center that extended Harrisburg's lead to 3-0. The Baysox bats struggled to string together hits all night. Despite having nine hits on the evening, Bowie was held off the board until the bottom of the ninth, when Donta' Williams doubled home the lone run of the game for the Baysox in the defeat. Left-handed starter Alemao Hernandez went six frames and got the win for Harrisburg.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Senators enter tonight with a record of 23-23 - good for third place in the Southwest division and two-and-a-half games out of first. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg split a six-game series in Reading last week, losing each of the last three contests. The Senators won five of six in Harrisburg against the Baysox back in the second week of May, Harrisburg has the fewest home runs (31) and road home runs (14) hit in the Eastern League, and the second fewest in Double-A, while the Bowie staff has allowed the second-most home runs at home (35) in the league. The Senators' roster is highlighted by the Nationals' top two prospects, according to MLB Pipeline - James Wood (No. 1 WSH/No. 7 overall) and Robert Hassell III (No. 2 WSH/No. 44 overall) patrolling the outfield. RHPs Jackson Rutledge (No. 11 WSH) and Gerrardo Carrillo (No. 27 WSH) alongside LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 23 WSH) feature on the Harrisburg pitching staff.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Jackson Rutledge gets the ball tonight for Harrisburg. The No. 11 prospect in the Nationals' system, per MLB Pipeline, is set to make his third start against the Baysox already this season. Rutledge only allowed one earned run across six frames against Bowie on 5/9 in Harrisburg, before also starting the series finale on 5/14, firing six shutout frames and striking out five. He did allow a season-high eight hits and four earned runs through 5.2 innings in his last start this past Friday against Reading. Last season, Rutledge spent his time exclusively with Single-A Fredericksburg after seeing his development stymied by shoulder and blister injuries in 2021. He is holding left-handed hitters to a .243 average, after lefties hit .309 against him in 2022. Rutledge was the 17th overall pick by the Nationals in the 2019 draft out of San Jacinto JC. His arsenal features a 2-seam and 4-seam fastball in the mid-90s, alongside a mid-80s slider, upper-80s changeup, in addition to a curveball.

ONE CLUTCH CONDIMENT

Coby Mayo has been an RBI machine for the Baysox on their recent hot stretch. Mayo has a team-high 23 RBI on the season, including 10 in his last nine games. In that span, Mayo has three-multi RBI games, and has produced four game-winning runs for the Baysox. Mayo has also provided serious pop as of late, with an extra-base hit (six doubles, three home runs) in nine of his last ten games. Mayo is tied for the Double-A lead with 16 doubles and his 24 extra-base hits are tied for second-most at the level. He also has an active 16-game on-base streak - third longest by a member of the Baysox this season.

SLIPPING UP

The 47 errors committed by the Baysox this season are tied for the most at the Double-A level. This comes after a season where Bowie had a lauded infield defense, and committed only 100 errors, an average number in the Eastern League. At this point in the season, Bowie is on pace for 145 total errors

STRUGGLES WITH THE SENS

The Baysox have outhit the Senators in seven of the eight contests between the teams this season, and by a 63-48 total. However, Bowie is just 2-6 against Harrisburg in 2023. Part of that is due to the Baysox struggle to string together hits. Bowie is hitting .225 this season with runners in scoring position, but just .156 in such situations against Harrisburg. In total this season, the Baysox are 14-12 in games where they outhit their

TURNING A CORNER ON TANDEM TROUBLES?

Bowie has struggled with statistical splits relating to its starting pitching this season, but may be beginning to find some consistency. This season, Baysox starting pitchers have managed a 3.16 ERA in 196.2 innings, compared to a 5.73 ERA in 81.2 innings when arms with starting experience enter games as relievers. However, the arms in the back end of these tandems have combined for a 0.79 ERA (2 ER in 22.2 IP) in the past six games where a tandem has been used. Bowie has won five of those six contests. In total, the Baysox are 10-2 this season when a tandem combines for 3 ER or fewer and 0-12 when a tandem combines for 4 ER or more.

Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Fitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series.
